

# Acid attack victims not getting justice

**Says Acid Survivors Foundation**

Although incidents of acid attacks decreased significantly in recent years, the victims are yet to get justice as many perpetrators managed to escape punishment after completion of trials, said participants at a conference yesterday.

The rate of acquittal in acid violence cases is 75 percent in the country, revealed a report of Acid Survivors Foundation at its conference titled "Ensuring Justice in Acid Violence Cases through Speedy Trial" in Brac Centre Inn at Mohakhali of the capital.

The report cited a total of 2,019 cases, in which over 5,000 persons were accused, filed between 2002 and 2015.

Only 12 percent of the perpetrators were arrested in these cases and the rest are at large, read the report.

Hailing from Kishorgonj, Sima, an acid attack survivor, said, "Instead of using the person who was with me during the attack three years back as a witness, they used another witness."

Shah Alam, brother of Yesmin Aktar, who died due to an acid attack, said they had repeatedly asked police to arrest the main culprit, Yesmin's husband Palash, but to no avail.

"Instead of arresting Palash, police asked use to capture him and give him over to them," he claimed.

Justice Iman Ali, a Supreme Court judge, said it is a disgrace to the judiciary that acid survivors were not served justice.

He said the amount of attention special tribunals give to acid cases should be monitored.

Nasrin Begum, additional secretary to the law ministry, urged for comprehensive cooperation among public prosecutors, lawyers and NGOs to ensure justice for victims of acid attacks.

# CU to test aspiring teachers

The Chittagong University authorities have decided to include a written test and a mock lecture session for recruiting teachers.

The decision was taken at a syndicate meeting yesterday.

Now candidates, who fulfil the

CGPA requirement, will have to sit for a written test, face a viva voce and then take a class before they can be selected.

"The decision was taken after allegations surfaced that although some teachers have a very good CGPA, they cannot teach properly in the classroom," said Tanvir Mohammad

Haydar Arif, associate professor and a syndicate member.

The authorities also took a decision to keep the university close on Fridays and Saturdays in line with other public universities.

The decision will be implemented from January, 2016.

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# Six 'JMB men' held in India

Six Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB) members, including the one who is allegedly linked to the Burdwan blast, were arrested from different places of north-eastern Indian state of Assam yesterday, police said.

Law enforcers also recovered arms, ammunitions and army fatigues from their possession.

The arrestees are Monirul Islam alias Boro bhai, Anwar Ali, Ikram Hussain, Abdul Razzak, Mokibul Hossain and Saddam Hossain. They were captured from Baksa, Chirang, Goalpara and Kokrajhar districts, Inspector General of Police LR Bishnoi told the media in Guwahati. Monirul allegedly visited Burdwan in West Bengal before the blasts on October 2 last year and was also attempting to set up training camps for militants in Barpeta district and along the Assam-Meghalaya border, Bishnoi said. Police recovered a revolver along with five bullets from his possession. The arrest of the six "jihadis" was a major breakthrough after the police busted camp in Chirang district on September 15, and arrested 10 "jihadis", the police officer added.
