

### JMB man arrested in Nachole

Police arrested a member of the banned militant outfit Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB) at Nizampur Station Para in Nachole upazila of the district yesterday.

The arrestee is Mohammad Masum, 25, son of late Abdul Gofur of the village.

Officer-in-Charge Mohammad Fasiuruddin of Nachole Police Station said, law enforcers, acting on a tip-off, rounded Station Para area around 10:00am and arrested Masum when he was visiting his home.

Masum was trying to regroup the organisation in the area, the OC said, adding that he was wanted in three cases, including one under the Anti-terrorism Act.

### 5 traders fined for using plastic bags

A mobile court yesterday fined five trading firms in Saidpur municipality of the district for using plastic bags instead of jute bags for packaging rice and other commodities.

The firms are Messrs Jonaki Store, Messrs Nasim Store, Messrs Sayed Store, Messrs Abdul Gani Store and Messrs Guddu Store in the municipality.

Abu Saleh Md Musa Jongi, upazila nirbahi officer (UNO) of Saidpur upazila, led the mobile court along with a police team and raided the trading centres at around 11:30am.

During the raid, he found violation of the packaging rule that makes use of jute bags mandatory for packaging some specified goods.

He fined each of the traders Tk 15 thousand, which they paid instantly.

The UNO said that he gave light punishment to the traders as they gave him commitment not to use plastic bags again in packaging those goods in future.

He said stern action would be taken against them if they didn't follow the packaging rules.

ATM Taibur Rahman, chief jute inspector of Nilphamari district, accompanied the mobile court.

### Outlaw murdered

Police recovered the severed body and head of an alleged outlaw from Sadar upazila in the district yesterday morning.

The dead is Firoj Hossain, 40, a top cadre of outlawed Gono Mukti Fouz, and son of Gias Uddin of Pashchim Abdalpur in the upazila.

Obaidur Rahman, sub-inspector of Kushtia Model Police Station, said locals found his detached head near Balipara School and College in Alampur area around 9:30am.

Police later recovered the body three kilometers away, he said.

The law enforcers later sent the head and body to Kushtia General Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Firoj was accused in 14 cases, including four for murder, said SI Obaidur.

Intra-party rivals might have killed him, he said.

### 2 kids drown in pond

Two kids drowned in a pond at Chandra village in Keshabpur upazila of Jessore district yesterday morning.

The deceased are Samir Hossain, 4, son of Abdul Alim, and Siam Ali, 5, son of Khokon Gazi of the village.

Family sources said the duo fell into the pond near their house while playing on its bank and drowned.

Later, local people recovered the bodies from the pond after a frantic search.

## Post-polls violence leaves 20 hurt in Sirajganj

### 2 Trishal AL men arrested in connection with Friday night's incident

At least 20 people were injured in post-polls violence in Bahirgola area under Sadar upazila of Sirajganj district yesterday.

The men of elected councillor Shahadat Hossain and defeated councillor candidate Shahdat Hossain Buddin had an altercation around 12 noon.

At one stage, the rival groups attacked each other with lethal weapons, leaving at least 20 people from both sides injured.

The injured include Jahangir Hossain, 45, Mohabbat Ali, 38, Piar Khan, 40, Shariful Islam, 30, Ismail Hossain, 25, Sabuj, 36, Selim, 35, Rabiul Islam, 35, Bani Hossain, 28, Munna, 30, Roky, 20, and

Bijoy, 28, of Bhangabari village in the upazila.

Failing to get elected, the men of defeated councillor candidate carried out the attack, alleged elected councillor Shahadat.

Contacted, Buddin refuted the allegation of attacking the men of Shahadat.

The situation is now under control, said Habibur Islam, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station.

In Mymensingh, police yesterday arrested two Awami League activists on charge of killing a Jubo League man in Trishal municipality of the district the day before, in an apparent post-election violence.

The arrestees are Chand Miah, 35, and Mazharul

Islam Sumon, 30, loyal to rebel AL candidate ABM Anisuzzaman.

