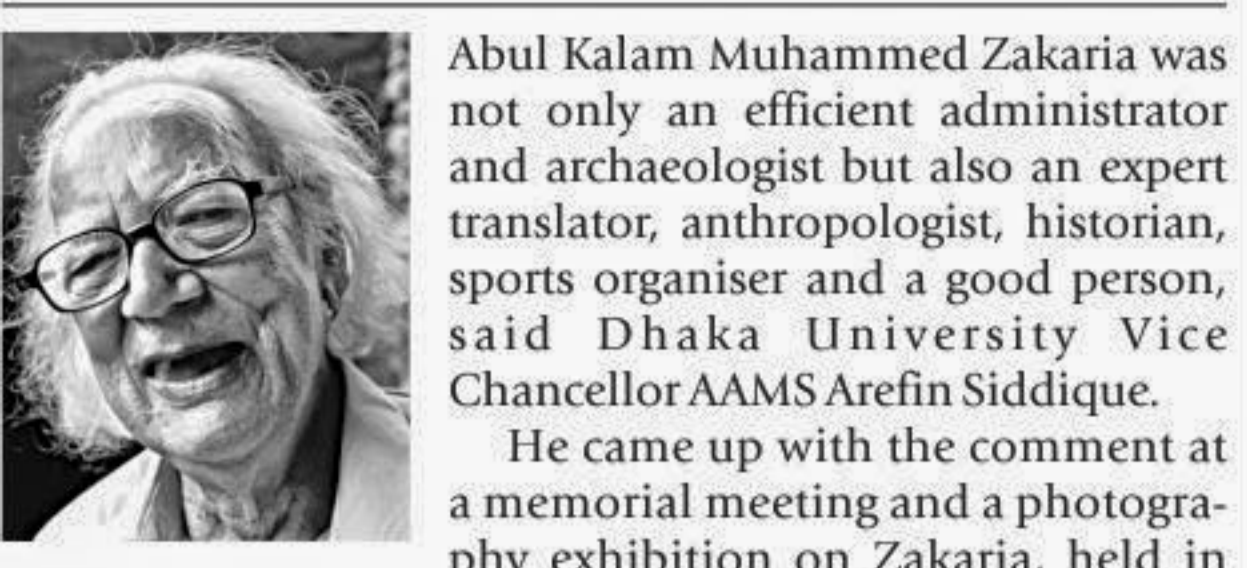


# AKM Zakaria will be missed

Memorial meeting told



Abul Kalam Muhammed Zakaria was not only an efficient administrator and archaeologist but also an expert translator, anthropologist, historian, sports organiser and a good person, said Dhaka University Vice Chancellor AAM Siddique. He came up with the comment at a memorial meeting and a photography exhibition on Zakaria, held in Nabab Nawab Ali Chowdhury Senate building at DU yesterday. "Committee to publish books on architectural sites of Dhaka", an initiative of a group of young researchers, organised the programme. "He had an infinite zeal to learn new materials and teach others. He will be missed," said Prof Arefin. Maruf Shamsur Zakaria, son of late Zakaria, said, "He always spent time with us despite being busy. He was disciplined, logical and secular minded." Prof Saiful Islam Khan of the Persian language and culture department of DU said, "He was one of the few scholars in Bangladesh who was fluent in Persian language." Around 30 of his books, including "Bangladesher Pratinasampad", "Bangladesher Prachin Kirti", and "Nabab Siraj-ud-Doula", as well as translated historical books "Tabkat-e-Nasiri", "Tarikh-e-Bangla-e-Mahabbatjangi", "Muzaffarnama", "Naobahar-e-Murshidkuli Khan", and "Siarul Mutakhhirin" were exhibited along with some rare photos of his busy and eventful life. Zakaria received Ekushey Padak in 2015 and Bangla Academy Award in 2006 for his contributions. Born in 1918, the scholar completed his graduation in English Literature from Dhaka University. He started his career as a teacher at Government Azizul Haque College, Bogra in 1946. Two years later, he joined the civil service. He breathed his last on February 24, 2016, aged 97.

# Protecting water bodies, ecology must in development process

Speakers tell int'l architecture symposium in capital

STAFF CORRESPONDENT Bangladesh cannot afford destroying its waterfronts and ecology in the development process, said globally acclaimed architects on the sideline of a three-day international architecture symposium in the capital yesterday. There has to be a process led by conservationists, before architecture comes in, for the conservation of some irreplaceable natural resources like rivers, wetlands and water bodies, said Peter Stutchbury, principal architect of Peter Stutchbury Architecture in Sydney, Australia, while talking to The Daily Star. "We are missing a stage of analysis...developers buy cheap but sensitive lands and build on it because they want money," he said. "Bangladesh is the biggest delta in the world, a most remarkable place, yet you are killing it...I would hope in Bangladesh there is some definitive effort to save the nature," he added. "Nature is everything and it is most important to respect the patterns of nature," he emphasised, adding, rivers connect people to a greater natural world; it forms a spiritual union between humans and beyond human realm. "Water is everywhere in the Bangladeshi landscape," said Prof Adele Santos, former dean of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in Boston in the US, adding, "Water is cultivation; water is fishing and a beautiful thing to look at." "Water has a strong value. It is not an evil and should be a friend in development process. To fill up the water bodies and harm the ecological system is not a responsible act," she said. Architects think in a lateral way to bring wellbeing and are responsible for emotional and spiritual welfare of the people and society, not like a doctor, who brings physical wellbeing, said Peter. People, if exposed to beauty are often inspired, he said. While talking on architectural education, noted architect Prof Shamsul Wares, said that an architect should take a position against commercialism, consumerism and the culture of greed. Prof Timmy Aziz from Maryland Institute College of Art in Baltimore, US, said that architects have to be innovative and imaginative and resist being constrained by mere material demands of the employers. Architect Nikalus Graber from Switzerland, while moderating the panel discussion on education, said that in general 80 percent built environment has nothing to do with architecture, they are mere production. The Bengal Institute for Architecture along with Bengal Foundation organised the symposium on "Architecture Now/Next" at Krishibid Institution Bangladesh, which aims at understanding new directions in architecture and city building. The invited speakers include globally acclaimed professionals, academicians, writers, critics and thinkers in the field of architecture also from the UK, the USA, Mexico, Turkey, South Korea, and Vietnam. Kazi Khaleed Ashraf, director general of Bengal Institute conducted the day's session. The symposium comes to an end today.

# DU female 'stalked, slapped by BCL man'

FROM PAGE 3 He urged women to engage in political movements to establish their rights. On the Chittagong Hill Tracts Peace Treaty of 1997 yet to be implemented, he criticised the government, terming it undemocratic and reactionary. "Our government, the ruling class is perpetually submerged up to the neck in extreme nationalism," he said referring to how the Bangalee identity was imposed on ethnic minority people in 1972 and later through the 15th amendment to the constitution. Tapoti Saha, programme coordinator, Economic Security and Rights, IUN Women; Wasir Rahman Tonmoy, programme coordinator, MJE, and Chaitali Tripura and Basanti Murmu, both joint conveners of BIWN, also spoke. In the first session, Falguni Tripura presented a report on the overall human rights condition of the ethnic minority women. The report highlighted 434 incidents of physical and sexual violence against ethnic minority women and children between 2007 and 2015. In 2015, out of 69 incidents, 38 occurred in the Chittagong Hill Tracts and the rest in plain land. The violence included 14 rapes, 12 gang rapes, 11 physical assaults, six sexual harassments and 16 attempted rapes.
