The people of Pabna, the home district of Jamaat-e-Islami chief Motiur Rahman Nizami, are expecting that the Supreme Court will uphold his death sentence for crimes against humanity during the 1971 Liberation

However, eight prosecution witnesses (PWs) from Santhia upazila, who testified to the war crimes tribunal against Nizami, are worried about the possible acts of vengeance by Jamaat men as the verdict on the appeal against capital punishment of the war crime convict is set to be delivered today.
