

# Main accused in Pabna ASI murder case held

Revolver, bullets seized

Police arrested the main accused in ASI Sujaul Islam murder case in Ishwardi upazila at midnight on Wednesday.

Koyel's cohorts opened fire on the law enforcers prompting them to retaliate. Police said Koyel and Constable Saidul Islam were

injured by bullets during the gunfight. Police rushed them to Pabna General Hospital from where Koyel was shifted to Dhaka, the OC added. Police also seized a

revolver and four bullets from the spot.

Assistant sub-inspector Md Sujaul Islam was killed on October 5. Later, his body was recovered from a turmeric field near Pakshey railway station.

Sub-Inspector Rezaul Islam of Pakshey Police Camp filed a case with Ishwardi Police Station the following day, accusing some unnamed criminals.

Police arrested four suspected criminals-- Khokan Hossain, 32, Jani Pramanik, 21, Masud Rana, 25, and Md Setu, 25, of Pakshey village, raiding different areas since the murder incident occurred.

Police arrested Koyel, following information grilled from the four, the OC added.

# 8 cops among 50 hurt in Habiganj clash

At least 50 people, including eight policemen, were injured in a clash on Wednesday evening between two groups of people in Sadar upazila of Habiganj district town over stalking of a schoolgirl.

Of the injured, 22, including four policemen and the officer-in-charge (OC) of the police station, were admitted to Habiganj Sadar Hospital. Two of them were shifted to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital as their condition deteriorated. The rest of the injured were given first aid at the local health center.

Locals said Nurul Haque, son of Inu Miah of Mohanpur, used to stalk schoolgirls of JK & High School everyday.

Police and witnesses said

an altercation took place between the youths of Shayestanagar and Mohanpur areas of Habiganj on Wednesday when Nurul Haque was stalking a girl of Shayestanagar.

Later, people of the two villages, equipped with sharp weapons, locked in a series of clashes over the issue, which lasted about two hours, leaving at least 50 from both sides injured.

A good number of shops and vehicles were also vandalised during the clash

On information, police rushed to the spot and fired rubber bullets and tear gas shells to bring the situation under control.

Additional police have been deployed in the area to avert further untoward incident, officer-in-charge of Habiganj Police Station said.

# Garments trader hacked to death in Pabna

A garments trader was hacked to death in the district town on Wednesday night.

The victim is Anu Agarwala, 32, owner of Chandni Fashion at Alahaz Super Market in the town, and son of Sham Sundor Agarwala of Pabna town hall area.

Locals and family sources said criminals hacked Anu at Pabna town hall premises, leaving him seriously injured when he was returning home around 10:30pm.

He was taken to Pabna Medical College Hospital where on-duty doctors declared him dead.

A gang often gathered in front of Pabna town hall and demanded extortion, said the victim's father.

Contacted, Anam Abdullah Al Hasan, officer-in-charge of Pabna Sadar Police Station, said police are investigating the incident.

Meanwhile, traders of the market kept shutters of their shops down yesterday

morning, protesting the killing.

They also formed a human chain in front of Pabna Press Club around 11:00am, demanding immediate arrest and capital punishment of the killers.

None of the killers was arrested as of filing of this report at 4:00 pm yesterday.

# 9 Jamaat-Shibir men held

Ten Jamaat-Shibir men were held in Rangpur, Bogra and Noakhali districts yesterday and the day before.

In Rangpur, police in separate drives arrested eight activists of Jamaat-e-Islami and its student wing Islami Chhatra Shibir in Mithapukur upazila and in the city in the last two days, reports our correspondent.

The arrestees are Jamaat activists Wahed Ali, 47, Mominul Islam, 33, Azizul Islam, 45, Farazul Islam, 35, and Abdul Quader, 54; and Shibir activists Mostafa Hossain, 28,

Shahidul Islam, 30, and Faruk Hossain, 25.

They were arrested in cases for carrying out subversive activities in the areas, said Additional Superintendent of Police Joyal Abedin.

The arrestees were later produced in the court that sent them to jail, said the ASP.

According to our Bogra correspondent, Detective Branch (DB) of police arrested a local Jamaat leader on sabotage charge in Kahaloo upazila of the district yesterday.

The arrestee is Tayeb Ali, 68, nayebe ameer of the district unit of Jamaat, and chairman of Kahaloo Upazila Parishad.

# Schoolgirl rescued 13 days into abduction

A schoolgirl, abducted from Birampur upazila of the district on October 22, was rescued from Habibpur village in the upazila early yesterday.

The victim is a Class X student of Ketra High School in the upazila.

Police quoted her family members as saying that Roni Bepari, 25, son Kuddus Bepari of Ketra village, often teased the girl on her way to school.

Roni and his four accomplices abducted the girl while she was going to the school in the morning. They took the girl to Habibpur village and confined her to a house.

Victim's father filed an

abduction case with Birampur Police Station the same day, accusing Roni and four others.

Police, acting on tip-off, raided the house at Hibibpur village at around 3:00am and rescued the girl from there. They could not arrest any of the abductors as they fled the scene, sensing the presence of the law enforcers.

Contacted, Officer-in-Charge (OC) Amiruzzaman of Birampur Police Station said they have already launched a drive to arrest the rest of the accused.


