Locals foil bid to grab land meant for hospital

Locals have foiled the attempt to set up business establishments on the government land, also proposed site of the hospital of Probin Hitoishi Sangha (unity of senior citizens), beside College Road in the district town.
Local sources said Moinul Islam, surveyor of Patuakhali Zila Parishad, Shahjahan, work assistant, and Joydev Chandra, accountant of the same

organisation, jointly planned to set up tin-shed business houses there.
Around 8:00am on Friday, they came to the spot with labourers and construction materials including wood and tin to build structures.
After getting the news, leaders of Probin Hitoishi Sangha and local people rushed to the spot and foiled the attempt.
At one stage the three Zila Parishad staff and their workers fled away, leaving the materials on the spot.

Syed Habibur Rahman, president of Probin Hitoishi Sangha, also president of Patuakhali Sadar upazila unit of Awami League, said they selected the site for a proposed hospital for the senior citizens as the district administration and the municipality authorities gave them assurance of giving the land.
But three Zila Parishad staff wanted to set up business establishments by grabbing the government land, said Md Ishaque

Mollah, secretary of the organisation.
Joydev Chandra, accountant of the Zila Parishad, said, "We planned to set up tin-shed business establishments on the land that we took on lease from the Zila Parishad around five years ago."
When contacted, Khan Mosaref Hossain, administrator of Patuakhali Zila Parishad, said, "I don't know about the matter. I will see it and take legal step if anyone is found guilty."

176 BNP-Jamaat men held in five districts

At least 176 BNP and Jamaat-Shibir men were held in Rangpur, Chapainawabganj, Bogra, Jhenidah, Satkhira and Faridpur districts yesterday and the day before.
In Rangpur, police in separate drives arrested 12 activists of Jamaat-e-Islami and its student wing Islam Chhatra Shibir in Mithapukur upazila and the city in the last two days, reports our correspondent.
The arrestees are Akmal Hossain, 55, principal of Tanjumul Millat Cadet Madrasa, Abu Sayeed, 50, principal of Kutubpur Degree College in Badarganj upazila, Ekramul Haque, 30, Nurul Azam, 28, Golam Kibria, 44, Ferdous Mian, 35, Moklesur Rahman, 30, Lutfar Rahman, 32, Nurun Nabi, 28, Badal Mian, 35, and Altaf Hossain, 19.
They were arrested on charge of planning subversive activities in the areas,

said Additional Superintendent of Police Joynal Abedin.
According to our Chapainawabganj correspondent, the law enforcers arrested 13 leaders and activists of BNP and Jamaat-Shibir in three upazilas of the district yesterday and the day before.
The arrestees include Mizanur Rahman, 50, ameer of Rahanpur municipality unit of Jamaat, Tasirul Islam, 40, president of Sramik Kalyan Federation of Nachole upazila unit, and its Bholahat upazila unit sura member Nazrul Islam, 47.
The arrestees were accused in several cases, said police.
Away in Bogra, police arrested 20 BNP-Jamaat men in the district yesterday, reports our correspondent.
They were arrested in cases for sabotage, arson and vandalism, said Police Superintendent Md Asaduzzaman.
In Jhenidah, police

arrested five Jamaat men in the district town on Friday night, reports our correspondent.
The arrestees are Khairul Islam, 23, of Bishoykhali village, and Saiper Ali, 50, of Shalia village in Sadar upazila; and Samad Biswas, 50, Md Abdullah Hossain, 51, and Jihad Ali of Ramchandrapur village in the upazila.
They were arrested on charge of planning subversive activities in the area, said ASP Ajbahar Ali.
Meanwhile, police arrested 53 Jamaat-Shibir men in Satkhira district in the last two days.
Sub-Inspector Kamal Hossain confirmed the incident, reports UNB.
In Faridpur, the law enforcers arrested 73 leaders and activists of BNP and Jamaat-Shibir in the district yesterday and the day before, reports UNB.
They were arrested on sabotage charges, said police.

Idol vandalised at temple

Criminals vandalised an idol at a temple in Shukhanpukur area under Gabtoli upazila of the district early Friday.
A gang entered Malipara Durga Temple at Lathiganj Bazar in the area at midnight and damaged the idol of goddess Laxmi, said Pormot Mali, president of the temple.
The damaged idol was later found in a pond near the temple, said locals and devotees.
Pranbandhu Debnath, president of the upazila Pujya Udjapon committee, demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment of the criminals.
Police are raiding different areas to arrest the culprits, said Shaheed Mahmud, officer-in-charge of Gabtoli Model Police Station.

