BSS, Dhaka
The results of Junior School Certificate (JSC) and Junior Dakhil Certificate (JDC) examinations will be published today.
Education Minister Nurul Islam Nahid will announce the results at a press briefing at 1:30pm in his ministry.
A total of 23,25,933 examinees from 28,632 educational institutions appeared in the examinations this year, ministry sources said. A total of 585 students from eight overseas centres appeared in JSC examinations.

Moni Singh's 25th anniversary of death today

Today is the 25th death anniversary of Moni Singh, former president of the Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB).
He was a member of the Advisory Council of the Provisional Government of Bangladesh during the 1971 Liberation War.
Born in Kolkata on July 28, 1901, he shifted to Durgapur in Mymensingh (present Netrakona) with his mother after his father's death. An Independence Award recipient, he died in 1990 at the age of 84.
On the occasion, different organisations, including CPB, will hold different programmes. They will also place wreaths at his monument at Postogola crematorium at 7:00am today. A fair in his memory will begin today and continue till January 6 in Netrakona.

RANA PLAZA COLLAPSE

Rana's four aides sent to jail on surrender

A Dhaka court yesterday rejected bail and sent four accomplices of Sohail Rana to jail after their surrender before it in connection with a murder case filed over the Rana Plaza collapse in Savar in April 2013.
The accused are: Aatur Rahman, Abdus Salam, Biddut Miah and Aminul Islam.
They have been charged with pressuring garment workers to join work even though the building was risky. They had also threatened the

workers to join work or face dismissal, according to the charge sheet.
Senior Judicial Magistrate Al Amin passed the order after they surrendered before the court seeking bail.
Earlier on December 21, the same court took cognisance of the murder charges against Rana Plaza owner Sohail Rana and 40 others.
The court also issued arrest warrants against 24 fugitives that include the four government officials.
At least 1,136 people, mostly gar-

ment workers, were killed and thousands injured in the building collapse that evoked bitter global criticism of the standard of labour and human rights in Bangladesh.
More than two years after the disaster, the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) on June 1 pressed murder charges against 41 people, including Rana, for their alleged role in the incident.
The accused also include Rana's parents, owners of four factories, the then mayor of Savar municipality and 14 government officials.

JU students detain 16 buses for 3hrs over fare dispute

Students of Jahangirnagar University detained 16 buses for three hours at its main entrance outside the capital yesterday following an altercation between a fellow and helper of one of the vehicles of a company.
They released the buses of Welcome Paribahan, which ply Motijheel-Nabinagar route, after its managing director Kalu Sheikh assured the students and the JU authorities of taking action against the helper who misbehaved with the student over fare, campus sources said.

HC scraps challenge to partisan municipal polls

A vacation bench of the High Court yesterday dropped from its hearing list a petition that challenged the legality of political parties' participation in municipality elections.
The bench of Justice Quamrul Islam Siddique and Justice Md Badruzzaman excluded the petition saying that the petitioner can move it before a regular bench after reopening of the court.
Eunus Ali Akond -- a Supreme Court lawyer -- who filed the petition on Tuesday, told The Daily Star that he would move it before a regular bench of the HC on January 3 when it will reopen after its ongoing annual vacation.
He submitted the petition challenging the legality of the Local Government (Pourasabha) Amendment Act-2015, which allows candidates to contest in local government elections under the political banner.
In the petition, he said the provisions of the law are contrary to the constitution as its provisions did not permit political parties to run activities in local government polls.
He prayed to the HC to pass a stay order on publishing results of the municipal elections held yesterday.

3 cocktails found at JU dormitory

On information, police rushed to the spot and recovered the cocktails.
Obaidur Rahman, hall provost, said they would investigate the matter.

Immunisation must be boosted in urban areas

Because those have lower coverage than rural areas, say health experts

Health experts have suggested strengthening immunisation programmes in urban areas of the country as they have lower vaccination coverage than rural areas.
According to the Coverage Evaluation Survey-2014, the rate of valid vaccination coverage for children under 23 months at national level is 81.6 percent. The rate in Dhaka North is 74.1 percent and Dhaka South 74.2 percent. Valid vaccination is administering vaccines on time.
Experts say these figures show the weakness of immunisation programmes in cities where the government has no health staff for this purpose, but rather depends on NGOs.
"We found invalid vaccination in Dhaka city to be quite high, which is a matter of concern," said Dr SK Roy, senior scientist and chairman of Immunization Platform of Civil Society in Bangladesh (IPCSB), a network of 17 NGOs working on immunisation in the capital.
Presenting a study on barriers of valid vaccination of 12-month old babies in Dhaka, he said mothers sometimes lose vaccination cards, do not understand hazy hand writings or forget to take the child to vaccination centres on the recommended day.
The study also found that mothers sometimes find vaccination centres closed, lack awareness or families migrate from one place to another, Dr SK Roy said at a discussion in Cirdap Auditorium in the capital.
Dr Mohammad Quamrul Islam, director of the Institute of Public Health Nutrition, said NGOs and the government together implement immunisation programmes in rural areas, but NGOs alone implement the programmes in urban areas.
Dr Habib Abdullah Sohel, director of Primary Health Care at Directorate General of Health Services, said there is no scope for complacency on immunisation as it remains a big challenge in urban Bangladesh.
Roxana Quader, additional secretary at the health ministry, suggested use of mobile phones and media for mobilization in urban areas to create more awareness.
