

# Mother, two girls found dead in Nilphamari

Police recovered dead bodies of a woman and her two daughters from Chowdhury Haat cluster village in Kathali union of Jaldhaka upazila under the district yesterday morning.

It is suspected that the woman, Fency Begum, 32, committed suicide after killing her daughters Aklima, 5, and Khadiza, 3.

Aklima as usual went to the nearby madrasa for study around 7:30am and

returned home after one hour, locals said.

Then Fency's husband Ashraful Islam, 40, a day labourer, bought some snacks, handed it over to daughter Aklima on the way and went to the adjacent village for work.

Hearing no sound from the house for a long time, neighbours became suspicious, peeped through the hole of the bamboo fence of the house and found the woman hanging from the ceiling with a rope.

Entering the room they

also found her two lifeless daughters, wearing new dresses, lying on the bed and informed police.

Due to conflict with his wife, Ashraful stayed with his mother in a different house of the same cluster for several days, said Sohrab Hossain Tuhi, chairman of Kanthali union.

Fency often quarrelled with her husband and on several occasions, neighbours mediated between them, locals said.

It seems that the woman first strangled her two

daughters and then she committed suicide by hanging from the ceiling with a rope, said Dilwar Hasan Inam, officer in charge of Jaldhaka Police Station.

Fency's husband Ashraful Islam filed a murder case with Jaldhaka Police Station accusing unnamed people while police filed an unnatural death case in this connection.

Police sent the bodies to Nilphamari 100-bed Hospital for autopsy at noon.

## 459 PSC answer scripts burnt in 'mysterious fire'

At least 459 answer scripts of recently concluded Primary School Certificate (PSC) examinations were burnt in a mysterious fire at Sadar Upazila Complex on Saturday.

The answer scripts were wrapped in 14 bundles and kept in a room of the upazila complex. Contacted, Tahmina Begum, deputy director of primary education department, in Sylhet division, said it might be an act of sabotage.

A case was filed with Shah Poran Police Station in this connection. Of the 459 answer scripts, 141 were of English and 318 of Bangla and Bishwa Porichoy, Upazila Nirbahi Officer Mahbubur Rahman said.

## Logs of illegally felled trees seized from sawmill

Village police seized huge logs of illegally felled roadside trees from a sawmill at Kulaghat Bazar in Sadar upazila of the district yesterday.

Following a complaint filed by the villagers, the law enforcers rushed to the spot and seized the logs.

Earlier on Saturday, local people stopped a gang from felling another tree beside Kulaghat-Barabari road at Kulaghat village under the upazila in the morning.

A gang of 6/7 allegedly led by one Abu Shahed cut down four big trees beside

the road showing an application signed by the district council administration in last two days, said the villagers.

They have been felling the roadside trees illegally for long with the help of some unscrupulous officials of the district council, alleged locals.

Abdul Jobed, a local Awami League leader, said, "Without any bid paper, the gang felled roadside trees illegally."

They already informed the district council administrator, upazila nirbahi officer and police about the matter.

Shahidul Islam, owner of the sawmill, said local wood trader Abdus Samad kept the logs of the felled roadside trees for sawing them.

Contacted, Abdus Samad said he purchased the logs from local Abu Shahed and his men for Tk 70 thousand.

However, Abu Shahed said they felled the trees getting permission from the district council.

But he kept mum when he was asked if the permission letter was bid paper.

District Council Administrator Matiar Rahman said he will take immediate steps to investigate the matter.

## Minor girl killed after rape

A minor girl was killed after rape at Jodubaira village in Kumarkhali upazila of the district.

Police recovered the body of the girl from a field on Saturday evening. She was identified as Ishita Khatun, 7, daughter of Isharat Ali of the village.

Mohibul Islam, officer-in-charge (OC) of Kumarkhali Police Station, quoting family members of the victim, said Ishita went to nearby Jodubaira field to collect grass for cattle on Saturday afternoon.

As she did not return home until 6:00pm, family members and neighbours went to the field and found her body there.

The OC said primary evidence shows that the girl was raped before being murdered.

## Criminal killed in shootout with rivals in Faridpur

Law enforcers recovered the bullet-hit body of a listed criminal from Piyarpur area of Faridpur town on Saturday night.

The deceased, Shahin Alam alias Hatkata Shahin, 37, son of late Motahar Hossain of Kamlapur area in the town, was a fugitive accused in at least 18 cases filed with different police stations.

He was sentenced to 54 years imprisonment by a Faridpur court in four out of 18

cases, police said.

Kamruzzaman, additional superintendent of police in Faridpur, said they came to know that two gangs of listed criminals were trading bullets on the bypass road around 11:00pm.

A police team led by Sub-Inspector Abhijit Sarker of Kotwali Police Station went to the spot, fired blank shots and dispersed the clashing groups, the ASP added.

Police later found Shahin's bullet-hit body lying on the spot.

## Youth takes own life after killing college boy

A young man committed suicide after killing a college student at Hatosharipur village in Sadar upazila of the district yesterday.

The victim is Sujan Mahmud, a 1st year Commerce student at Kushtia Islamia College and son of Mohabbat Hossain of the village.

Zoynal Abedin, additional superintendent of police (ASP), Kushtia, said Palash Hossain, 22, son of Mintu Sheikh of the same village, swooped on Sujan while he was returning home from the college at around 9:30am. He stabbed Sujan with a chisel, leaving him critically injured.

Sujan was taken to Kushtia General Hospital where he died at around 10:30am.

Palash took shelter at his

grandfather's house, about half a kilometer from the spot, when he was chased by people after the incident. He locked the room from the inside.

On information, a police team from Kushtia Model Police Station and members of the Rapid Action Battalion (Rab)-12 rushed to the spot.

Angry people attacked the house and tried to break the lock of the room to bring Palash out. Failing to pacify them, police fired 7/8 rubber bullets to disperse the mob that left three minor boys injured. Of them, Mehedi Hassan, a six-year-old student of Old Kushtia High School is undergoing treatment at Kushtia General Hospital.

When Palash heard about Sujan's death from inside the room, he hanged himself from the ceiling at around 11:40am.

Police later broke open the door of the room and found Palash hanging from the ceiling.

Police could not unearth clue to the stabbing of Sujan as of 5:30pm yesterday.

The arrestee was later produced before a court which sent him to jail, said police.

### 3 held with pistol, Yaba

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) in separate drives arrested three people with a pistol, two magazines, five bullets and 973 Yaba tablets in Sadar and Shibganj upazilas of the district on Saturday. The arrestees are arms trader Rumon Ali, 19, son of Mostaq Ali of Shibganj, and drug traders Golap Ali, 30, son of Zillur Rahman, and Harun ur Rashid, 23, son of Hasan Ali of Sadar upazila. The arrestees were later handed over to Sadar Police Station, said Rab sources.

### Octogenarian murdered

Police recovered the body of an unidentified elderly man, aged about 80, from Dinajpur branch canal of Teesta Irrigation Project at Horish Chandrapath village in Jaldhaka upazila of the district yesterday. Locals found the body floating in the water in the morning and informed the police. The law enforcers rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Nilphamari 100-bed Hospital morgue for autopsy. Criminals might have strangled the victim as injury marks were found on the throat, said Dilwar Hasan Inam, officer-in-charge of Jaldhaka Police Station.
