# Rupayan starts mega gated community project

Rupayan Group started a mega gated community project—Rupayan City Uttara—in about 134.5 bighas of land on Friday.  
The community at Nalbhog beside sector 12 of Dhaka's Uttara area falls under the Turag thana. It will have apartments, villas, penthouses, shopping malls, schools and office spaces, Rupayan Group said in a statement yesterday.  
The gated city also features round the clock security system and playgrounds for children among other modern amenities, according to the statement.  
To mark the launch of the city,

Rupayan Group also started a fair featuring products and services of all units of the group.  
The fair, which ends on March 4, will feature projects from Rupayan Art View, Rupayan Housing Estate, Rupayan Land Development, Ratul Properties, Rupayan Port and Logistics, Rupayan Hotels and Resorts, Rambo Fabrics, and Rupayan Welfare Trust.  
Mosharraf Hossain, housing and public works minister, attended the launch where Sourav Ganguly, former captain of Indian cricket team and brand ambassador of Rupayan City, was also present.

Gated communities are a highly popular choice of residence around the world, with the concept gaining popularity in the neighboring India and Pakistan, where they have already become a dependable residential system, Rupayan said in the statement.  
In India's Maharashtra, Ambi Valley City and Lasava City are prominent examples of highly sophisticated gated communities. Bahria Town in Pakistan is the largest gated community in Asia.

## IMF says Tunisia should adjust its 'development model'

Tunisia should adjust its development model to counter economic slowdown and build "inclusive growth", the International Monetary Fund's country representative said, ahead of an expected line of IMF credit.  
The authorities have failed to redress the economy since the uprising five years ago that ousted longtime president Zine El Abidine Ben Ali.  
Tunisia's economic growth slowed to 0.8 percent last year from 2.3 percent in 2014, and unemployment nationwide stands at 15 percent.  
In January, a wave of protests spread to several cities including Tunis in some of the worst social unrest since the 2011 revolt.  
"This trend needs to be reversed... The idea would be to build the base for inclusive growth and revise Tunisia's development model," Robert Blotvogel told AFP.  
An IMF delegation is in Tunisia to discuss a new aid package at least equal to a \$1.7 billion credit line granted in 2013.  
Blotvogel said the government and the IMF had agreed on "the goal for big reforms and the diagnosis" of the situation, and were now "mostly focusing on the timeline for implementation".

## After G20 stalemate, focus turns to signs of growth momentum

Investors worried about the risk of a new global recession are hoping that data over the coming week will show that some momentum remains in the world economy, eight years into its slow recovery from the financial crisis.  
The Group of 20 economies were unable to agree on a joint push for new stimulus measures at a meeting which ended on Saturday, turning attention instead to upcoming business surveys from China, Japan, Europe the United States.  
Central banks in Europe and Japan may inject a little more stimulus into their economies later in March. But the Federal Reserve and the Bank of England look likely to sit tight for now, meaning hopes for a period of calm in the world's volatile financial markets lie largely with the indicators.  
"It seems economic data will have to bear the burden of stabilizing sentiment," economists at Barclays said in a note to clients on Friday.  
A first reading of inflation in February for the euro zone on Monday will help shape expectations of how much further below zero the European Central Bank is likely to push its deposit rate the following week.  
Euro zone inflation picked up in January but is expected to have fallen back to zero in February, according to a Reuters poll of economists.  
If there is also a weakening of the monthly purchasing manager indexes for Germany and other leading euro zone countries, the ECB may consider increasing its bond-buying programme as well as cutting rates on March 10.  
"There is a growing chance that the ECB will do more at its March meeting than simply lowering its deposit rate," Ralph Solveen, an economist at Commerzbank, said.  
US payrolls figures on Friday may help ease fears about the world's biggest economy, which appeared to stumble soon after the Federal Reserve felt confident enough to hike interest rates for the first time in nearly a decade in December.  
Solid US job growth and pay growth are seen as the best antidote to the upheaval in global financial markets which has hurt confidence and even raised questions about whether the United States was heading back into recession.  
Markets have turned calmer in recent days, helped by stronger-than-expected US inflation figures. But the impact of plunging share prices has shaken the confidence of many households and businesses in rich countries.  
Economists at Citi have cut their forecast for global economic growth this year to 2.5 percent from 2.7 percent due to slowing activity in developed economies. They said growth could come in below 2 percent -- equivalent to a global recession -- because of the chance of weaker growth among emerging economies.  
Bank of England Governor Mark Carney said on Friday that the global economy risked becoming "trapped in a low growth, low inflation, low interest rate equilibrium."

## Amazon sizes up UK restaurant delivery market

Amazon.com Inc has begun surveying UK customers about their use of restaurant delivery services, in what analysts said was likely the first step in an international expansion of a business it rolled out in the United States last September.  
In recent days, the online retailer sent its customers surveys, seen by Reuters, asking about the frequency and cost of customers' food orders and also whether they used companies such as Just Eat, Hungry House and Deliveroo, which deliver prepared food such as pizza, sushi and kebabs.  
The surveys asked customers what they most liked about providers such as Just Eat and Hungry House, and "what can be improved most about these service providers?"

## Qatar trade figures slump almost 60pc in year

Qatar's balance of trade fell almost 60 percent in the year to January, official figures released on Saturday showed, as the Gulf country grapples with a slump in global energy prices.  
The Development Planning and Statistics ministry said that the trade balance, which represents the difference between total exports and imports, fell 10.1 billion riyals (\$2.7 billion, 2.5 billion euros) in January 2016, compared with 12 months before.  
That represents a fall of 58 percent, said the ministry, in a statement posted on the official Qatar News Agency.  
In comparison to January 2015, there was a decrease in the value of exports of the major commodity groups, "oil-gas and other gaseous hydrocarbons", the ministry said.
