Gunfight over land dispute leaves 30 hurt in Sylhet

At least 30 people were injured during a gunfight between two groups of villagers over a land dispute in Shahjigaon village under Bishwanath upazila of Sylhet district on Monday night.

Of the injured, 12 were admitted to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital while the rest to Bishwanath Upazila Health

Complex. Quoting locals, police said there had been a long-standing dispute between Manik Miah and Mustab Ali of the village over the ownership of a piece of land.

Following an altercation over the issue, the supporters of the two rival groups traded gunshots, leaving at least 30 people from both sides injured.

Informed by locals,

police rushed to the spot, dispersed the clashing groups and brought the situation under control.

No case was filed with Bishwanath Police Station as of filing of this report at 5:00pm yesterday.

Md Masudur Rahman, officer-in-charge (investigation) of the police station said police have been deployed in the area to avert further clash.

Female schoolteacher held on extortion charge

Meherpur police yesterday arrested a schoolteacher on charge of her involvement in extortion of Tk 89,174 from a local trader.

The arrestee is Nawrin Ferdous, assistant teacher of Terail Government Primary School in Gangni upazila of Meherpur district.

Victim Aftab Hossain, owner of Yasin Medicine Corner at Gangni Bazar,

alleged that Nawrin introduced herself as a member of a local gang and demanded Tk 2 lakh from him over cellphone several days ago.

"The woman also threatened to kill me if I informed police about the matter. Later, I paid Tk 89,174 through bKash in the mobile number she used," said Aftab.

Aftab informed Gangni police about the matter when the woman demanded more money

and continued threat for the last three days, said Akram Hossain, officer-in-charge of Gangni Police Station.

After tracking her mobile calls, police arrested the woman from the school.

During primary investigation, the arrestee confessed to her involvement in the incident.

The schoolteacher was later produced in a court that sent her to jail, said the OC.

Train kills Krishak League man

A local Krishak League leader was killed when he was hit by a speeding train at Naoapara in Abhoynagar upazila of Jessore district on Monday. The deceased was identified as Atiar Rahman Molla, 50, executive member of the upazila unit of Krishak League, and son of Abul Hossain of Guakhola village in the upazila. Nasir Uddin, officer-in-charge of Abhoynagar Police Station, said a Jessore-bound train hit Atiar, leaving him critically injured around 8:00pm when he was crossing the rail tracks. He was rushed to the upazila health complex where on-duty doctors declared him dead, said the OC.

Labourer electrocuted

A day labourer was electrocuted in Benapole check post area of Jessore district yesterday morning. The deceased is Khorshed Alam, 29, son of Chanu Mia, of Boalia village under Benapole Port Police Station. Police and witnesses said Khorshed came in contact with a live electric wire when he was working at a house in the area. He died on the spot, said Apurbo Hasan, officer-in-charge of the police station.

10 maunds of jatka seized

Bangladesh Coastguard seized 10 maunds of jatka from a passenger launch at Tetulbaria ghat under Pathorghata upazila of Barguna district on Monday. On secret information, a team of coastguard raided MV Nasir, a Barguna-bound launch from Taltali upazila, around 9:00pm and seized the jatka. However, none was arrested in this connection, said Lt. Syed Abdur Rouf, Pathorghata station commander. The seized jatka was later distributed among the poor and orphans, he said.

20 hurt in AL infighting

At least 20 people were injured in a clash between two factions of Awami League over establishing supremacy at Baliadi in Mohammadpur upazila of the district on Monday evening. Officer-in-Charge of Mohammadpur Police Station Riazul Islam said Yunus Shikder, a leader of Baliadi union unit of AL, had long been at loggerheads with another leader Kanchan Biswas over establishing dominance in the area. As a sequel to the conflict, a brawl ensued between the supporters of both the groups in the evening. At one stage, the men of both rivals equipped with lethal weapons attacked each other, leaving 20 people from both sides injured, the OC added. On information, police rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control. A case was filed in this connection.

Jamaat man held

Police arrested a leader of Jamaat-e-Islami from Choumohani area in Dupchanchia upazila of the district on Monday. He was arrested on sabotage charges, said Officer-in-Charge of Dupchanchia Police Station Nazrul Islam. The arrestee was later produced in a court that sent him to jail.

26 expelled for cheating in exam

Five teachers and 21 students were expelled from a Dhakhil examination centre at Kalish-Punail Fazil Madrasa under Nandigram upazila of the district yesterday during Arabic second paper examination. Anwar Imam, upazila nirbahi officer (UNO) and executive magistrate, expelled the teachers and students while visiting the exam centre. The expelled teachers are assistant teacher Abdul Hakim of Islampur Dhakhil Madrasa, Ayub Ali of Acholota Alim Madrasa, Abdur Rahim of Bizrul Fazil Madrasa, Tozzammel Haque of Shara Dhakhil Madrasa, and Mohsin Ali of Kalish Alim Madrasa in the upazila. Upazila administration sources said, acting on a tip-off regarding random copying in the exam centre, the UNO immediately rushed to the centre and caught the students red-handed while they were cheating and the teachers were helping them. Contacted, Anwar Imam said that the students were cheating in the exam centre and the teachers were helping them.

Robbers loot jewellery shop in Munshiganj

Robbers looted gold and silver ornaments and cash from a jewellery shop at Baluchar Bazaar in Sirajdikhan upazila of the district early yesterday.

Sub-Inspector Md Waheduzzaman of Sirajdikhan Police Station said a gang of 20/25 armed robbers arrived at the bazaar at around 2:00am and tied 15/16 people, including two night guards, at gunpoint.

They then entered the shop of one Babul Rajbangshi and looted gold and silver ornaments and Tk 10 thousand from a safe by breaking its lock, the SI said.

As a shop owner informed the local people of the matter through a loudspeaker of a mosque, the gang members fled the scene.

Police could not arrest any of the gang as of 5:00pm yesterday.

Man kills daughter, takes own life in Mymensingh

Schoolgirl commits suicide in Jessore

A man allegedly committed suicide after killing his one-and-a-half-years old daughter at Boroichala village in Bhaluka upazila of the district yesterday.

The deceased were identified as Jamil Hossain, 40, a rickshaw-van puller of the village and his daughter Rabeya Begum.

Quoting Jamil's wife Rokeya Begum police said Jamil had been suffering from deep depression for the last few days as he was facing trouble in repaying the loans he had taken.

Out of the depression, Jamil first killed Rabeya by

slitting her throat with a knife and then stabbed himself with the same weapon around 6:30am, Officer-in-Charge Mamun-or-Rashid of Bhaluka Police Station said.

Hearing hue and cry, neighbours went to the spot and took Jamil to Bhaluka Upazila Health Complex. He died on way to the hospital around 7:00am, the OC added.

On information, police recovered the bodies and sent those to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital for autopsy.

Away in Jessore, a schoolgirl committed suicide allegedly over a family feud at Balidha

village in Monirampur upazila on Monday night, reports our Benapole correspondent.

The deceased, Lipi Khatun, 14, daughter of Fazlur Rahman, was a Class IX student at Balidha High School.

Quoting Fazlur Rahman police said Lipi had an altercation with her mother over a trifling matter on Monday night.

At one stage, she went to her room and later hanged herself with a scarf from the ceiling of the room around 9:30pm.

Police recovered the body and sent it to Jessore Medical College Hospital for autopsy.