Sirajganj clash leaves one dead, 20 hurt

A man was killed and 20 others were injured during a clash between two rival groups of villagers at Madla village in Shahzadpur upazila of Sirajganj district early yesterday.
Locals said a group of youths supporting Shahid Mollah misbehaved with Nur Mollah of the village on Friday night. Some other villagers arranged an arbitration meeting yesterday morning to resolve the matter.
Md Rezaul Karim, officer-in-charge of Shahzadpur Police Station, said Shahid Mollah's men attacked Nur Mollah and his supporters at the arbitration meeting, which led to a clash between the two sides.
Yusuf Ali, a supporter of Nur Mollah, died during the clash while 20 others from both sides were injured the OC said.
The injured were taken to the upazila health complex and local clinics.

Cop, journo among 10 injured by robbers

At least 10 people, including a policeman and a journalist, were injured in attacks by robbers in Habiganj and Dinajpur districts yesterday.
Robbers looted cash, gold ornaments and other valuables worth about Tk 10 lakh from a house after injuring five people in Phulbari upazila town of Dinajpur early yesterday, reports our correspondent.
The injured are house owner Morshed Ali, 42, his wife Samsun Nahar, 38, son Emon Hossain, 21, neighbours Raju Ahmed, 36, and Sazu Ahmed, 33, of Gouripara area in the town. They were admitted to the upazila health complex.
Family sources said a gang of 20 stormed into the house and took away Tk 8 lakh and gold ornaments after beating Morshed, his wife and son when they tried to resist them.
On information, neighbours rushed to the spot but they came under an attack by the robbers. Of them, Raju and Sazu sustained injuries during the incident.
A case was filed in this connection, said Mostaque Ahmed, officer-in-charge of Phulbari Police Station.

BEATING OF JSC EXAMINEE Stalkers threatening victim's family to withdraw case

The stalkers, who beat up a Junior School Certificate (JSC) examinee in Ishwarganj upazila on November 2, are threatening the victim's family to withdraw the case.
Rahima Khatun, 13, a JSC examinee from Postari High School, was returning home at Char Pubail village in the upazila from the examination centre at the upazila headquarters on a motorbike with her uncle and cousin around 2:00pm.
On the way, Russel Miah, 22, son of Abdul Quddus, along with 20 accomplices of the same village, waylaid the motorbike near Char Pubail Community Clinic and gave a marriage proposal to the girl.
As the girl rejected the proposal, Russel and his men pulled her and her uncle Nazrul Islam, 32, from the

bike and started beating them with an iron rod.
At one stage, the stalkers hacked Nazrul Islam with a sharp weapon. When Rahima's cousin Faruq Hossain, 25, came forward to save Nazrul, the gang hacked the boy also.
Hearing their screams, locals rushed to the spot but the gang members managed to flee.
The victims were admitted to Ishwarganj Upazila Health Complex. Rahima was released after treatment at the health complex, but Nazrul and Faruq were shifted to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital (MMCH) with head injuries.
Rahima's uncle Abdul Helim Liton, filed a case against 20 people, including Russel as prime accused, with Ishwarganj Police Station on the day.
Contacted, Md Borhan

Uddin, officer-in-charge of Ishwarganj Police Station, said four of the accused appeared before a Mymensingh court on Wednesday and took bail.
The accused left the area after the incident but police drives are on to arrest Russel and other accused, the OC added.
As the girl is appearing in the JSC examination, we are alert about her security, the OC continued.
But the girl's family members alleged that local administration and police did not take security measures for her. The girl has been appearing in the examinations with injuries in her legs, family sources said.
We are feeling insecure following repeated threats from the accused to withdraw the case, said Rahima's family. "The accused are moving freely in the area," they alleged.

সরকারী সম্পত্তি সাধারণ বীমা কর্পোরেশনে বীমাকরণে বিধি-বিধান সম্পর্কিত বিজ্ঞপ্তি

সাধারণ বীমা কর্পোরেশন গণপ্রজাতন্ত্রী বাংলাদেশ সরকারের ব্যাংক ও আর্থিক প্রতিষ্ঠান বিভাগ অর্থ মন্ত্রণালয়-এর অধীন একটি রাষ্ট্রীয় প্রতিষ্ঠান। বাংলাদেশে বিদ্যমান বীমা আইন এবং তৎপরবর্তীকালে সাধারণ বীমা কর্পোরেশনের সাথে বেসরকারী নন-লাইফ বীমা কোম্পানীসমূহের সম্পাদিত Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) অনুযায়ী সরকারী সম্পদের অনুকূলে শুধুমাত্র সাধারণ বীমা কর্পোরেশন থেকে সকল ধরনের বীমা পলিসি গ্রহণ করার বিধান রয়েছে। বীমা Ordinance No. L1 of 1984-এর Substitution of Section 23, Act VI of 1973 অনুযায়ী সরকারী সম্পত্তি বা পাবলিক প্রপার্টি সম্পর্কিত ব্যাখ্যা নিম্নে উদ্ধৃত করা হলো :