The victim, Md Parvez, 23, a member of Ward No 3 unit of Jubo League, was hacked to death on Friday.

Parvez, loyal to defeated AL mayor candidate Jahidul Islam Sarker, was attacked allegedly by supporters of Anisuzzaman, winner AL rebel candidate in the municipality, at night.

Two other Jubo League activists -- Asar Ali, 22, and Delwar Hossain Delu, 22 -- were also injured in the attack.

A gang of 15/20 attacked Parvez on his way home around 10:20pm, leaving him dead on the spot, said Md Moniruzzaman, officer-in-charge of Trishal Police Station.

### One killed over land dispute

A man was killed and another injured in a clash between two rival groups over taking possession of a disputed land in Nakla upazila of the district yesterday.

The deceased is Md Azizul Haque, 28, son of Abdul Kuddus, a resident of Hasonkhila village in the upazila.

Quoting the villagers, police said there had been a longstanding dispute over the ownership of 15 decimals of land between Fazr Ali, 65, and his cousin Rais Uddin, 60, of the village.

Around 11:00am, an altercation took place between Fazr Ali and Rais when Fazr prevented Rais and his men from uprooting his Boro plants from the disputed land.

At one stage, Rais and his men attacked Fazr's son Sekandar Ali, 30, and son-in-law Azizul with machetes, leaving them critically injured.

The duo were admitted to Nakla Upazila Health Complex and then referred to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital as their condition deteriorated.

Azizul succumbed to his injuries at the hospital around 2:00pm.

Contacted, Officer-in-Charge Golam Haider of Nakla Police Station said Azizul's wife filed a case with the police station yesterday evening, accusing Rais Uddin and eight others.

Police have already launched a drive to arrest the accused, the OC said.

### Mob beats up 6 'cow lifters' in Chuadanga

A mob beat up six suspected cow lifters, leaving them severely injured at Jamjami village in Alamdanga upazila of Chuadanga district early yesterday.

The six are Saheb Ali, 45, Abul Kalam, 45, Intazul, 30, Gaffar Hossain, 30, Faksar Mondol, 50 of Dhupatila; and Shamim Ahmed, 25, of Pouro area of Chuadanga town.

Atiar Rahman, officer-in-charge (OC) of Alamdanga Police Station, said around 100 villagers encircled the six at Jamjami field beside Kushtia-Chuadanga highway after hearing that they had stolen two cows from the houses of Rezaul Islam and Amzad Hossain in the upazila, and loaded the cows onto a truck bound for Dhaka at around 4:30am.

The angry villagers beat them up mercilessly.

Being informed, police from Alamdanga Police Station rushed to the spot and rescued them. They were later admitted to Alamdanga Upazila Health Complex.

However, local sources said they were cattle traders not thieves. They collected cattle from different houses and bazars and sent them to Dhaka.

### Pirojpur JCD leader held

Police arrested a Chattral Dal leader from a procession in Pirojpur town yesterday morning.

The arrestee is Md Badiuzzaman Sheikh Rubel, president (in charge) of Pirojpur municipality unit of JCD and son of Md Aslam Sheikh of the town.

JCD brought out a procession from BNP district unit office at 11.30am, marking the 37th birth anniversary of the organisation after cutting of a birthday cake and a discussion meeting.

Cops picked up Rubel from the procession when it came in front of Rose Garden Restaurant in the town.

Md Enayet Hossain, officer-in-charge of Pirojpur Sadar Police Station, said Rubel is an accused in several cases and had been in hiding to avoid arrest.

## Now BNP rejects polls result in Pabna municipality

### Earlier the AL aspirant demanded re-polling as independent candidate won

The local leaders of BNP have rejected the December 30 poll result in Pabna municipality, two days after the ruling Awami League (AL) did the same.

Both the parties blamed the district administration and the police for acting in favour of independent candidate Kamrul Hassan Mintu, also the sitting mayor, although the election was generally acclaimed as an impartial and peaceful one.

