

**GATCO GRAFT CASE
HC clears way
for trial against
ex-CPA chairman
at lower court**

The High Court yesterday cleared way for the lower court concerned to resume the trial proceedings against Commodore (ret'd) Zulfikar Ali, former chairman of Chittagong Port Authority, in Gatco corruption case.
The HC lifted its 2008 stay order on the trial proceedings against Zulfikar, a co-accused of BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia in the case.

The bench of Justice Md Ruhul Quddus and Justice Mahmudul Haque came up with the verdict while rejecting a petition filed by Zulfikar for scraping the case proceedings against him, Anti Corruption Commission lawyer Khurshid Alam Khan told The Daily Star.

The Special Judge's Court-3 of Dhaka is now set to frame charges against Zulfikar, he added.

On February 23, the same court asked Khaleda to appear before it on April 13 in the graft case.

The HC in August last year had rejected two petitions filed by Khaleda challenging the legality of trial proceedings in the case.

The HC on February 15 released its full verdict asking the BNP chief to surrender before the trial court within two months from the day of receipt of the verdict copy.

On September 2, 2007, the ACC lodged the case with Tejgaon police against Khaleda, her youngest son Arafat Rahman Koko,

**3 factory workers
killed in Gazipur**

Three factory workers, one of garments and two others of spinning and knit, were killed in three separate incidents in Gazipur city and Kaliakoir upazila of the district yesterday.
Mouchak police camp in-charge Saiful Alam said Mahmuda Akter, 18, wife of Apel Miah, worked at Hanif Spinning Factory as a machine operator.
She used to live at a rented house in Rakhaliachala area of Kaliakoir.
Mahmuda was strangled as her scarf got entangled with a machine while she was working.
Later, she was rushed to Safipur General Hospital where doctors declared her dead.
In another incident, Mamunur Rashid, 31, son of Makbul Hossain of Shaktipur in Gobindaganj of Gaibandha, was killed as a truck knocked down his bicycle on Chandra Pal Apex road in Dighipara area of Kaliakoir upazila.
Quoting locals, Kaliakoir Police Station Sub-inspector Mukti Mahmud said a speeding truck hit the bicycle of Mamunur Rashid, a worker of Fareast Knit & Dyeing Limited, in the area while he was returning from his workplace around 3:00am, leaving him dead on the spot.
Meanwhile, police recovered the body of Hasina Akter, 32, a resident of Enayetpur village in Fulbaria upazila of Mymensingh, from a paddy field in Teknagpara of the city.
Sub-inspector Ruhul Amin of Joydebpur Police Station said local people spotted the body of Hasina, a worker of a readymade garment factory, lying in the field at Barboika.
The bodies were sent to Gazipur Shahid Tajuddin Ahmad Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Govt plans 16,000MW power this year

The government has a target to generate 16,000 megawatt (MW) of electricity in 2016, 24,000MW in 2021, 40,000MW in 2031 and 60,000MW in 2041, as the country has undertaken various power related projects in the country.
"We have taken a challenge to supply uninterrupted electricity to consumers across the country at affordable price by 2021," Director General of Power Cell Mohammad Hossain told the news agency yesterday.

He said the government has chalked out plan to reach electricity to every house and increase the production capacity to 24,000MW by 2021 and 60,000MW by 2041.

Hossain said the present government was firm to materialise the dreams of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman to build "Sonar Bangla", adding,

"Bangladesh will be a middle income country by 2021 and a developed one by 2041 with the united efforts of all."

"The nation is recovering from chronic energy crisis as the government has already brought 80 percent people under electricity coverage," he said.

According to an official, the Awami League-led government achieved successes in the power sector and the power generation capacity reached 14,077MW.

He said the country adopted strategy for renewable energy. Solar system has already made a positive impact throughout the country.

The government planned to generate 2,000MW power from solar-based facilities by 2021 and 10 percent demand would be met from renewable energy by 2021, the official added.

The arrestees are Aminur Rahman of Gopalganj, Abu Sayeed Manik of Mymensingh, and Shahenshah of Chandpur.

"The trio were plotting subversive activities, targeting the March 7 events," claimed ASP Alake Biswas of Rab-5 in Rajshahi.

Rab also seized 16 crude bombs, 7 petrol bombs and 8 jihadi books from their possession.

**Woman killed in port city
Robbers might have strangled her, suspect cops**

A woman was asphyxiated in a house at Roufabad in the port city on Saturday.

The deceased was identified as Parveen Akter, 36, the wife of Dubai expatriate Nurul Alam of Roufabad Paharika residential area in the city.

Parveen along with her 12-year-old son Md Syyed, a fifth grader, used to live on the 2nd floor of their six-storey building, said Parveen's nephew Majed Bin Yunus.

Minutes after Syyed's home tutor left

their apartment around 9:00pm, three youths suddenly entered it, and locked the door from inside.

They caught Syyed, and asphyxiated Parveen when she headed towards her son, Majed quoted Sayeed as saying.

They left the house keeping Syyed locked in the bathroom, Majed added.

Coming out of the bathroom by breaking its door down, Syyed informed his aunt, who was living on the 1st floor of the same building, of the incident.
