

8 MYMENSINGH WAR CRIMES ACCUSED JP MP, son seeks bail

Progress report submitted, formal charges sought March 22 in another case against 5 from Moulvibazar

Jatiya Party lawmaker MA Hannan and his son Rafique Sajjad yesterday sought bail in a case accusing them and six other Mymensingh men of committing crimes during the Liberation War in 1971.

The duo's counsel Mizanul Islam reasoned before International Crimes Tribunal-1 that Hannan was aged and, as a sitting lawmaker, wanted to take part in an ongoing parliament session while the duo were not mentioned in the primary charges. Prosecutor Sultan Mahmud Simon opposed the petition and the three-member tribunal led by Justice Anwarul Haque fixed February 4 to pass an order.

Meanwhile, Prosecutor Rezia Sultana Chaman submitted a progress report regarding investigations against the eight men and sought four months to complete the probe. The court granted time till March 23.

Hannan, the alleged general secretary of Mymensingh district Peace Committee; his son Rafique Sajjad, Khandakar Golam Sabbir Ahmed, Mizanur Rahman Mintu and Hormuj Ali are now in jail. Mohammad Abdus Sattar, Mohammad Fakruzzaman and Khandakar Golam Rabbani are on the run.

Moreover, the tribunal directed the prosecution to submit on March 22 formal charges, if they have any, against five men of Moulvibazar's Rajnagar upazila over their alleged involvement in crimes committed in 1971.

Yesterday was fixed for the submission but Prosecutor Mohammad Ali said he received the investigation reports and other documents on January 21 and needed two months to scrutinise those before making the submission.

On January 20, the tribunal's investigation agency completed the probe against them and said to have found evidence of their "involvement" in six incidents of crimes.

Yunus Ahmed, 71, and Ujer Ahmed Chowdhury, 63, are in jail while Samsul Hossain Tarafder, 65, Nesar Ali, 75, and Mobarak Mia, 66, on the run.

Hospital in Dhaka fined Tk 6 lakh

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab-1) fined Regent Hospital Limited in the capital's Uttara Tk 6 lakh for different anomalies yesterday.

The court found anomalies including using date expired reagents in pathology department, technician's signature on pathology reports instead of doctor and unapproved blood bank, says a Rab-1 press release.

Firoz Ahmad, executive magistrate conducted the drive in presence of Dr Manzur Ahmad, assistant director of health department.

Ahsan Habib Majumdar, director of the hospital, said there was a date expired reagent by mistake, and added, they don't operate blood bank, attendants of an emergency patient stored a bag of blood and left it at the hospital while they left. Also, in emergency, technician signs the medical report in absence of doctor when patients need it urgently.

Kaizen from Japan brings innovation

A small initiative can bring a remarkable change in public services.

It was a big challenge to give wheat farmers proper value for their crops as the market is controlled by business syndicate.

But Sabet Ali, upazila nirbahi officer of Nilphamari sadar decided to bring a change. He helped them to identify the appropriate times amid market changes to sell the wheat.

"Farmers are now not only benefited, they are also delighted," he said at a national convention.

Sabet was inspired by "Kaizen", an initiative adopted by both the governments of Bangladesh and Japan for continuous improvement of public services.

Kaizen means "change for better" in Japanese.

The National Kaizen Convention was held yesterday at the capital's Sonargaon hotel to share field experiences, award field level officers for their dedication and declare the One Year One Project initiative nation-wide.

Bangladesh Public Administration Training Centre (BPATC) and Japan International Cooperation Agency (Jica) jointly organised the convention. The Daily Star was the strategic partner of the event.

Both the governments are working together to enhance public services in Bangladesh through total quality management, with a five-year (2013-18) project with focus on Kaizen.

Apart from Sabet, seven government officials also received awards for bringing changes.

Ismat Ara Sadique, state minister for public administration said, "Serving people should be the main motto...I strongly hope all upazila offices will implement at least one Kaizen each year."

Sust teacher sued for reckless driving that killed two

A case has been filed against Prof Dr Ariful Islam of Shahjalal University of Science & Technology (Sust), in connection with a road crash that killed two people on campus on Saturday.

College teacher Ataur Rahman and his uncle Gias Uddin were killed when Ariful's car knocked them down near the campus. Ataur's daughter, Selina, was also injured in the incident.

Deceased Ataur's wife filed the case under

sections 279, 304 and 388 of the penal code with Jalalabad Police Station on Sunday night.

Witnesses said Prof Ariful, head of Mechanical Engineering department, was driving the car while his driver sitting beside when the accident took place.

Ariful and his family went into hiding after the incident and his phone was switched off, said police.

Prof Kamruzzaman Chowdhury, Sust proctor, said an investigation body was formed in this regard.
