

Rab rescues 2-day-old child, arrests 4 trying to sell it

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) yesterday arrested four people for attempting to sell a two-day-old child in the capital's Shantibagh area.

The arrestees are Salma Akhter, 32, Anwara, 44, Md Babu, 35, and Saiful Islam, 35, said a press release.

In a primary investigation, the arrestees informed that the mother of the child was Bina, 19, of Badda area, whom Salma, convinced in giving up her child for his good upbringing.

A Rab aide feigning interest for the baby offered the gang Tk 100,000. After they struck a deal, the gang revealed the address of the house. A Rab team raided the house and rescued the infant. The infant was returned to his mother and undergoing treatment at Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

Two child marriages prevented

A mobile court yesterday foiled two attempted child marriages in Natore sadar upazila.

The court, led by Nairuzzaman Khan, Natore sadar upazila nirbahi officer, rushed to Islabari and stopped the attempted marriage of Bilkis Khatun, 13, daughter of Abdur Razzak of the village, then went to Haguria village and foiled the attempted marriage of Monia Khatun, a seventh grade student and daughter of Mamtaz Uddin of the village.

Later, the parents signed an undertaking of not marrying off their daughters until they turn 18.

Man dies after being hit by car

Kaniz Fatema Mohsina passes away

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday visited the residence of late Kaniz Fatema Mohsina, the daughter of late Syed Nawsher Ali, the first speaker and health minister of undivided Bengal, in the capital's Dhanmondi.

Mohsina, wife of late Hatem Ali Khan, the first chief engineer of the Roads and Highways Department, and mother of Haidar Akbar Khan Rono, a presidium member of Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB), died of old-age complications yesterday morning, aged 92.

The Prime Minister had a glimpse of the body of Mohsina to show her last respect and joined a munajat seeking eternal peace for her departed soul.

Govt to introduce Nat'l e-Service Bus

The government is going to introduce National e-Service Bus to ensure sharing of digital information, improve e-services accessibility and facilitate interoperability of inter-government agencies.

The e-Service will be a software driven middleware platform, State Minister for ICT Zunaid Ahmed Palak told the news agency.

The UK based Ernst and Young, appointed by the World Bank financed Leveraging ICT for Growth, Employment and Government (LIGT) of Bangladesh Computer Council (BCC), has been providing technical support to establish the e-Service under Bangladesh National Enterprise Architecture (BNEA). "This will not only remove hassle to access e-services but also help reducing cost of an organisation or individual to develop software, data and statistics," said Palak.

Executive Director of BCC SM Ashraf Islam said some government organisations spent huge amount of money to gather information and develop database separately. If they established connection with National e-Service Bus, there is no further necessity of re-developing the same database.

LIGT project sources said as part of introducing National e-Service Bus, NEA portal has been launched to make it knowledge repository of the government ministries, divisions and agencies, academia and industry.

"The portal is intended to include principles, standards, specifications, reference models, architecture design guidelines, e-Services, tools, and roadmaps for organisations in-line with digital Bangladesh vision," said LIGT Deputy Project Director Tarique M Barkatullah. LIGT project has initiated a twelve-day knowledge sharing and training programme on National e-Service Bus from February 3, Tarique added.

50 hurt including six cops in clash over land

At least 50 people were injured including six cops in a clash between two groups over land dispute in Badhaghat area of Sylhet yesterday.

The injured twenty two, including six cops, were admitted to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College and Hospital and seven were taken to private clinics. Others were treated with first aid.

According to the eyewitness and police sources, an altercation started between the supporters of Advocate Nure Alam Siraji, of Sunatola village, and Samsul Islam Tunu, Mogolgaon UP chairman, because of a long-standing feud over a land in the area.

Police rushed to the spot and fired 133 rubber bullets and eight teargas shells to control the situation, said Akther Hosain, officer-in-charge of the Jalalabad police. A case was filed in this regard.

free, fair and credible election.

The EC on Thursday announced that elections to 4,275 of the over 4,500 UPs, the lowest tier of the local government system, will be held, on partisan lines for the first time, in six phases starting March 22.

Meanwhile, BNP Joint Secretary General Rizvi Ahmed said their candidates would be selected by five-member committees comprising the party's respective UP unit president, general secretary and organising secretary and upazila unit president and general secretary.

Addressing a press conference at BNP's Nayapalton headquarters to make public the party's participation, he claimed that the EC had intentionally fixed the date, along with March 20 to hold polls to 10 municipalities of nine districts, to hamper BNP's 6th national council, scheduled to be held

on March 19.

Moreover, BNP Vice Chairman Abdullah Al Noman said the party would be able to hold the council successfully in 48 hours if they were permitted to use a venue.

Letters have been forwarded to the authorities concerned and BNP is yet to get permission to use the Institution of Engineers, Bangladesh; Suhrawardy Udyan and Bangabandhu International Conference Centre, he said.

Noman was addressing a discussion organised by pro-BNP Jatiyatabadi Nagorik Dal in Jatiya Press Club protesting cases filed against BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia and Senior Vice Chairman Tarique Rahman.

He said the UP polls would mean nothing to the people and BNP if there was a repetition of what happened during the ones held for the municipalities and upazilas.
