

# DU students hold cartoon exhibit against metro rail route thru' campus

Students of Dhaka University yesterday held a satirical cartoon exhibition at DU demanding shifting of the proposed metro rail route from their campus. They claimed if the route runs through the campus, it would hamper the academic atmosphere by creating crowds, noise, and insecurity. The cartoons, mainly painted by the fine arts students, showed the feature of possible problems due to the project. They also launched a mass signature collection campaign to press the demand, said Samanta Shermeen, a master's student of the sculpture department of DU. Earlier, the students held different programmes, including a solidarity rally.

# Bangladeshi peacekeeper dies in Congo

Constable Ashrafal Islam, a member of Bangladesh Police who had been working in the United Nation Peace Keeping Mission in Congo, died of a cardiac arrest on Tuesday at a hospital of Uganda. He was 37. He left behind his mother, wife and a two-year-old daughter. Joined at Bangladesh Police in 1999, Ashrafal went to Congo on April 9 last year. He had been working at Rab Headquarters before going to the mission. He hailed from Tikari village of Jhenidah, said a press release. Inspector General of Police (IGP) AKM Shahidul Hoque mourned his death.

## Bangladesh to host World Congress on Information Technology-2021

Bangladesh has been elected as a host country for arranging "World Congress on Information Technology (WCIT)-2021", the largest event in information technology. World Information Technology and Services Alliance yesterday selected Bangladesh as it bagged the majority votes after defeating Australia, the ICT division sources said. Secretary General of WITSA Dr James H Poissant, President of Australian Information Industry Association Rob Fitzpatrick and Chairman of National Association of Software and Services Companies R Chandra Shekhar also attended the meeting.

## Separate bicycle lanes on streets of capital demanded

Bangladesh Cycle Lane Bastabayan Parishad (BCLBP) yesterday demanded separate lanes in the capital to help protecting the environment, and improving public health. They formed a human chain at the premises of Fine Arts Faculty of Dhaka University, collected mass signatures and marched towards Dhaka South City Corporation office to submit a memorandum. Mortality rate is increasing due to diabetes, cardiac ailments and blood pressure, they said, adding only a few minutes of cycling can reduce this rate. Also environment pollution is increasing alarmingly due to a rise of motor vehicles. Carbon emission from vehicles is also contributing to the global climate change. BCLBP President Aminul Islam, Sammilita Sankritik Jote president Gulam Kuddus, Abul Kashem, and Sculptor Rasha were present.

## Two youths caught while 'trying' to rob drugstore in capital

Locals caught two youths with sharp weapons while they were allegedly trying to rob a drugstore in the capital's Shajahanpur early yesterday. Saiful Islam, 30, and Johirul Islam Shohag, 32, with two others attempted to rob Popular Pharmacy around 12:50am when locals, hearing the screams of the owner, rushed in and caught them. However, the two others managed to flee the scene, said Inspector of Shajahanpur Police Station Abdul Mabud. Saiful and Johirul were handed over to police, he said adding, the car was seized.

# SHARIATPUR WAR CRIMES ICT decides to try Edris in absentia

**Sulaiman in jail also faces trial**

The International Crimes Tribunal-1 yesterday decided to hold trial of fugitive war crimes accused Edris Ali Sarder alias Gazi Edris in absentia along with Sulaiman Mollah, who is now in jail, for their alleged involvement in crimes committed in Shariatpur during the 1971 Liberation War. The tribunal took the decision as the alleged Razakar did not appear before it even after publication of newspaper advertisements asking them to do so. Earlier, law enforcers had failed to apprehend Edris. It also appointed Gazi MH Tamim as the state defence counsel for Edris and fixed April 3 for hearing the charges. The prosecution on November 16 last year pressed four charges against Sulaiman, 84, of Kashipur Muslimpara, and Edris, 67, from Mahmudpur of Shariatpur sadar upazila. The tribunal took cognisance of the charges on December 22 last year. According to the prosecution, they were involved in killing, sEE PAGE 5 COL 2

# RECRUITMENT ROW HC summons National Museum president, DG

The High Court yesterday summoned four officials of the national museum including president of its board of trustees, director general and secretary to appear before the HC on March 21 over not complying with its order regarding submission of some documents. During hearing writ petitions, the HC bench of Justice Gobinda Chandra Tagore and Justice SM Mozibur Rahman asked them to appear before it to explain their roles in this regard. Petitioners' counsel Shah Mohammad Ahsanur Rahman told 'The Daily Star' that the museum authorities issued a recruitment advertisement for 35 vacant posts in 12 categories on August 5, 2013. The selection committee of the board of trustees recommended for recruitment of 35 qualified candidates for those posts on March 8, 2014 after holding relevant tests. Later, the board at a meeting proposed to issue a new circular for the recruitment to the same posts by mentioning a case in this regard filed with New Market Police Station. Then the museum authorities issued a new circular for three posts on April 30 last year. Subir Shikder and Sushmita Biswas, who had been qualified and selected for the posts of movie cameraman and assistant keeper for world civilisation respectively, filed two separate writ petitions with the HC challenging the legality of museum authorities' decision to issue the second circular. Following the petitions, the HC on June 2 last year stayed the effectiveness of the new recruitment circular and issued two rules upon the authorities concerned of the museum and government to explain the sEE PAGE 5 COL 1
