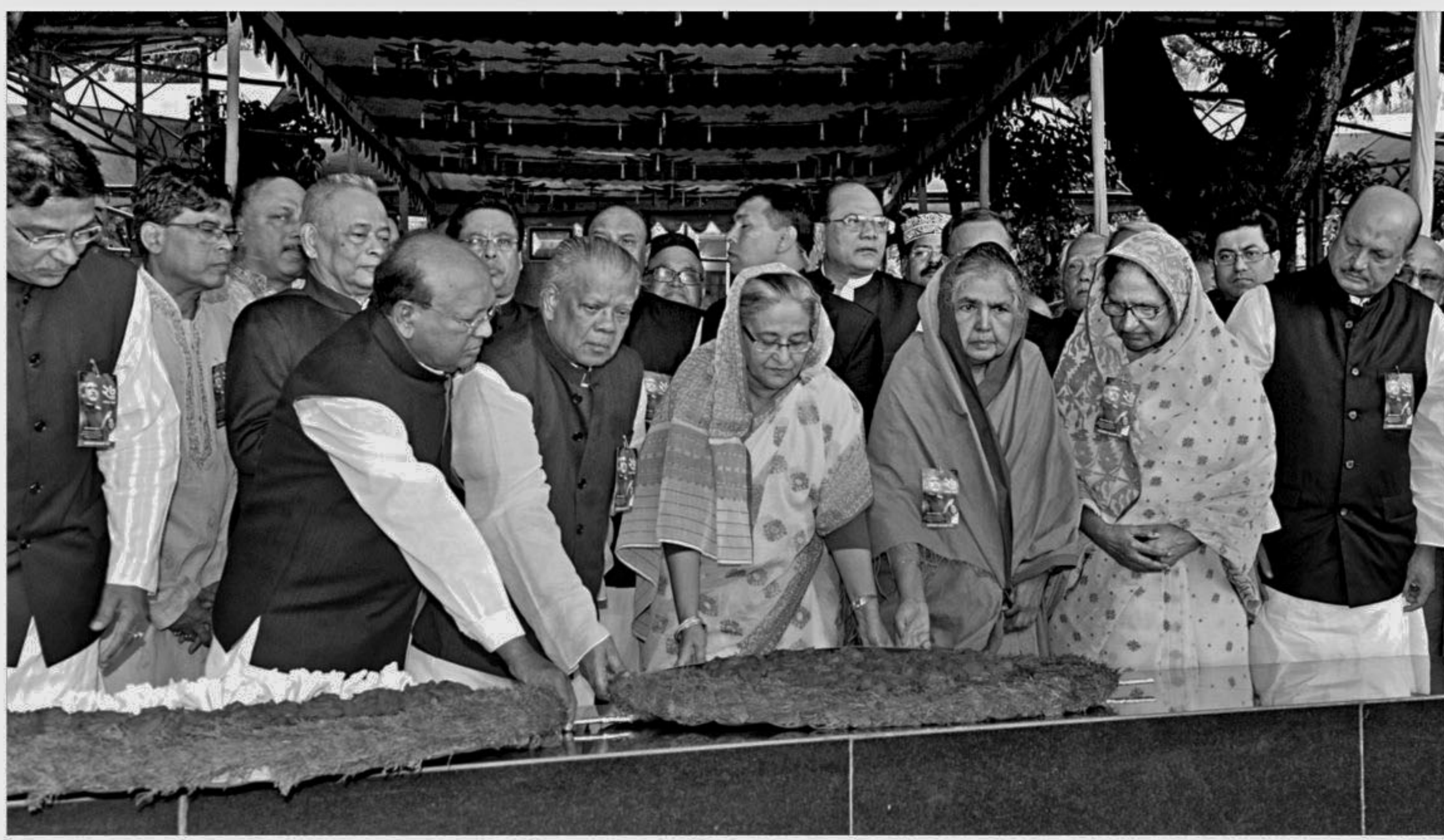


Foni Bhushan Chy passes away

Staff Correspondent Foni Bhushan Chowdhury, a member of Public Service Commission (PSC), died of cancer yesterday afternoon, aged 62. He was undergoing treatment at Dhaka Medical College Hospital. The body of Foni Bhushan, also a former police coordinator and a former secretary, will be taken to Dhakeshwari Temple around 9:30am today and then to Rajarbagh Police Lines around 12:00pm. In the evening, the body will be taken to his village home Chhatak upazila of Sunamganj for cremation, which is expected to take place tomorrow, according to Dhaka Metropolitan Police website. Born in an educated family, Foni Bhushan graduated in physics from Chittagong University in 1975 and later obtained a law degree from Dhaka University in 1984.

ASK joins protests against Tonu murder

Staff Correspondent Ain o Salish Kendra (ASK), a legal aid and human rights organisation, yesterday criticised and expressed grave concern for not arresting any perpetrator involved in the killing of Sohagi Jahan Tonu, a student of Comilla Victoria College. "Such a heinous incident in a secured area like the cantonment and a failure to arrest anyone have raised various questions among people," ASK said in a release and demanded a fair investigation into the incident. ASK demanded that the government take responsible measures to ensure proper and exemplary punishment for the culprits after identifying them immediately. The body of Tonu, 19, a second year history student and a member of Victoria College Theatre, was recovered from Mynamati area on March 20. Tonu's friends and theatre-group colleagues claimed that she had been raped before being murdered and accused the local administration of playing a "dubious role" regarding the incident.

