

C'NAWABGANJ, MUKTAGACHHA MUNICIPALITIES Mayor aspirants pledge to accept people's verdict

Ten candidates for the posts of mayor of Chapainawabganj and Muktagachha municipalities have pledged to fight corruption and improve civic amenities, if elected in the upcoming polls.

Our Chapainawabganj correspondent reported that five out of six candidates for the post of mayor of Chapainawabganj municipality vowed to make the municipality corruption-free and take up programme to improve civic amenities.

They made the pledge at a face programme with voters organised by Sachetan Nagarik Committee (SANAC), a unit of Transparency International, Bangladesh (TIB), at the playground of Chapainawabganj Government College yesterday afternoon.

The candidates who attended the programme are Samiul Haque Liton of Awami League, Ataur

Rahman of Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP), Moniruzzaman Monir of Jatiya Samajtantrik Dal (Inu), Shahjahan Ali of Jatiya Party, and Abdul Matin, a rebel candidate of BNP and also present mayor.

Nazrul Islam, ameer of district unit of Jamaat, who is contesting as an independent candidate, did not attend the programme.

All the five candidates promised to fulfill their election pledges, if voted to power, and work together for the development of the municipality. They also promised to accept people's verdict in the election.

The mayor candidates also vowed to ensure supply of safe drinking water and development of drainage system and roads.

Selina Begum, president of SANAC of Chapainawabganj unit, presided over the programme while NSM Mahbubur Rahman, member of SNC conducted the

programme. Among others, SANAC members Raihanul Islam Luna, Couri Chand Barman Situ, Golam Farukh Mithun, and Shafiqul Islam, area manager of TIB Chapainawabganj unit, were present.

Our Mymensingh correspondent adds: Five mayor aspirants have taken oath to root out corruption and provide better civic amenities for the people of Muktagachha municipality, if elected.

SANAC Muktagachha upazila unit organised the programme at RK High School ground on Tuesday evening.

The candidates, who took oath, are Abdul Hye Akanda of Awami League (AL), Shahidul Islam Shahid of Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP), Ataur Rahman Lenin of Jatiya Party (Ershad), Shariful Islam Biplob of Jatiya Samajtantrik Dal (JSD) and Debashish Ghosh Bappi (AL rebel).

The candidates also

pledged to improve civic amenities, including smooth supply of safe drinking water and proper drainage system, to make the municipality more livable.

They also told the gathering that they will accept the voters' verdict and will join hands with the elected mayor for all-out development of the municipality.

"We will prevent all sorts of anti-social activities in the area, and provide more facilities for children and women," the mayoral aspirants said.

Presided over by SANAC President Principal Ekhlashur Rahman Jewel, the programme was also attended, among others, by the Chairman of Muktagachha Upazila Parishad SM Zakaria Harun, Headmaster of RK High School Md Nazrul Islam, Muktijoddha Commander Abul Kashem and business leader Shyamol Chandra Saha. Principal Swapon Das, ex-SANAC president conducted the programme.

Bullet-hit man dies at MMCH

An elderly man, who was shot by unidentified criminals at Rajarhat village in Doail union under Sarishabari upazila of the district on Friday night, died at Mymensingh Medical College Hospital (MMCH) yesterday morning.

The deceased was identified as Mozzafar Hossain, 65, of Haatbari village in the upazila.

Police and family sources said Mozzafar Hossain and Abdul Hanif, 50, son of Efaj Uddin, president of ward No 2 unit of the union Awami League, were taking tea at a tea stall in the area at around 7:30 pm.

A gang of masked criminals riding two motorbikes opened fire targeting Hanif. Hanif was shot in the head and died instantly while Mozzafar received bullet injuries in his left leg and stomach, said police.

Mozzafar was admitted to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries at around 6:30am, police said.

On Saturday, Hanif's wife Hasi Begum filed a murder case with Sarishabari Police Station against eight unnamed people, said Billal Uddin, officer-in-charge of the police station.

"We are raiding different areas of the upazila to arrest the culprits," the OC added.

