## Four Ctg eateries fined Tk 75,000

A mobile court of the Chittagong District Administration yesterday fined four restaurants Tk 75,000 in Chittagong city on different charges including not maintaining hygiene and using burnt and dirty oil in food.

The court fined Zaman Hotel and Restaurant Tk 20,000, Café Alam Restaurant Tk 15,000 and Candy Restaurant Tk 10,000 in GEC Circle area, said a press release. Kutumbo Bari Restaurant at AK Khan Intersection was fined Tk 30,000.

## Polythene bags seized in Ctg

## Drive against illegal signboards, wall paintings from April

DNCC warns all businesses, individuals

Dhaka North City Corporation (DNCC) requested all the business centres and individuals to keep signboards or nameplates in sizes that have been approved and remove all wall paintings or pictures by March 31 and threatened to otherwise take action.

DNCC, in a press release, said it would also take steps to disconnect utility service lines like gas, electricity and water, if they failed to do so by that time.

The DNCC authorities said although they had already removed almost all billboards in their areas, some business centres had made their signboards larger than the approved, which was a punishable offence.

They also advertise on walls or in shopping centre violating rules.

According to the release, the DNCC have sued 42 owners and agencies over using signboards illegally.

## HC upholds BTRC's decision of seeking Tk 30cr from ETV

The High Court yesterday upheld a Bangladesh Telecommunication and Regulatory Commission (BTRC) decision to seek Tk 30.09 crore from Ekushey Television (ETV) for using its broadcasting frequency.

The bench of Justice Quazi Reza-Ul Hoque and Justice Abu Taher Md Saifur Rahman rejected a writ petition filed by ETV, challenging the BTRC's decision in 2007.

Now ETV has to pay the amount, Additional Attorney General Murad Reza told The Daily Star.

BTRC's lawyer Khandaker Reza-e-Raquib told this correspondent that his client had sent a letter to ETV in March 2007 asking to pay for using the frequency till that day, who then filed a writ petition, challenging the letter.

That same year, the HC stayed the BTRC's decision and

## 672 flats for govt staff to be built in N'ganj

Ecneec okays 5 other development projects

The Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (Ecneec) yesterday approved six development projects involving Tk 1,219.26 crore, including one to construct some 672 residential flats for government officials and employees at Aliganj in Narayanganj.

The approval came from the 24th Ecneec meeting of the current fiscal year held at the NEC conference room in the capital's Sher-e-Bangla Nagar with Ecneec Chairperson and Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina in the chair.

Briefing reporters after the meeting, Planning Minister AHM Mustafa Kamal said a total of six projects were approved with an outlay of Tk 1,219.26 crore.

"Of the total project cost, Tk 894.92 crore will come from the national exchequer, Tk 84.19 crore from the organisation's own fund while Tk 240.15 crore from project assistance," he said.

Of the approved six projects, five are new while one is a revised project, the minister added.

He said some 191 development projects got approval with an estimated cost of Tk 1,67,188 crore in the last 23 Ecneec meetings of the current fiscal year.

The planning minister said Public Works Department, under the Ministry of Housing and Public Works, will implement the flat construction project by June 2019.

Under the project, some eight 15-storey buildings will be built on 12.84 acres of land of PWD at Aliganj, which is barely five kilometres away from the capital's Jatrabari.

He said multi-storey buildings will also be built at upazila level for the government officials and employees.

The Ecneec meeting gave nod to another project titled "Embankment protection of Rajapur and East Ilisha union under Bholra Sadar upazila from the erosion of the river Meghna" with an outlay of Tk 279.42 crore.

Bangladesh Water Development Board under the Ministry of Water Resources will implement the project by June 2020.

Asked about the possible size of the Revised Annual Development Programme (RADP) for the current fiscal year, the planning minister said it would stand at that figure which the executing agencies would be able to implement by this June.

The other projects approved at the meeting are poverty alleviation initiative at northern region with Tk 324.34 crore, expansion of Rajshahi BSCIC industrial estate with Tk 128.81 crore, conducting interrelation affairs survey of ecosystem of haor and rivers, developing management framework of listed water bodies and permanent water bodies with Tk 54.41 crore and fisheries development in greater Jessore with Tk 34.12 crore.
