pended assistant subinspector Shamim Reza of Bangshal Police Station on a five-day remand yesterday in a case filed over shooting a cable TV operator staff the day before in Khilgaon.

A metropolitan magistrate passed the order after Khilgaon police produced the ASI before the court seeking a 10-day remand.

A ballistic test found that the pistol seized from ASI Shamim was used to shoot the cable TV man, the OC of the police station said.

On Friday, Al Amin, 26, an employee of Dhaka East Cable Vision, was shot by ASI Shamim during an altercation over the payment of monthly service charge. Later, police arrested Shamim in Bangshal after an attempted murder case was filed by the victim, and

of appointment letters or identity cards to drivers. As per rule, a driver has to pay Tk 900 daily as a deposit

money or operating charge to owners. But the drivers demanded minimising the rate.

On the other hand, another section of CNG-run autorickshaw workers differ with the strike.

"Those, who have called the strike, should discuss with the government authorities concerned to solve the issue. If the negotiation fails, they can launch their movement," said Hanif Khokon, general secretary of the Dhaka Auto Rickshaw Sramik Union. "The drivers, who are involved with our union, will oper-

ate the auto-rickshaws. We urge the law enforcers to take action against those who would try to resist our drivers," Khokon told The Daily Star.

Meanwhile, another organisation of auto-rickshaw workers at a press conference yesterday demanded immediate implementation of the government's pledge to give permis-

sion to workers for introducing new 5,000 CNG-run autorickshaws in the capital. Although the government gave the pledge in 2013, it is

yet to be implemented, said Ashraful Alam, a leader of CNG Auto Rickshaw Driver and Cooperative Federation, while addressing the press conference at Jatiya Press Club. He also threatened to launch a tougher movement, if the

demand was not met immediately. Around 13,000 CNG-run auto rickshaws ply in the capital and around a dozen of workers' organisations are working in this sector, according to workers.

THEFT OF BANGLADESH BANK MONEY

BNP points finger at govt, bank officials

Two senior BNP leaders yesterday alleged that the Tk 800 crore, which was stolen from Bangladesh Bank's account in the US Federal Reserve Bank, was skimmed with the help of the government and central bank officials. BNP standing committee members Moudud Ahmed and

Goyeshwar Chandra Roy raised the allegation in two separate programmes in the capital. They demanded that a fair and credible investigation be

carried out into the incident, saying the ministers and MPs and bank officials who were behind the heist can be identified through a proper probe.

The BNP leaders, however, did not elaborate or mention names of any individuals.

"Nobody believes that it is possible for hackers to loot money from the central bank's reserve without the help of the officials of the bank," Moudud Ahmed said at a discussion.

Moshiur Rahman Jadu Mia Jatiya Memorial Committee organised the programme at Jatiya Press Club marking the 37th death anniversary of the BNP co-founder. "An anarchic situation has been created at present due to

an absence of accountability of the government. Besides, there is no democracy... A political vacuum is prevailing. Under this situation, militancy, extremism and fundamentalist forces will rise," said Moudud.

Earlier, speaking at another discussion at the same venue organised by Jatiyatabadi Karmajibi Dal, Goyeshwar warned that the government will have to bow out amid public wrath if it fails to recover the public money.

The Federal Reserve Bank of New York was hacked and \$100 million was taken out from the Bangladesh government's account last month. The sensational heist surfaced after a Philippines newspaper published a report on it.

Bangladesh Ambassador to Qatar Ashud Ahmed was invited by the adviser to his office, according to a message received in Dhaka on Friday. Ashud said Bangladesh would definitely consider extending its support. Kawari said he would visit Bangladesh sometime in the coming months.

Boy dies from electrocution in capital

A 13-year-old boy died from electrocution when he attempted to climb an electric pole to get on a wall while he was playing with other children in the capital's Azimpur yesterday.

Sixth-grader Mir Bayezid Islam lived with his parents in Mouchak Colony area. He fell to the ground after he touched a high voltage live wire, his elder brother Touhidul Islam, 25, quoted Bayezid's friends as saying. Locals rushed him to Dhaka Medical College Hospital where doctors pronounced him dead, he added.
