In a drunken state, 16-year-old Fareez, nephew of former Awami League lawmaker HBM Iqbal, was racing with another car on a Gulshan street when he rammed his SUV into two rickshaws, according to a police officer, who inspected the site immediately after the crash.

However, police played a dubious role in dealing with it and refrained from taking any legal action against the boy even days after the accident that created quite a stir on the social media.

On October 20 the High Court asked the police authorities to explain in two weeks why they should not be ordered to take legal action against Fareez. It also asked why departmental proceedings should not be taken against the officer-in-charge of Gulshan Police Station for not carrying out his duty in this matter.

"The case has been filed in line with the [HC] order," OC Sirajul told The Daily Star Islam last night.

Two killed in Ukraine blasts

AFP, Kiev

Two civilians were killed and eight people injured in a series of explosions at a munitions depot in wartorn eastern Ukraine, Ukrainian military officials said yesterday.

A fire caused a series of ammunition explosions on Thursday evening at military depots close to the government-held city of Svatove, about 60 kilometres from rebel-controlled territory in the eastern Lugansk region, military spokesman Oleksandr Motuzyanyk told AFP.

The fire was still raging yesterday morning with security forces and rescue workers on high alert, he

added. "According to the latest information, two civilians were killed and another eight people were injured," in the blasts, regional military spokesman Ruslan Tkachuk told AFP by phone, adding that four of those

wounded were soldiers. Officials said the area had been cordoned off and roads leading to the city were closed. Soldiers had also been evacuated from their base, as well as civilians living

nearby. Soviet-era military warehouses usually contain large amounts of weapons and ammunition that some-

times are stored in poor conditions. According to the local media, the Svatove location contains nearly 3,500 tons of ammunition, including Grad, Hurricane and Smerch missile

"Not only China, the whole region will not develop without peace and stability here [in South Asian countries]. This is the fundamental element ...," she said.

Yanqi said the bilateral exchanges between China and South Asian countries have increased significantly.

She said trade between China and South Asian countries was over \$100 billion and Chinese investment in those countries stood at \$7.2 billion last year.

"We have announced a series of initiatives of our cooperation towards South Asian countries. In 2019, our bilateral trade will be close to \$150 billion. That is our common goal," she added

On the huge trade gap between China and Bangladesh, she said China has a large economy and it was necessary for them to adopt some measures and try to minimise the trade imbalance with its friends, like Bangladesh and Nepal.

"We also find it very necessary to support and facilitate Bangladeshi companies to represent in China, either through exhibitions or cam-

paign programmes," Yanqi added. China wants to see Bangladesh and Nepal more "integrated" in the regional cooperation mechanism, she said,

mentioning BCIM [Bangladesh-China-India-Myanmar], in which Bangladesh is an important part.

On many Chinese companies building bridges and roads, she said this was not only development work, it was the "linkage of hearts".

"We have common history and values. So we have to help each other and develop together," she said.

Welcoming the young Bangladeshis to study in China, the official said China would continue to provide scholarships for Bangladeshi students and would increase 100 more scholarships to Bangladeshi students.

Currently, China provides more than 800 scholarships to Bangladeshi students.

China would send teachers to Bangladesh to teach Chinese language there, which would help boost exchange programmes.

On China's "One Road One Belt" initiative, Yanqi said this was an important initiative and Bangladesh and Nepal could support and participate in building the road. "We have to help each other ..."

Stressing on people-to-people contact, she said, "From the ancient times, we are friendly to each other. We will keep it, as people-to-people contact is the foundation of our bilateral relationship."
