Rapid Action Battalion yesterday arrested eleven alleged traffickers of women in the capital's Paltan.

Informed by victims of trafficking, a Rab team conducted the drive at HM Trade International and busted the gang.

The team also seized 1,136 passports of women, four computers and printers, a laptop, 214 visa forms, 1,136 training certificates, 22 mobile phones and Tk 2.4 lakh in cash.

Rab-3 officials at a press briefing at its office said three victims, who were sent to Saudi Arabia and Jordan by the gang, returned home, contacted Rab and talked about their hardship abroad.

One of the women described how she was locked and tortured for months in different apartments in the KSA although she was sent with a promise of a job at a hospital.Her husband had to pay more money to the agency to get her back to Bangladesh.

Shajahan gives 72hrs to sand, coal traders to leave Beribadh

Shipping Minister Shajahan Khan yesterday gave 72 hours to the sand and coal traders to free 20km of pathway beside Beribadh in the capital's Mirpur.

"I am angry and I give you three days to clear up the pathway or I will take punitive measures against you," he said while addressing a rally at Gabtoli Bus Terminal.

Dhaka North City Corporation organised the rally to declare roads from Shyamoli to Aminbazar via the terminal free from illegal parking from January 1.

Awami League lawmaker Aslamul Haque recommended bus and truck owners to ensure their own parking space

before expanding their business. He said it was not the government's duty to find parking

space for buses and trucks. In a letter to the lawmaker, the truck owners demanded a

separate terminal for about 1,500 trucks before eviction. Addressing them, he said, "All of you except those using

this terminal have illegally grabbed people's land to park trucks." Aslamul Haque also urged the Dhaka North mayor to

impose three times more tax to house owners of Kalyanpur who rent out ground floors to bus companies for counter services.

Mayor Annisul Huq said, "Illegal parking is not the fault of drivers but of owners."

Khandaker Enayet Ullah, secretary general of Bangladesh Sarak Paribahan Malik Samity, said they would cooperate with the city corporation to keep the main roads free of illegal parking.

He, however, urged the mayor to take problems of transport owners into consideration during eviction.

150 Bangladeshi maids fled from Saudi jobs in 7 months

At least 150 Bangladeshi housemaids escaped from their employers in Saudi Arabia in the last seven months, a Makkah daily reported quoting a source of Bangladesh Embassy.

The source who was not identified said the housemaids were nabbed and deported, according to the Saudi Gazette.

He said the embassy registered three main reasons -- difficult house chores, homesickness and mistreatment by the employers -- behind the fleeing.

The source expected that more house helps will come from Bangladesh in the coming months but the employers who recruited the escapees would not obtain any financial compensation from the recruitment offices.

The source also said a total of 52,000

workers from Bangladesh arrived in the KSA in 2015 and were mostly working in various manual jobs.

Khaled Al-Saif, a recruitment expert, believes that Bangladesh is not in a position to meet the great demand for housemaids in the Kingdom.

Though Bangladesh had promised to send 500,000 house helps when the two countries signed a labour agreement, it sent only 15,000 housemaids including the 150 who escaped, he said.

Most of the workers came through recruitment companies not offices as Bangladesh prefers to deal with the companies because they recruit both male and female workers, Saif further said.

The cost of recruiting a housemaid from Bangladesh has increased from about SR 7,000 to SR 15,000, he added.

Decision on charges on January 28

ARSON CASES AGAINST KHALEDA

A Dhaka court will now decide on January 28 whether to accept the charges brought against BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia and 37 others in two cases filed over an arson attack on a passenger bus.

The arson was carried out on the bus by throwing a petrol bomb in the capital's Jatrabari on the night of January 23 this year. Thirty-one persons suffered burns in the attack and later one of them died.

In yesterday's order, Metropolitan Magistrate Md Maruf Hossain could not scrutinise the case dockets and other relevant documents as he dealt with other cases pending with his court, said sources.

Detectives in May pressed murder and sabotage charges against the accused in the cases filed with Jatrabari Police Station. According to the charge sheets, Khaleda masterminded the attack. In the First Information Report (FIR), Khaleda was not named as an accused. But the FIR mentioned that the attack was carried out on her instructions.

The charge sheets showed Khaleda and 30 others as fugitives as they are not on bail in the cases. Three others, including BNP leader Ruhul Kabir Rizvi Ahmed, are now on bail while the remaining four are in jail.


Gulshan Ara also urged the authorities concerned to recruit 10,000 nurses as per the prime minister's promise in 2011.

gation agency, Abu Saleh, now a central leader of anti-liberation Jamaat, was a commander of a local Razakar Bahini, while the rest were its members in 1971; they took assistance from the Pakistani army for committing atrocities in Gaibandha.

The three charges against them are looting and killing of one Hindu man of Moujamali village in Gaibandha sadar upazila; killing of one Chhatra League leader in Sundarganj upazila; and killing of 13 chairmen and members of five union councils in Sundarganj.
