19th International Mathematics Conference 2015 at BRACU

In collaboration with Bangladesh Mathematical Society, Mathematics and Natural Sciences (MNS) Department, BRAC University organised the 19th International Mathematics Conference from December 18-20, 2015 in Dhaka. The theme of the conference was "Mathematics: Enigma and Reality".

The inaugural ceremony of the conference was held on December 18, 2015 at BRAC Centre Inn, Mohakhali. Prof. Abdul Mannan, Chairman, UGC of Bangladesh was the chief guest while Prof. Sajeda Banu, President, Bangladesh Mathematical Society was the special guest. Welcome address was delivered by Prof. Munibar Rahman Chowdhury formerly of DU. Prof. A.A.Z. Ahmad, Chair, Organising Committee and Chairperson, Mathematics and Natural Sciences Department, BRACU presided over the ceremony. The invited speakers included Prof. Michel Waldschmidt of Universite Pierre et Marie Curie, France; Dr. Ding Liu of Xidian University, China; Dr. Binayak S.
