The first month of 2016 saw 84 incidents of rape including seven gang rapes, reads the monthly Violence Against Women (VAW) data gathered by Bangladesh Mahila Parishad (BMP). The number of rapes almost doubled compared to January 2015, when BMP data showed 48 rapes had been

VAW incidents in January also increased from that of December 2015 with a total VAW incident of 320, as per BMP report.

The women's rights organisation gathers data from reports published in 14 national Bangla and English dailies. Rape as usual was the most frequent crimes committed against women.

Among other significant VAW incidents last month were 70 murders, 38 mysterious deaths, 33 physical tortures and 28 child marriages.

Why smoking in public places not being stopped

The High Court yesterday issued a rule upon the government to explain in four weeks why it should not be directed to enforce two sections of the tobacco control act to stop smoking in public places.

The bench of Justice Quamrul Islam Siddique and Justice Razik-Al-Jalil came up with the rule following a writ petition.

Secretaries to the ministries of health, law, and home, and the director general of Directorate General of Health Services, inspector general of police and the director general of the department of narcotics control have been made respondents to the rule, Deputy Attorney General Mokhlesur

Rahman told The Daily Star.

Supreme Court lawyer Shammi Akhter recently filed the petition saying owners, caretakers or controllers, and managers of public places and transports will have to mark a separate smoking zone there as per section 7 of the act.

As per section 8, they will have to put up signboards asking people to refrain from smoking in public places, and mentioning that smoking in such places is a punishable offence, she said. The authorities concerned are also violat-

ing the provisions of the law by not taking necessary steps to stop smoking in public places, she added in the petition.

JR Khan Robin appeared for the petitioner.

"We questioned the other girl, aged around 13 years, to learn about the incident," said Mashiur.

"The parents of the teenage girl heard about the incident from a girl who worked in another apartment in the neighbourhood. They said they want do not want any part of it and refused to visit their daughter," the OC added.

The teenage mother dropped the baby through the window of the flat, wrapping him in a plastic shopping bag, in fear of social stigma. The baby fell on the roof of a nearby tin-roof shop.

Hearing his screams, local shopkeepers rescued and took him to Ad-din Women's Medical College Hospital in Moghbazar.

"Forensic test was conducted yesterday and we will conduct test to identify her age today," said Bilkis Begum, onestop crisis centre coordinator. Sample from the baby would be collected for identifying his father through DNA tests later, Bilkis told The Daily Star.

"Two cases will be filed. One against the girl for attempting to murder the baby and another against the brother-inlaw for alleged rape," she said.




