AL mayoral candidate rejects results, demands repolling

Supporters of Ragib Hasan Tipu, Awami League (AL) candidate for the post of mayor of Pabna Sadar municipality, barricaded the Pabna bus terminal area, halting movement of vehicles from noon until evening, demanding cancellation of the election result and re-polling in the municipality.

Kamrul Hassan Mintu, independent candidate and also the sitting mayor, won the Pabna municipality election bagging

30,547 votes against Ragib Hassan Tipu's tally of 24,654 votes.

Not accepting the result, Pabna district unit AL, in a press conference held at their office yesterday at noon, claimed the local administration acted against the AL candidate to make the independent candidate win.

"The local administration, including the district administration and police, attacked AL men in different areas. Most voters could not come to voting centres for fear of being

attacked," lawmaker Golam Faruk Khandaker Prince, secretary of Pabna district unit of AL, told journalists at the press conference.

Rejecting the poll result, senior vice president of the district unit of AL, Rejaur Rahim Lal, also the chairman of the election monitoring committee, demanded reelection in Pabna municipality, saying victory for the boat was snatched by the local administration.

Tipu alleged that the district administration

and police supported his rival, and demanded the removal of the DC and the SP of Pabna. He alleged that an industrialist motivated the local administration to help Mintu.

"If the poll result is not cancelled, we will go for a tougher agitation programme," Tipu said.

Refuting the allegation, Additional Deputy Commissioner Munshi Md Moniruzzaman, also the returning officer in the polls, said the claims were baseless.

Mentally challenged mother kills daughter

A five-month-old girl was hacked to death allegedly by her mentally challenged mother at Poyarkandi in Muktagachha municipality area of the district on Tuesday night.

Police and family sources said mentally challenged Moyna Begum, 23, wife of garment worker Shamim Miah of the area, killed her daughter Riya at their house around 9:00pm.

On information, the law enforcers rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.

They later arrested Moyna, said Abu Mohammad Fazlul Karim, officer-in-charge of Muktagachha Police Station.

Moyna had been suffering from mental illness for long, said the OC.

Shops gutted

GPA-5 holders, pass rate rise in Dinajpur

The number of GPA-5 holders and pass rate for Junior School Certificate (JSC) examinations saw a rise this year under Dinajpur Education Board.

The pass rate was 91.52 percent, up from the 90.10 achieved last year, said an official of the board yesterday.

As many as 19,143 students secured GPA-5 this year while the number was

14,420 in 2014.

Tofazzur Rahman, controller of the education board, said 21,381 students from 3,094 high schools in eight northern districts appeared in the examination this year. The examination was held at 245 centres across the eight districts. Of them, 1,95,682 students passed the examination.

The pass rate for the JSC saw a rise of 1.42 percent

since last year, he said.

But the pass rate of female students was higher than for boys. Female students' pass rate was 91.96 while males' pass rate was 91.06 percent under Dinajpur Education Board.

The number of schools with a cent percent pass rate dropped this year.

This year 802 schools achieved a cent percent pass rate, down from 829 last year.

Four held with arms, ammo

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) in separate drives arrested four people and seized three firearms and 10 bullets from their possession in Feni Sadar and Chaudagram upazilas of Comilla early yesterday and on Wednesday night.

A team of Rab-7 from Feni Camp, acting on a tip-off, conducted a drive in Barahipur area under Feni municipality around 6:00am and arrested Emran Hossain, 22.

According to his confession, the elite forces searched his house and recovered a

foreign made pistol and six bullets from there, Major Mozammel Hossain, commander of Feni camp, said.

Rab later filed a case and handed Emran over to Feni Sadar Model Police Station, he added.

On Wednesday, the same team raided Kaichchhati village under Chaudagram upazila around 10:00pm and detained Anwar Bhuiyan, 36, Mir Hossain, 50, and Ismail Hossain, 31, along with a pistol, one revolver, four bullets and 32 Yaba tablets.

After quizzing, the trio were handed over to Chaudagram Police Station the same night, the commander further said.
