The report was scheduled to be submitted yesterday and prosecutor Rezia Sultana Chaman sought one month. International Crimes Tribunal-1 directed them to submit the report, if there were any, on May 17.

Earlier, the prosecution took time twice on December 1 last year and January 21 this year to submit the report.

The accused are Esahaq Shikder, Abdul Goni Hawlader, Md Awal alias Awal Moulavi, Abdus Sattar Pyada and Solaiman Mridha.

According to the tribunal's investigation agency, Esahaq was a member of a local Peace Committee, an antiliberation organisation, while the rest were members of a local Razakar Bahini, an auxiliary force of the Pakistani occupation army, during the Liberation War.


