## Local MP avoids question about long missing lid

Assures action against those who used the opening last

Shyampur-Kadamtali Shilpa Malik Samity President Syed Abu Hossain Babla yesterday avoided a direct reply over whether the slab of a Shyampur sewer opening in the capital through which a five-year-old fell and drowned on Tuesday had been what locals say missing for years.

Instead, the local lawmaker told The Daily Star that those of the samity responsible for using the opening to clean the sewer last would be identified and legal steps taken for "negligence" in replacing the lid.

Babla said there was no scope for the samity to avert responsibility of the "accident".

One of Nirob Hossain Ismail's playmates pushed him into the around 2.5 feet by 3.5 feet opening of the sewer built by the samity for discharging the area's industrial waste.

Around five hours later, the body was found about a kilometre away at Shyampur Sena Kalyan Ghat, where the sewer empties into the Buriganga river.

Dhaka Medical College's acting head of forensic medicine department Kazi Mohammad Abu Shama said the boy drowned and that minor injuries were found on the skin, inflicted when the body rolled out.

## 4 of Mymensingh, Jamalpur accused arrested

Following warrants against 8; tribunal seeks on Feb 24 progress or probe report in another case against Satkhira Jamaat leader

Police yesterday arrested four Mymensingh and Jamalpur war crimes accused hours after International Crimes Tribunal-1 issued a warrant for eight over their alleged involvement in crimes committed during the 1971 Liberation War.

Rezaul Haque alias Akkas Moulvi was arrested in his Purba Chechia residence in Mymensingh's Muktagachha upazila, Muktagachha Police Station Officer-in-Charge Abu Mohammad Fazlul Karim told The Daily Star's district correspondent.

Rezaul is the superintendent of Chechua Dakhil Madrasa and a former president of Jatiya Party's Muktagachha unit.

Yunus Ali, his brother AKM Yusuf Alam and Omar Faruk are from Chandpur village in Jamalpur's Harinakundu upazila, police and investigators said.

Yunus and Omar were arrested in their village residences while Bagerhat police, in association with Rapid Action Battalion, arrested Yusuf from Dublar Char in Bagerhat, said Abdul Hannan Khan, coordi-

nator of the tribunal's investigation agency. Law enforcers are trying to arrest the rest,

The two-member tribunal led by Justice Md Shahinur Islam issued the warrant following a prosecution's petition. The tribunal's chairman, Justice Anwarul Haque, was on leave.
