

Prakash Jha wraps Jai Gangaajal off on vacation


Filmmaker Prakash Jha, who has wrapped shooting for his upcoming film "Jai Gangaajal", has left on a solo vacation to Paris and London. He says he wants to "catch up with friends" and "brood" on his next film.

"There is no agenda of this vacation. I just wanted to catch up with friends and chill out. I will also brood on my next film," Jha said. In the upcoming movie, which he's directing too, Jha will also be essaying a policeman's role,

while Priyanka will be donning the khaki uniform as well. The film, which will release worldwide on March 4 next year, revisits the dusty heartland of north India, examining the society-police relationship.

PRESSURE ON 'DILWALE' MUSIC IS HIGH PRITAM CHAKRABORTY

Known to churn out hit songs film after film, music composer Pritam Chakraborty says there is pressure on his forthcoming release "Dilwale". The Rohit Shetty directed romantic-drama reunites the iconic Bollywood couple of Shah Rukh Khan and Kajol, five years after their 2010 drama "My Name Is Khan".



"'Dilwale' is a movie which has song situations which demand popular songs. So, the pressure on 'Dilwale' is high," Pritam said during a session in 'Movie Mela' event at the 17th Jio MAMI Mumbai Film Festival.

Apart from working on the Shah Rukh-starrer, the "Bajrangi Bhaijaan" hitmaker will also be composing for Aamir Khan's next venture, "Dangal".

"Dangal" songs are with the script. Whenever songs are with the script you kind of get into the script, the songs happen very fast. The entire 'Dangal' album

was locked in six days in Panchgani. I thought it'll take a lot of time. Aamir was extremely involved and was there in Panchgani too."

Singer-actress Rita Ora says she wants to be the first woman to be a Bond girl and sing the 007 theme. The "Body On Me" singer has aspirations to bag two of the top jobs in the prestigious spy franchise and is confident she could pull it off. Quizzed on whether she would prefer to act or sing for Bond, Ora replied, "I'd rather sing the theme but has anybody done

both? Maybe. Maybe I'll do both!"

Madonna recorded the theme song for 2002 film "Die Another Day" and also had a cameo as fencing instructor Verity. Sam Smith penned "Writing's On The Wall" for current 007 adventure "Spectre" and the song has become the first Bond theme to reach the number one spot in the UK.
