

Try killers of four national leaders

Demands SCF urging to declare Nov 7 as Day of Murdering Freedom Fighters

Sector Commanders Forum yesterday demanded trial of the killers of four national leaders and some other freedom fighters, who were assassinated in November, 1975.

Citing that anti-liberation forces were behind the killings, SCF leaders said they were still active in the country. So, social movement is crucial to resist them, they said.

They were addressing a discussion on trial of the killers of four national leaders and freedom fighters and distortion of the history of the Liberation War, organised by SCF's Dhaka division unit at the capital's Bangladesh National Museum.

Four Liberation War heroes -- Syed Nazrul Islam, acting president of Bangladesh government in exile in 1971; Tajuddin Ahmad, prime minister of the same government; Capt M Mansur Ali, finance minister; and AHM Quamaruzzaman, minister for home affairs, relief and rehabilitation -- were killed by some army officers

inside Dhaka Central Jail on November 3, 1975.

Besides, some other army officers and freedom fighters including Khaled Musharraf, Najmul Huda and ATM Haider were murdered on November 7 the same year.

SCF Chairman KM Shafiullah said Jamaat was working to implement a Pakistani agenda.

He also urged everyone to socially boycott the lawyers defending the alleged war criminals in the International Crimes Tribunal.

The SCF Secretary General Haroon Habib demanded that the government declare November 7 as "Day of Murdering Freedom Fighters".

He reiterated a demand for retracting Amnesty International's recent statement that claimed the trials of two condemned war criminals were flawed and they failed to meet international standards.

The SCF vice president Harun-Ar-Rashid said everybody was in fear of being attacked by militants as unrest was sweeping across the country.

Road crashes kill seven, injure five

Seven people were killed and five others injured in road accidents in six districts yesterday and on Saturday.

In Chittagong, Sumaiya Akter, 8, daughter of Mohammad Hasan of Dakkhin Fedainagar was killed when a bus hit her while she was crossing Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Terail area of Sitakunda upazila yesterday.

In Cox's Bazar, three people were killed as a bus rammmed into a trolley in Islampur area on Cox's Bazar-Chittagong highway yesterday.

The deceased were Saiful Islam, Nurul Islam and Jasim uddin of Napitkhali area.

In Savar, RMG worker Md Rabiuzzaman, 36, of Lalmonirhat was killed when a microbus run him over while he was cross-

ing Dhaka-Aricha highway in Hemayetpur yesterday.

In Patuakhali, five people were injured when a battery-run auto-rickshaw fell into a roadside ditch after it collided head-on with another vehicle on Patuakhali-Kalapara road at Masterbari point yesterday.

In Mymensingh, Sohrab Ali, 50, of Kamlapur village was killed when a CNG-run auto-rickshaw hit his motorcycle on Mymensingh-Tangail road at Lengrabazar in Muktagacha upazila on Saturday night.

In Bogra, Rubel Ahmed, 24, of Khamarkandi village died yesterday at Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College Hospital after he was injured as a leguna hit his rickshaw on Bogra-Dhaka highway at Sherpur municipality on Saturday evening.

TWO CUSTODIAL DEATHS IN PALLABI HC denies bail to suspended SI

The High Court yesterday rejected three bail petitions of a suspended sub-inspector of Pallabi Police Station in three cases accusing him of torturing to death two people in custody.

The HC bench considered the pleas of Jahidur Rahman Khan to have not been placed before it properly. Jhut (scrap of fabrics from garment industries) trader Mahbubur Rahman Sujan and Istiaq Ahmed Johnny, a resident of Bihari camp in Mirpur, were allegedly tortured to death on February 8 and July 13 respectively last year, Deputy Attorney General Md Bashirullah told The Daily Star.

Sujan's wife Momotaz Sultana Lucy and Johnny's father Intiaz Hossain filed two cases with a Dhaka court last year under the Torture and Custodial Death (Protection) Act-2013, he said. Bashirullah said Pallabi police filed the third unnatural death case over Sujan's death. Jahid filed the petitions on November 1.

Give legality to land ownership

In some places, the lands are owned by outsiders who either bought them from the former enclave dwellers or grabbed those from minority Hindus, said AKM Bulbul Ahmed, programme officer (law) of ALRD.

"If the traditional method of land surveying is done, a concern remains that the land ownership of people of the weak sections such as women and Hindus might not be identified properly," said Sultana Kamal, executive director of ASK.

She asked those who were involved in the survey to keep these issues in mind.

In addition, those who are leaving the country are also facing problems in selling their land and property because of a lack of records, said Iftekharuzzaman, executive director of TIB.

In the statement, the three organisations also recommended that the government set up a special tribunal to resolve the land disputes in the former enclaves and deploy additional law enforcers there.

SM Abraham Lincoln, president of Kurigram Bar Association, called for passing a law to give the locally used land transfer documents of the former enclave dwellers a legal basis.

Action Battalion and Detective Branch of police and "they were armed and carried handcuffs."

The men reached Saifuddin's house in Shahidnagar area around 6:45am and said they were ordered by court to search his house, he said.

Seeing the identity cards of the men, Saifuddin opened the door of his apartment on the third floor of the five-storey building, but instead of searching the house, they took Saifuddin downstairs, forced him into a microbus, and drove away, Badsha said.

He added that the microbus carrying

Saifuddin joined two other minibuses waiting some around 200 metres away from the house.

Saifuddin's phone was turned off soon after the vehicles left, he said.

Md Alauddin, younger brother of Saifuddin, lodged a general diary with Lalbagh Police Station on the day of the incident.

Asked, Officer-in-Charge Moniruzzaman said police were looking for Saifuddin but a "full fledged investigation" would start if a case was filed.

Badsha, however, said the family would wait for a few more days before filing a case.