Burglary at Gaibandha ADC's house

Thieves took away cash, gold ornaments and other valuables worth about Tk three lakh from the house of additional deputy commissioner (revenue) at Masterpara in the district town early yesterday.

Police said a gang entered the house, breaking open the door and looted over five tolas of gold ornaments, Tk 54000 and a suitcase from the room of ADC Aleya Khatun.

The burglary took place at midnight when the family members were in deep sleep.

On information, Deputy Commissioner Abdus Samad and the officer-in-charge of Sader Police Station visited the house.

3 traders fined for using plastic sacks

A mobile court here on Tuesday fined three rice traders Tk 30,000 for using plastic sacks instead of jute sacks for rice packaging at Trimohoni in Keshabpur upazila of Jessore district.

The mobile court, led by Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Sharif Raihan Kabir, conducted a drive in the area in the evening and fined Sonali Rice Mill Tk 20,000, Agrani Traders Tk 5,000 and Jani Enterprise Tk 5,000, for using plastic sacks.



Students of different educational institutions in Gouripur upazila of Mymensingh district bought 64 blankets with the money they earned by cutting paddy and distributed them among the cold-hit poor people at Nauha village in the upazila.

2 housewives murdered

Two housewives were killed in Jessore and Chandpur districts yesterday and the day before.

A woman was beaten to death allegedly by her husband and sister-in-law following a family feud at Ashwingri Pukuria village in Chowgachha upazila of Jessore on Tuesday.

The deceased was identified as Rojina Begum, 24, wife of Abdullah of the village, reports our Benapole correspondent.

Khadija Khatun, daughter of the victim, said Rojina and Abdullah locked in an altercation following a family feud at night.

At one stage, Abdullah and his sister Asia Khatun beat up Rojina mercilessly, leaving her seriously injured. Later, they hanged Rojina from the ceiling of her room.

Hearing screams, local people rescued Rojina and took her to Jessore 250-bed Hospital where she died later.

On information, police rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to

Jessore Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Abdullah went into hiding soon after the incident, said Elias Hossain, officer-in-charge of Chowgachha Police Station.

In Chandpur, a housewife was killed by criminals in Balia area of Sadar upazila in the district early yesterday, reports our correspondent.

The dead is Joitun Begum, 32, wife of Kuwait expatriate Md Mizanur Rahman of the area. She was mother of two children.

Family members said a gang of 4/5 entered Joitun's room at midnight and attacked her with sharp weapons.

Critically injured Joitun was rushed to Chandpur General Hospital where on-duty doctors declared her dead.

The body was sent to the hospital morgue for autopsy, said Md Mamunur Rashid, officer-in-charge of Chandpur Model Police Station.

The reason behind the killing could not be known immediately, said family.

Robber gang leader killed in 'gunfight' with Rab in Bagerhat

The ringleader of a robber gang of Sundarbans East Zone was killed in a 'gunfight' with members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) in Panighat area under Sarankhola upazila of the district yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Sagir Bhandari, 35, chief of infamous 'Nayan Bahini', and son of Anwar Hossain Bhandari of Panchakaran village in Moreganj upazila of the district.

Receiving informed that members of 'Nayan Bahini' gathered at Panighat, the elite force in association with detectives took position in the area around 7:30am, said Harun-or-Rashid, assistant director of Rab-6.

Sensing the presence of the Rab men, the gang opened fire, forcing the law enforcers to retaliate, he said.

After 15 minutes of gunfight, members of the gang retreated, said Harun, also a senior assistant police superintendent. Later, Rab members found bullet-hit Sagir in the area.

He was rushed to Sarankhola Upazila Health Complex where the on-duty doctor declared him dead.

Rab personnel also recovered two foreign-made and three country-made firearms, seven bullets and five bullet shells from the spot, according to UNB.

The body of Sagir were later handed over to Sarankhola Police Station.

Sagir, who used to extort the fishermen in Sundarbans, was an accused in several cases filed with different police stations in Bagerhat and Khulna, Rab sources said.