Women not safe in country

Fakhrul tells BNP's Independence Day procession

Staff Correspondent Women are not safe in the country now because incidents of violence are occurring one after another against them, BNP acting secretary general Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir said yesterday. "The country's people have no security of their lives and property. Our mothers and sisters are not safe here," he said in a brief address before a party procession started from the Naya Paltan central office to mark the 46th Independence and National Day. The BNP leader said people did not have the right to express their thoughts, while the freedom of the media was snatched. Participants of the huge colourful procession paraded different roads through Bijoynagar, Kakrail and Shantinagar before stopping at the Malibagh intersection. Thousands of leaders and activists of BNP and its associate bodies carrying banners, placards and portraits of top leaders joined the procession that started around 3:20pm. Party insiders said the BNP leaders from the capital's different units thronged Naya Paltan with their followers to attract the attention of the party high-ups ahead of the formation of BNP's new committee. In his speech, Fakhrul also called upon the party activists to get united putting behind all differences among them to "restore" democracy through a movement. He said even after 45 years of independence, the nation was still clamouring for democracy. "We're still on a movement for realising our democratic rights. As a nation, it's very unfortunate for us."

College student held for stalking teenager in capital

Victim claims she doesn't even know the stalker

Staff Correspondent Police arrested a college student on the charge of stalking a female student of a medical college in the capital's Farmgate yesterday. Farhan Moon, 19, a student of Tejgaon College, got on a rickshaw by which the 19-year-old was going towards Asadgate from Farmgate, she told The Daily Star. Farhan teased her standing behind the rickshaw, she alleged. Later, the teenager informed police patrolling the area and the law enforcers arrested Farhan after a chase. Sher-e-Bangla Nagar police Sub-inspector Saiful Islam said the woman filed a complaint against the man who denied the allegation. Farhan was not her acquaintance and she had no enmity with him, police quoted the female student as saying.

AUW's Model UN Club int'l confce passes third day in festivity

Staff Correspondent, Ctg A lively discussion and a social event marked the third day of the four-day international conference organised by Asian University for Women (AUW) Model United Nations (UN) Club, on the AUW campus in Chittagong city yesterday. A total of 200 students from 20 countries are participating in the AUW International Model UN Conference 2016. Sessions of six committees, United Nations Security Council (UNSC), the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea (ITLOS), the Economic and Social Council, Unicef, UN Women and International Press, resumed yesterday. Most of the committees completed their working papers on set agendas and were drafting the resolution papers, said Nanjiba Zahin, a student of the AUW and director of public relations of the conference. Committees such as ITLOS and UNSC faced crisis sessions, she said, adding, countries concerned went through intense discussions to find immediate solutions. After the sessions, a social event was held, said Anjuman Tanha, secretary general of the conference.

Hacked restaurant worker dies in capital

Staff Correspondent A restaurant worker, hacked by a youth in capital's Pallabi on Friday night, died at Dhaka Medical College Hospital yesterday noon. The youth also stabbed Lucky Akter, 20, wife of the victim Nizamuddin, 27. The couple lived in Mirpur sector-7. Pallabi police arrested the attacker Touhidul Islam, 23, and recovered a blood-stained knife from him on Friday. Dadan Fakir, officer-in-charge (OC) of Pallabi police, told The Daily Star that the couple went to Mirpur-11 for shopping and while returning on foot, Touhid attacked them. Touhid claimed that he and Nizam had a quarrel while working at a garments factory one year back and he killed him out of enmity, said the OC. "It's a lie. Nizam had been working in a restaurant for more than a year," claimed Fakir. The OC said Touhid will be placed on remand for further interrogation.

She recalled all the martyrs and their family members with due respect, paid tributes to all who helped achieve independence through their supreme sacrifices and prayed for "stronger and sweeter ties" between Bangladesh and West Bengal. She also tweeted in Bangla saying, "Tributes to martyrs. Joy Bangla. Joy Hindi." Meanwhile, the day was observed at the Bangladesh High Commission in New Delhi, beginning with the hoisting of the national flag at the chancery by High Commissioner Syed Muazzem Ali and a special prayer seeking salvation of the martyrs. Messages of President Abdul Hamid, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, Foreign Minister AH Mahmud Ali and State Minister for Foreign Affairs Shariar Alam were read out. Special supplements were published in three leading Indian newspapers - The Indian Express, The Financial Express and Anandabazar Patrika. Moreover, the Bangladesh flag was raised by the Legislative Assembly of Ontario in Queen's Park, Toronto for the first time on March 23 marking the Independence Day. The event was facilitated by Honourable Speaker Dave Levac, MPP; Percy Hatfield, MPP of New Democratic Party of Ontario; Sylvia Jones, MPP of Progressive Conservative Party of Ontario; and Arthur Potts, MPP of the Ontario Liberal Party. The flag was hoisted by community leader, academic and The Daily Star columnist Dr Mozammel Khan and cultural personality Azzul Malik while hundreds of Bangladeshis waved smaller flags and Bangladeshi artists rendered the national anthems of Bangladesh and Canada. The event was managed by Toronto's Bangladesh Centre and Community Services, led by the master of the ceremony, Hasina Quader, Dr Mahub Reza and others. Apart from the members of the provincial government, the programme was addressed by Barrister Chayanika Dutta, daughter of decorated freedom fighter Chittaranjan Dutta.