23. Public Property to be insured with the Sadharan Bima Corporation only:
 - (1) All insurance business relating to any public property or to any risk or Liability appertaining to any public property shall be placed with Sadharan Bima Corporation and with no other insurer.
 - (2) Any policy of insurance taken or issued in contravention of sub-section (1) shall be void: Provided that any claim for loss, damage, compensation or refund of premium arising out of, or relating to, such policy shall be binding on the insurer.
 - (3) In this Section "Public Property" means :-
 - (a) any property movable or immovable which belongs to, or the protection of which is the legal responsibility of-
 - (i) The Government or a local authority; or
 - (ii) Any company, firm, undertaking, institution, organisation or other establishment which is managed or controlled by the Government or a local authority or in which the Government, by it self or jointly with a local authority or company managed or controlled by it, holds controlling financial hare or interest or which is specified by the Government for the purpose of this section; and
 - (b) a project financed out of an external loan or with external aid until it reaches-
 - (i) in the case of an industrial project, the stage at which it is capable of commencing normal production; and
 - (ii) in the case of any other project, the stage at which it is capable of being put to the use for which it is intended."

পরবর্তীতে ১৯৮৪ সালে বেসরকারী খাতে বীমা কোম্পানী প্রতিষ্ঠিত হওয়ার পর সরকারী সম্পত্তি বীমা করার সপক্ষে ১৯৯০ ইং সনের The Insurance Corporations (Amendment) Act অনুযায়ী Section-23-এর Sub-section (1)-এর পরিবর্তে নিম্নরূপ আদেশ জারী করা হয় :

"(1) Fifty percent of all insurance business relating to any public property or to any risk or liability appertaining to any public property shall be placed with the Sadharan Bima Corporation and the remaining fifty percent of such business may be placed either with that corporation or with any other insurer in Bangladesh".

তবে বীমা ব্যবসায় শৃঙ্খলা বজায় রাখার স্বার্থে Bangladesh insurance Association-এর অনুরোধের প্রেক্ষিতে বাণিজ্য মন্ত্রণালয়ের পত্র সূত্র নং-বাংবি-২/১(১৬)/৮৯(অংশ)/১১৪ : তারিখ : ২১-০৪-১৯৯০ ইং অনুযায়ী সাধারণ বীমা কর্পোরেশন এবং বেসরকারী সকল নন-লাইফ বীমা কোম্পানীসমূহের মধ্যে একটি Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) সম্পাদিত হয়। উক্ত সম্পাদিত MOA-এ নিম্নোক্ত ধারাসমূহ সন্নিবেশিত আছে :

1. None other than Sadharan Bima Corporation shall underwrite any general insurance business relating to any public property or to any risk or liability appertaining to any public property.
2. All accounts of concerned signatory/signatories of the 2nd party who is/are found to have underwritten any such business in violation of the terms and modalities of the said agreement shall be kept suspended until the matter is finally resolved.

সুতরাং, বাংলাদেশে বিদ্যমান বীমা আইন এবং কোম্পানীসমূহের সাথে MOA অনুযায়ী সরকারী খাতের সকল সম্পদের বীমা বুকি সাধারণ বীমা কর্পোরেশন হতে গ্রহণ করার সুস্পষ্ট বিধান রয়েছে। এতদসঙ্গেও বিদ্যমান বীমা-বিধি লংঘন করে কোন কোন বেসরকারী নন-লাইফ বীমা কোম্পানী সরকারী সম্পত্তির অনুকূলে বীমা পলিসি ইস্যু করছে যা কোনভাবেই বাঞ্ছনীয় নহে। নন-লাইফ বেসরকারী বীমা কোম্পানী কর্তৃক সরকারী সম্পদের বীমা বুকি গ্রহণ বীমা আইনের পরিপন্থী। বীমা আইন ও সংশ্লিষ্ট বিধান অনুযায়ী সরকারী সম্পত্তির বীমা বুকির বিপরীতে সাধারণ বীমা কর্পোরেশন থেকে বীমা পলিসি গ্রহণ করার জন্য এবং বেসরকারী নন-লাইফ বীমা কোম্পানী কর্তৃক সরকারী সম্পত্তির বিপরীতে বীমা পলিসি ইস্যু না করার জন্য অনুরোধ করা হলো।
