Demand shoots up centring Valentine's Day

Flower growers and traders of bouquets and garlands are making good profit amid high demand of the items centring the Valentine's Day today.

In the district famous for flower producing, a good number of people, especially women and girl students, are passing busy time to make jhopas (a jhopa=800 flowers) that are supplied to Dhaka, Chittagong, Sylhet, Rajshahi and other areas of the country.

This time a jhopa sells for Tk 150 to 200 while in other times, the prices fall as low as Tk 20/25, said traders.

Flower growers said, they get good profit in February as the demand increases, especially ahead of the Valentine's day when people buy flowers for offering to loved ones.

Besides, educational institutions, offices, different organisations and individuals purchase flowers for offering at the altar of Shaheed Minars in honour of the Language Movement martyrs on the Ekushe February (February
