

Regional bus services soon

New passenger, cargo transport services to connect Bangladesh, India, Nepal, Bhutan, says FM

New passenger bus and cargo services connecting Bangladesh and India with Nepal and Bhutan will be operational soon, says Foreign Minister AH Mahmood Ali.

The initiative, taken under the BBIN Motor Vehicle Agreement, will have a huge positive economic impact on the countries.

"This is expected to be a 'game changer' in this sub-region," the foreign minister yesterday said while addressing the inaugural session of a two-day seminar titled "Bangladesh and Indian northeast: Exploring Opportunities and Mutual Interests".

The Asiatic Society of Bangladesh organised the event in the city.

"All these initiatives, put together, would have a huge impact on increasing people-to-people contact as well as on increasing cross-border business activities," he said.

Bangladesh, Bhutan, India and Nepal (BBIN) signed a motor vehicle agreement in June. The pact was signed to promote safe, economical efficient and environmentally sound road transport in the sub-region.

Regional AIDS congress postponed

The 12th International Congress on AIDS in Asia and the Pacific (ICAAP-12), which was scheduled to be held in Dhaka on November 20-23, has been postponed, apparently on security grounds.

The ICAAP-12 executive committee in its website on Thursday night said the postponement was "due to unavoidable circumstances," and the schedule would be announced later.

Though they did not officially cite any reason behind the decision, a 28 October update on the website says some of the

US air strike 'kills Jihadi John' in Syria

The United States targeted British Islamic State leader "Jihadi John" in an air attack in northern Syria which Britain said would "strike at the heart of Islamic State" if the militant's death is confirmed.

British Prime Minister David Cameron said the death of Mohammed Emwazi, who was known as Jihadi John after appearing in videos showing the killings of US and British hostages, could not yet be confirmed and the Pentagon said it was still assessing the effectiveness of the strike.

But a US official said Thursday's attack in the town of Raqqa, Islamic State's de facto capital, probably killed Emwazi and the



Syrian Observatory for Human Rights, a monitoring group, quoted sources in Raqqa as saying he had been blown to pieces.

"A car carrying four foreign Islamic State leaders, including one British Jihadi was hit by US air strikes right after the governorate building in Raqqa city," Rami Abdulrahman, Director of the UK-based Observatory told Reuters.

He initially quoted sources in Raqqa as saying the body of an important British Jihadi was in the town's hospital but later quoted them as saying Emwazi's body, and those of his three militant comrades, had been left in charred pieces.

Emwazi took part in videos showing the

Chinese town reborn from ashes of quake

The fate of the residents of Yingxiu changed forever the moment an earthquake hit the small town with the magnitude of 8 on a summer afternoon in 2008.

Being the epicentre, the formerly nondescript town, deep inside the hills and mountains in the Sichuan province of China, was thrown into total chaos as mountains split and swayed, buildings reduced to rubble and its infrastructure and communications were destroyed.

About 6,500 of around 12,000 perma-

nent residents of Yingxiu were killed that day and the rest were left to suffer utter devastation as people tried bare-handed to dig relatives and neighbours from the debris.

Seven years on from the nightmare, the town is now reborn from the ashes and its residents have recovered from the tremendous sorrow inflicted on them with the loss of their families in the disaster.

Strolling through the reconstructed town, one may get stunned by sparkling new houses built in combination of the

BNP activist shot dead in Chuadanga

A BNP activist was found shot dead in Bhultia village of Chuadanga Sadar upazila yesterday three days after he was picked up by unidentified criminals.

The victim, Rabiu Islam Robi, 48, was son of Abul Hasem of Nalbhanga village in Jhenidah's Kaliganj upazila.

Victim's son Rana Hossain, 18, said his father was a fertiliser and insecticide trader. He was a BNP activist, but did not hold any post.

According to Rana, his father along with the other accused was returning home in a microbus on Tuesday noon after appearing before a Jhenidah court in a land-related case.

When they reached near Teltulita Bazar in Jhenidah Sadar upazila, some six to seven armed assailants on

GAS LEAKAGE Three burnt in explosion

Three members of a family suffered severe burns in an explosion in their household gas pipeline at the capital's Wari early yesterday.

Alamgir Hossain, 50, his wife Hosne Ara, 45, and their daughter Shamrin Alam, 20, were in critical condition, and fighting for their lives at the burn unit of Dhaka Medical College Hospital, said Partha Shankar Paul, residential physician at the hospital.

Alamgir sustained 95 percent burns, Hosne Ara 40 percent and Shamrin 30 percent, he added.

Quoting Shamrin, her uncle Abdus Sattar told The Daily Star that Hosne Ara went to their kitchen around 12:30am to boil milk. Just as she lighted a matchstick to fire up the gas stove, the room exploded with a loud bang and a huge fireball engulfed the house instantly.

Locals doused the flames immediately and rushed the three victims to the hospital.

Tapan Chandra Shahi, officer-in-charge of Wari Police Station, said gas leaked from what appeared to be a faulty pipeline
