

5 KISHOREGANJ 'RAZAKARS' Witness narrates father's killing by 2

Investigation officer gives deposition in case against Taher, Noni

A sixth prosecution witness in a war crimes case yesterday told International Crimes Tribunal-1 that he saw two of the five accused "Razakars" tie his father to a seedbed east of their house in Kishoreganj's Ayla village and that one shot him dead on November 12, 1971 during the Liberation War.

Earlier in another war crimes case against Obaidul Haque Taher and Ataur Rahman Noni, the investigation officer gave his deposition, saying the two topped a Netrakona Sadar Thana Razakar list which he collected from the deputy commissioner's office.

Shahjahan Kabir said he began investigations on June 6, 2013 and submitted the report to the chief prosecutor on November 5, 2014.

Kishoreganj Razakars

Shahjahan, 57, said the two, Nasiruddin Ahmed alias ATM Nasir and Shamsuddin Ahmed, were among 70-80 Razakars, including the three remaining accused, Hafiz Uddin, Azharul Islam and Gazi Md Mannan, who attacked their village at noon that day.

"Many of the villagers left out of fear but I and my father Abdul Mazid stayed at home. From a bush at the southern bank of our pond I watched them taking my father. I saw Nasir shoot my father dead," he said breaking down in tears.

The body was buried the next day, said Shahjahan, identifying Shamsuddin at the dock. The remaining four accused are on the run.

The five face seven charges of crimes against humanity. Other witnesses said they killed 8-10 persons of Ayla, Bidiyanagar, Fatehgarh and Kiraton Bilpara villages that day.

Defence counsel Abdus Shukur Khan cross-examined Shamsuddin before proceedings were adjourned until tomorrow.

help Tutul's family.

Dipan had published the work of blogger Avjit Roy, who was killed in February. Three other bloggers have been murdered this year, and all of them used to write about sensitive social, political and religious issues.

Farid Ahmed, also executive director of the association, said the publishers were exercising self-censorship and they would stop publishing creative works altogether if another threat came or an attack took place.

"My family has been praying for my safety ever since I got the threat," he said.

Vice President of the association Milon Kanti Nath urged the publishers to stand beside Tutul's family.

A milad mahfil praying for Dipan's departed soul and Tutul's quick recovery followed the discussion.

GONOJAGORON MANCHA

A faction of anti-war crimes platform Gonojagoron Mancha yesterday held a rally at the capital's Shahbagh, demanding exemplary punishment for the killers of publishers and bloggers.

The Imran H Sarker-led faction also brought out a procession.

Addressing the rally, Imran said "evil powers" were trying to show to foreigners that there was existence of Islamic State in Bangladesh so that they lost interest in investing in the country.

Meanwhile, the National Committee against Fascism and Imperialism rallied in front of Raju memorial at Dhaka University, condemning killings and militancy.

Violence against children on rise for impunity

Says report of BSAF, Terre des Hommes, World Vision

Incidents of child repression have increased alarmingly this year mainly because of the culture of impunity, claims a non-government report.

A total of 62 children were raped between January and June last year while this year in its first six months has experienced 230 child rapes, said the report jointly prepared by Bangladesh Shishu Adhikar Forum (BSAF), Terre des Hommes- Netherlands, and World Vision Bangladesh.

Besides, 55 children committed suicide and 136 others were killed in road accidents in 2014 during the aforementioned period while this year has seen 126 suicides and 281 deaths in road accidents. The statistics, prepared on the basis of news reports of 10 national dailies and information of different child rights bodies, was revealed at a press briefing on state of child rights in Bangladesh organised by the three organisations at Dhaka Reporters' Unity.

BSAF Chairperson Emranul Huq Chowdhury said even though around 45 percent of the country's population are children, there is a lack of political will to protect child rights properly. National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) Member Kazi Reazul Hoque said the situation would have improved, if the existing laws were enforced strictly. Eminent human rights activist Barrister Sara Hossain suggested that the child rights bodies collect information about child rights violation from police records and courts for preparing more accurate reports on child rights status in the country.
