China GDP growth seen slowing to weakest pace since 2009

China is expected to post its weakest economic growth since the global financial crisis in the fourth quarter, adding pressure on policymakers to take more steps to ward off a sharper slowdown that could jolt global markets.

markets and the yuan have stoked concerns among global investors about the health of the world's second-biggest economy, although analysts see few signs of an abrupt drop-off in activity.

Growth in fourth-quarter gross domestic product likely slowed to 6.8 percent from the same period last year, down from 6.9 percent in the third quarter, according to a Reuters poll of 50 economists.

That would be the weakest pace of expansion since the first quarter of 2009, when growth tumbled to 6.2 percent.

7.1 percent and the lowest was 5.3 percent, though some investors fear current growth levels could already be much weaker than the official data will suggest.

"The weaknesses in both domestic and external demand have exacerbated the deflationary pressures in the economy," economists Qu Hongbin and Julia Wang at HSBC said in a note.

"Going into 2016, weak domestic as well as external demand will continue to weigh on growth."

Economic growth for the full year is expected to have cooled to its slowest pace in 25 years of 6.9 percent in 2015 from 7.3 percent in 2014, a central bank work paper said recently.

Beijing's growth target for 2015 was "around" 7 percent, with the government rejecting suggestions that the figures were being inflated to meet official forecasts.

While the government is expected to lean more on fiscal policy to support growth this year, the central bank may still need to keep monetary pol-

US, major automakers to announce safety accord

The US government and a group of leading global automakers are set to announce a groundbreaking voluntary agreement at the Detroit auto show on Friday aimed at dramatically improving the industry's safety, according to company officials.

The unprecedented accord could set the framework for further discussions on safety reforms and mark a new era of cooperation between automakers and regulators after a record-setting year of safety fines, recalls and investigations into malfunctioning vehicles made by General Motors Co, Fiat Chrysler Automobiles NV, Honda Motor Co and others.

The agreement, under discussion for several weeks, would also attempt to improve vehicle cyber security and the use of early-warning data to detect potential defects that might lead to safety problems or large-scale recalls, sources said.

The accord would be voluntary, but industry watchers said regulators would expect automakers to stick to their undertakings.

Automakers recalled a record-setting 63.95 million vehicles in the United States in 2014, incurring large fines from the US National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

Companies in the talks leading up to the agreement include GM, Toyota, Ford Motor Co, Daimler AG, Fiat Chrysler, BMW AG, Honda, Nissan Motor Co and Hyundai Motor Co.

Earlier in 2009, the BB set up a Tk 200 crore revolving fund for the banks and other financial institutions to disburse low-interest loans for solar energy, biogas and effluent treatment plants.
