

Court denies bail to Jessore war crime suspects

The International Crimes Tribunal-1 yesterday rejected bail petitions of two war crimes accused from Jessore, who were allegedly involved in crimes committed in the district during the Liberation War in 1971.

On November 3, defence counsels of Billal Hossain and Lutfar Morol filed the bail petitions citing poor health condition of the two.

The three-member tribunal yesterday rejected the petitions saying the duo cannot be granted bail at this moment as charges have already been pressed against them, said Prosecutor Rezia Sultana Chaman.

The tribunal, however, directed the jail authorities to take necessary steps for their medical treatment, she said.

Billal and Lutfar are among nine war crimes accused from Jessore, who are facing five charges.

The seven others are: former BNP and Jamaat-e-Islami lawmaker Shakhawat Hossain, Ibrahim Hossain, Sheikh Md Mujibur Rahman, Kazi Ohidul Islam, Aziz Sardar, another Aziz Sardar and Abdul Khaleq Morol.

The seven, except Shakhawat, who is in jail, are on the run. The tribunal also adjourned the case proceedings until November 22 following a time petition filed by Abdus Sattar Palwan, a lawyer for Shakhawat and Billal.

Earlier in the day, Abdus Shukur Khan and Qutubuddin Ahmed, state appointed defence counsel for the seven others accused, placed their submission on charge hearing.

MA HANNAN'S CASE

Meanwhile, the prosecution yesterday submitted the progress report of the investigation against eight war crimes accused from Mymensingh, including Jatiya Party lawmaker MA Hannan, over their alleged involvement in crimes committed during the Liberation War.

The tribunal directed the prosecution to submit another progress report on January 25 after it sought four months time to complete the investigation, said Rezia Sultana.

Of the eight, Hannan, the alleged general secretary of Mymensingh district Peace Committee, his son Rafique Sajjad,

4 to die for killing boy 5 get life-term for abducting girl

A Chittagong court yesterday awarded death penalty to four people for killing a five-year-old boy after abduction while another court sentenced five people to life-term imprisonment for abducting a girl.

In the first incident, the four convicts -- Faruque, 25, Idris Mia, 28, Anwar, 23 and Sujan, 22, -- were also fined Tk 5,000 each. Of them, Sujan is absconding.

According to the case statement, the convicts abducted Yasin Arafat Abir, son of Reaz Uddin from ransom from Halishabar area while he was playing in a field nearby his house on December 17, 2012.

Later, they strangled the boy as he started shouting while they were taking him to Alankar area by a CNG-run auto-rickshaw

and left the body on the road in Nagordola area of Sitakunda upazila.

In another incident, the five convicts -- Rahima Begum of Banshkhal, Rokhsana, Mamunur Rashid, Jalal Uddin and Karim Dakat of Kutubdiya -- were fined Tk 50,000 each with the jail term.

Of them, Mamunur Rashid is in jail while others are on the run.

According to the case statement, the convicts abducted Farisa Afrin Oishi, 5, from in front of her residence in Chandgaon area in the city on January 27 this year and demanded Tk 5 lakh as ransom over the phone.

Later, following a case filed by the girl's father Jahed Hossain, police rescued her from Rahima's house in Khutukkhali of Banshkhal upazila on February 2.

SC resumes hearing Nizami's appeal against death penalty

After a 68-day recess, the Supreme Court yesterday resumed the hearing of the appeal filed by condemned war criminal Motiur Rahman Nizami, challenging the verdict that sentenced him to death.

Nizami's lawyer SM Shahjahan presented prosecution witnesses' statements about the charge of committing conspiracy, murder, rape and deportation of the villagers of Baousgari, Ruposhi and Demra in Pabna in 1971.

A four-member bench of the Appellate Division headed by Chief Justice Surendra Kumar also fixed today for its third hearing.

International Crimes Tribunal-1 on October 29 last year sentenced him to death on four charges of war crimes, including murdering of intellectuals. The 71-year-old was also sentenced to life imprisonment on four other charges.

context of our country. Plus they tend to neglect requests to close the pages when there is a bulk of complaints," she said.

Tarana hoped that a treaty with Facebook would help reduce posts causing political and sexual harassment. The government will also buy software to filter contents, she said.

However, Brac's Gender, Justice and Diversity Director Sheepa Hafiza, and Prof Sadeka Halima of sociology and Prof Suraiya Pervin of computer science and technology of Dhaka University, emphasised teaching children on how to use the internet properly.

"Men commit these crimes because they feel they enjoy a sense of impunity as...very few cases are filed under the ICT law," said KM Tanjibul Alam, a lawyer.

Noting that most police officers as well as legal and judicial practitioners are not yet familiar with digital technology, he suggested creating expert units in law enforcement agencies and district legal offices.

Mahbooba Panna, deputy secretary, Information and Communication Technology Division; Suparna Roy, local development expert, Access to Information Programme, Prime Minister's Office; Luna Shamsuddoha, chairman of IT company Dohatec; Taslima Miji, chief executive officer of Techmania Dhaka; and Shahana Siddiqui, head of content and communications for www.maya.com.bd also spoke.

high officials in the process. RECOMMENDATIONS The probe body recommended forming a supreme independent probe committee to ensure punishment for those who leaked the questions.

It also called for creating a "medical education commission" to conduct fair admission tests since the interference of the health ministry created controversies.

The committee also demanded enforcement of laws to stop question leaks. It criticised the suspicious death of a UGC official, who was arrested for his alleged involvement in the leak, under Rab's custody. A group of citizens formed the committee on October 19. It collected evidence from various sources, had them scrutinised by IT experts, talked to protesters and government officials and evaluated the question formulation procedure.

The committee also includes barristers Sara Hossain and Jyotirmoy Barua, BSMU's professor Dr Fazlur Rahman, hydrologist M Inamul Huq, academic AN Rasheda, vocalist Mahmuduzzaman Babu and DU teachers Mohammad Tanzimuddin Khan and Samina Lutfa.
