The Hindus in Bangladesh revere this place, as legends claim that this is the birthplace of Bashanti Puja, the celebration of Durga Puja during spring. Even though the ashram is

considered to be one of the principal pilgrimage sites for the Hindu community, after Chandranath temple in Sitakunda and Adinath temple in Maheshkhali, people know little about its history and existence. 
