

# DU student, another held

Police yesterday arrested two persons, including a DU student, for allegedly dealing an illicit agreement of question paper leakage with an admission seeker of 'Ka' unit at the university's Jagannath Hall.

The arrestees are Joydip Nath Dutta, a student of the Linguistics department of DU and his friend Partha Pradip.

DU acting proctor Prof M Amzad Ali said, "Acting on a tip-off, our proctorial team caught the duo from the gallery of Jagannath Hall playground while they were dealing with an admission seeker of providing entry test question papers of 'Ka' unit charging Tk 4.70 lakh."

The team handed over the two to Shahbag police who later arrested and filed a case against them.

A total of 71,350 candidates are vying for 1,660 seats under Ka unit (science faculty) this year. The one and a half hour test will start tomorrow at 10:00am.

# ACID ATTACK ON RMG WORKER Arrest of culprit demanded in Ashulia

Over hundreds from different walks of life form a human chain at Baipail in Ashulia, on the outskirts of the capital yesterday demanding arrest of the acid attack culprit immediately.

Mazeda Khatun, 23, worker of Birds Group Garment Factory in Ashulia suffered burns to her face and upper body allegedly by her husband Sohag, a CNG-run auto-rickshaw driver, on October 25.

Sohag poured acid on her while she was sleeping following a family feud. The victim is still under treatment in Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

The speakers criticize the action of police that they can not arrest the accused yet.

"We are repeatedly running drives, hope immediately the culprit will be held," Dipok Chandra Shaha, officer-in-charge (investigation) said.

The human chain was formed under the banner of Bengali Daily "Prothom Alo" and organised by their readers' forum "Bondhu Sova".

# Road crashes kill two

Two persons were killed while one other was injured in road accidents in the country yesterday and Tuesday night.

Our Savar correspondent reports, Md Mostafa Kamal, 26, of Kishoreganj, helper of a human hauler locally known as Maxi, died as he lost balance and fell from the rear of the vehicle while another such four-wheeler ran him over on Dhaka-Tangail highway at Narashinapur in Ashulia, outside the capital, yesterday.

Some local musclemen and political leaders are backing the operation of these illegal rickety vehicles which are causing frequent accidents, said locals.

Our Nilphamari correspondent adds, a person was killed and another injured as two motorbikes collided head-on before the Kishoreganj Upazila Dak Bunglow on Tuesday night.

The deceased was Dipok Thakur, 30, of the upazila. Injured Mamun Hossen is undergoing treatment at Rangpur Medical College Hospital.

# Ecneec likely to okay mega project on river today

The Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (Ecneec) is likely to approve a mega project today to protect around 2.5 million people in north-western region from erosion by the Jamuna River.

Ecneec chairperson and Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina will preside over the meeting to be held at NEC conference room.

Talking to the news agency, a high official at the Planning Commission said the proposed project titled 'Bangladesh's River Management Improvement Programme (Phase-1)' involves an estimated cost of Tk 5,200 crore. Out of the total project cost, the World Bank is expected to provide Tk 4,800 crore and Tk 400 crore by the government, said the official.