Mintu won the election by bagging 30,547 votes against AL candidate Ragib Hassan Tipu's 24,654 votes and BNP candidate Nur Mohammad Masum Boga's

7,444 votes.

The matter created tension among the local leadership of both AL and BNP.

"The independent candidate won the municipal polls on December 30 through election engineering with the help of the local administration. Our agents could not know the result at the centres," Boga told the journalists in a press conference at Pabna Press Club yesterday.

Due to interference by the administration, BNP men could not go to the centres, he alleged.

President of Pabna district unit of BNP KS Mahmud chaired the press conference.

Earlier, AL's mayoral aspirant Ragib Hasan Tipu rejected the poll result.

Pabna district unit of AL in a press conference at their office on Thursday noon claimed that the local administration acted against the AL candidate to make the independent candidate winner.

Demanding re-polling, his supporters also put barricade in Pabna bus terminal area, halting movement of vehicles for a couple of hours on Thursday afternoon.

Pabna Additional Deputy Commissioner Munshi Md Moniruzzaman, also the returning officer in the polls, termed the allegations baseless.

## Abducted man found dead

Law enforcers recovered the body of man from Shidhui Jiri area in Alikadom upazila of the district on Friday night, two days after his

alleged abduction.

The deceased is Borhan Uddin, 55, of Pan Bazar area in the upazila.

Quoting victim's family members, Alikadom Zone Commander Lt Col Sarwar of Bangladesh Army said

armed criminals abducted Borhan from the upazila headquarters around 12:00noon on Wednesday.

Locals spotted Borhan's body in a ditch beside Thanchi-Alikadom road and informed the police.

## Fake doctor caught in Pabna

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) arrested a fake doctor from Ichhamati Clinic, a leading private clinic in Pabna town, yesterday.

The arrestee, Md Golam Mostafa, 44, son of Ibrahim Sarkar of Aramghata village in Khulna Sadar upazila, had been working as a doctor at the clinic for a long time, although he has no medical certificate, Rab said.

"Acting on a tip-off, a team of Rab in the guise of patients caught Golam

Mostafa when he was checking the patients at the clinic," said Md Abdul Hai, commander of Rab-12 Pabna camp. The arrestee could not show medical

certificate or a licence as medical practitioner, the Rab commander said.

Mostafa also worked at different clinics in other districts during the last two years, Rab sources said. Abdur Rahman, owner of the clinic, managed to escape from the spot during the drive.

Pabna Civil Surgeon Dr Shahed Md Sadikul Islam said the district health administration had earlier fined different clinics for not having qualified doctors, but most of them still do not comply with the requirement.

## Criminals fell 100 banana trees in Rangpur

Criminals felled banana trees and uprooted potato and wheat plants on 75 decimals of land at Gaburar Char village under Pargachha upazila of the district on Thursday.

Police and villagers said there was a longstanding conflict between Abdul Jalil, 45, and Sayeed Ali, 50, of the village over the ownership of two acres and eight decimals of land.

On Thursday noon, a group of people, including

Sayeed Ali, Taleb Mian, 55, Hamid Mian, 53, Zafar Mian, 60, Maham Mian, 57, and Shukkur Ali, 45, went to the land and felled over 100 banana trees and uprooted potato and wheat plants cultivated by Jalil on the land.

Jalil said Sayeed threatened him with death over mobile phone as he told the police about the matter. Jalil claimed that his loss could go up to Tk 1.1 lakh.

Md Nazir Hossain, chairman of Chhaola Union Parishad (UP) in the upazila demanded exemplary punishment of the culprits.

Tajul Islam, sub-inspector of Pargachha Police Station, said he visited the spot on Friday and found that the villagers were trying to settle the issue.

No case in connection with the incident was filed the police station concerned as of 5:00pm yesterday.

Contacted, Md Aminul Islam, officer-in-charge of Pargachha Police Station, said police would take necessary steps if the victim filed a written complaint in this regard.
