WB, Bangladesh on track to solid partnership

A strong partnership could be developed between the World Bank and Bangladesh following the country's recent graduation to the lower middle-income bracket, the chief economist of the multilateral lender said yesterday.

The relationship that is developing with Bangladesh can now be termed partnership, Kaushik Basu said after a meeting with Finance Minister AMA Muhith at the latter's residence in Dhaka.

After decades in the low income bracket, Bangladesh graduated to the lower middle-income status in July.

"The World Bank's relationship with a low income country is very different from that with a lower middle income one -- it is like a partner-

lender adopted the goal under the guise of shared prosperity only three

years ago, Basu said. "I think a great amount of partner-

ship is possible with the World Bank." Asked about the challenges the Bangladesh economy faces, Basu said

every country, whether the US or Bangladesh, has weaknesses.

He cited the country's infrastructure as one of its weak spots: it has developed a lot but much work still remains to be done.

Taxpayers' satisfaction to be gauged

The National Board of Revenue plans to survey taxpayers' level of satisfaction with the services provided by tax officials.

The survey will cover 1,000 firms: 70 percent of them pay tax based on their financial accounts and 30 percent pay tax based on turnover, according to the NBR.

"We will be able to know the extent of satisfaction and dissatisfaction of taxpayers through the survey," said a senior official of NBR.

The tax administrator has launched a tender to hire a company to do the survey by July next year, when the NBR will also start implementing the new VAT and Supplementary Duty Act.

The NBR aims to implement the new law by modernising the VAT administration, restructuring the VAT wing and functional lines and automating the VAT system.

SIM RE-REGISTRATION

NBR may slap tax if details don't match

The National Board of Revenue plans to collect Tk 100 as tax from mobile operators for every SIM for which the users' names and details differ in the reregistration and biometric verification process.

At present, there are about 13.19 crore active SIMs, of which only 30 percent have been registered using the actual subscribers' details, according to industry insiders.

For security reasons, the government has called for re-registration of all SIM cards with information of the actual users from December 16.

If the names differ in the reregistration process, it will be counted as a fresh connection and the NBR wants to slap tax of Tk 100 on each of

them. NBR Chairman Md Nojibur Rahman said a final decision on the issue is yet to be taken. The tax authority will take opinion from the telecom regulator and some other authorities before it makes a call on the issue, he

Mobile operators said the move would lead to "double taxation".

The chief executive officers of all six operators have sent a letter to the NBR demanding a statutory regulatory order exempting tax on SIM cards reregistration by subscribers under the government drive.

A copy of the letter was forwarded to the telecom ministry as well.

The operators said they already paid taxes to the government when the SIM was first bought.

"We have already paid tax for the SIMs and no new sale is taking place here. So the government should consider this," said a senior official of a mobile operator.

Retailers and distributors registered SIMs with certain NID numbers and now the actual users are updating the database with their own NID numbers. A pilot project for SIM re-registration and biometric verification began on

November 15. If the NBR charges them for updating the information, they have no other option but to pass it onto the customers, the operators said.


