

# WAR CRIME TRIALS ICT-1 orders charging of 5 Patuakhali men

The International Crimes Tribunal-1 yesterday directed the prosecution to submit formal charges, if any, on January 21, against five Patuakhali men who were allegedly involved in crimes committed during the 1971 Liberation War.

The two-member tribunal led by Justice Shahinur Islam fixed the date after Prosecutor Rezia Sultana Chaman sought two more months to complete a probe against the five.

Earlier, she submitted a progress report on the investigation.

The accused are: Esaq Shikder, Abdul Goni Hawlader and Md Awal alias Awal Moulavi of Galachipa, Abdus Sattar Pyada and Solaiman Mridha of Patuakhali Sadar upazila.

According to the tribunal's investigation agency, Esaq was a member of local Peace Committee, an anti-liberation organisation, while the rest were members of local Razakar Bahini, an auxiliary force of the Pakistani army, during the Liberation War.

# TV channel marketers protest ad migration to Indian stations

Electronic Media Marketing Association (EMMA), an organisation of marketing executives of the country's television and radio stations, yesterday protested the broadcasting of Bangladeshi companies' advertisements in foreign television channels.

The association leaders, joined by journalists, media personalities, and actors, claimed that the television industry would be threatened if Bangladesh continued advertising in foreign channels.

Forming a human chain at the capital's Karwan Bazar, they placed an 11-point charter of demands including framing of an advertisement policy and threatened to organise more protest programmes.

The association leaders said local and multinational companies were choosing Indian TV channels because they could advertise with those cheaply. However, Bangladeshi TV channels do not get the priority in India as they are unofficially banned in India, they said.

When contacted, Md Anisur Rahamn Tarek, general secretary of EMMA, told The Daily Star that recently 20 to 25 local companies had signed a deal with Indian TV channels for telecasting their advertisements. He said the worth of the advertisements was about Tk 30 crore.

He said local viewers preferred watching Indian TV channels as they telecast few advertisements.

However, Indian channels do not telecast the advertisements in India; they use the same slot at a time and broadcast Bangladeshi advertisements for Bangladeshi audience and other advertisements in India, he said, adding that that is why they took low charges.

Tarek said local companies paid only 5 to 7 thousand for per minute to Indian channels while the cost was Tk 20 to 25 thousand for local TV channels.

He said local companies got the scope to advertise with Indian channels as Bangladesh Bank on September 8 issued a circular allowing this.

Some multinational companies have already cut their budget for the Bangladesh TV channels, he added.

When asked Bangladeshi TV channels could broadcast foreign advertisements, he said they did not get much from those advertisements due to absence of a policy.

## Cricketer Shahadat's wife gets bail in domestic help torture case

A Dhaka court yesterday granted bail to suspended national cricketer Shahadat Hossain's wife Jesmine Nahar Nrittya for 47 days in a case filed for torturing their 11-year-old domestic help Mahfuza Akhter Happy.

Nrittya was granted bail till January 17, 2016 on the ground that she is a mother of an infant.

On September 6, Mahfuza brought the allegation of torture by the couple. Police arrested Nrittya in the capital's Malibagh on October 4 and two days later Shahadat surrendered before a Dhaka court that sent him to jail.

December 13. The form fee, which is Tk 150, has to be paid through state-run mobile phone operator Teletalk.

Education Minister Nurul Islam Nahid yesterday inaugurated the online admission at Dhanmondi Government Boys High School. There are 35 government schools in the capital of which 16 also offer primary education and will enrol over 2,000 youngsters in class-I.

Like previous years, the beginners will be admitted in class-I by lottery, a process initiated in 2010 aiming to end increasing psychological torment that preschoolers were facing. Students wishing to get admitted to other classes will have to take a written test while candidates for class IX will be selected based on their Junior School Certificate and Junior Dakhil Certificate results.

Lotteries will be held for schools in Dhaka city on December 26 in presence of guardians, teachers, and officials concerned and the schools outside Dhaka will arrange the draw on their own, said a top official of DSHE wishing anonymity.

Although the lottery process received good response from parents, they are still worried because it is all about luck. Shahinur Islam said parents are nervous because there are only a handful of "good" schools in the capital which cannot enrol all the candidates.

"Admitting children to a reputed school in Dhaka is the toughest job. If my son is allowed here [Dhanmondi Govt Boys' High School], I will have no tension until class-X," said Anwar Hossain.

"The government schools are comparatively better as they have good teachers and environment and the fees are also low," he pointed out.

being treated at the National Institute of Burn and Plastic Surgery of Dhaka Medical College Hospital, DMCH sources said.

Other injured are her daughter Monika Akhter, 8, brother Imran Hossain, 27, and his wife Jannat, 20, and their daughter Tasfia, 2.

With 20 percent burns, second-grader Monika is in a critical condition, while the rest, who sustained 5 to 10 percent burns, were released from DMCH, the sources added.
