## Man crushed to death by locomotive after train derails

A man died after the locomotive of a train fell on him beside the railway tracks as it derailed near Narsingdi station last night.

At least 100 passengers were injured while they were getting down hurriedly. The deceased, Babul, was a rickshaw-puller in Hasnabad area of Raipura upazila.

Witnesses said the Akhaura-bound train was passing through the track following a "wrong signal" and the driver tried in vain to stop it. The derailment snapped Sylhet-Chittagong rail communication for around two hours.

## MP slammed for land 'grabbing' Superintendent of Police Abdur Rahim

According to the report, Akul on June 10 last year sowed plants on his land, but some people loyal to the lawmaker allegedly destroyed those by cultivating the land that afternoon. Mazharul even threatened Akul a week later, the investigation report says.

Later on June 19, 25-30 people led by Mazharul chased Akul, Bhakaram Singh and Janok Chandra Singh with hand-made weapons. Akul eventually fled to India for shelter. Eight to 10 men and some other people

were injured in the attack, the report says. Denying the allegation, lawmaker

Dabirul told our Thakurgaon correspondent that it was totally false and baseless. A vested quarter is trying to tarnish his image by spreading such rumours, he alleged.

Deputy Commissioner of Thakurgaon Mukesh Chandra Biswas said he along with

Shah Chowdhury visited the spot seven months ago following the allegations. "Practically, we didn't find any truth

behind the allegation of grabbing land by the lawmaker," he said. He also said they did not find any evi-

dence of torture on the minority people. However, Jiten Chandra Singh, one of the

victims who lost two bighas of land, told reporters at the press conference that his college going son Ovilal Singh had fled to India following the attack.

Bangladesh should not continue any relation with Pakistan because of its heinous role during the 1971 War of Liberation, said Dhaka University Vice Chancellor Prof AAMS Arefin Siddique yesterday, reports BSS.

He was addressing a discussion, organised by Bangabandhu Parishad, at the capital's Jatiya Press Club, marking Homecoming Day of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman. Meanwhile, member of Advisory Council of Awami

League Dr SA Malek said no unity would be forged with those who had patronised terrorism. Malek, also general secretary of the parishad, criticised

the call of BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia to form a national

Prof ABM Faruge, former dean of DU pharmacy faculty, among others, addressed the discussion.

Our staff correspondent adds, Imran H Sarker, spokesperson of a faction of Gonojagoron Mancha, yesterday issued an ultimatum to the government to sever diplomatic relations with Pakistan within 72 hours.

Or else, the Pakistan high commission in Dhaka would be besieged, he threatened at a rally at Shahbag in Dhaka.

He said there was no chance to show mercy or compromise if any country assaulted the dignity of Bangladesh. "So we think the government should take a bold step right now," he said, adding that neither Pakistan and the United States nor any other country did have the right to talk about or look into the internal affairs of Bangladesh.


# Smuggling hurting economy: SK Sinha
