

President stresses modernisation of BAF training

President Abdul Hamid yesterday stressed bringing changes to the education and training programmes of Bangladesh Air Forces keeping pace with the world.

"Globalisation and rapid development of technologies have brought changes to the security system of the world. Different techniques are being used worldwide to face terrorism and militancy," he said.

Hamid was addressing a ceremony to hand over National Standard Award to BAF Base Matiur Rahman at the base in Jessore.

He asked the BAF members to build themselves as skilled and ideal air force members and remain careful about ensuring the effective use and maintenance of war weapons, radars and aircraft.

The construction of "Bangabandhu Complex" is now progressing fast at the Air Force Academy for providing modern training to BAF members, he said.

The 210 Maintenance Unit of Bir Shreshtha Matiur Rahman Base has saved huge foreign currency by overhauling a 122 PT-6 aircraft. China's Jilin Aviation has given this unit the Certificate of Professional Excellence. In recognition of this success, BAF Base Matiur Rahman has achieved the national standard award.

Both factions of JSD want authorising own

Both factions of the recently split Jatiya Samajtantrik Dal (JSD) yesterday demanded that the Election Commission (EC) authorises the single person whom each named for selecting chairman candidates in the union parishad (UP) polls.

A seven-member delegation led by Information Minister Hesanul Haq Inu placed the demand meeting the chief election commissioner (CEC) and other commissioners at the EC secretariat around 11:15am, said EC and party sources.

A four-member delegation led by former general secretary Sharif Nurul Ambia led the other faction to a second meeting around 3:00pm to explain their logic, said the sources.

Afterwards, CEC Kazi Rakibuddin Ahmad told journalists, "We had initial discussions with them...we will seek more documents if necessary."

The rules say a political party must send a letter to the returning officer, along with copies to the EC, naming the person the party authorised to pick chairman candidates in UP polls.

In the first and second phases of the UP polls held on March 22 and 31, Sharif was the authorised person. The party split following a feud over electing the general secretary in its nation council on March 12.

The president and general secretary of one faction are Inu and lawmaker Shirin Akhter while Sharif and lawmaker Nazmul Haque Proddhan took up the roles respectively in the other.

Through separate letters to the EC, one group named Shirin while the other Nazmul as the authorised person to run the polls under the party's "Moshal" (torch) banner in the remaining phases. The EC on April 4 asked both factions to appear and give statements.

ACC sues Kazi Firoz of JP for 'land grabbing'

The Anti Corruption Commission has filed a case against lawmaker Kazi Firoz Rashid, also a president member of Jatiya Party, on the charge of grabbing a government land, reports UNB.

According to the first information report (FIR), a government house on a one-bigha of land in Dhanmondi residential area was allocated to then Canadian High Commissioner Mohammad Ali on November 3, 1951.

Later in 1970, the authorities concerned gave approval to hand over the land to inheritors of Ali -- his second wife, son and daughter -- and mutation of the land was made to their names. On May 22, 1970, the ministry concerned also gave approval to hand over the land to them.

But, according to the FIR, Kazi Firoz grabbed the land (Road No 2,

DU students keep demanding justice for Sujan murder

Students of Dhaka University staged a demonstration for the fourth consecutive day at the capital's Shahbagh intersection yesterday afternoon, protesting the murder of their fellow Sujan Mridha, a third year student of the university's marketing department.

They also formed a human chain on the university campus, demanding a fresh investigation, exemplary punishment for the perpetrators and reparations.

Sujan was allegedly killed in a police firing during the second phase of Union Parishad polls in Madaripur's Dhurai on March 31 while the police denied the allegation, saying that he was killed in a clash between two rival groups.

Body exhumed over allegation of 'killing'

The body of Nasrin Akhter, 32, who was allegedly murdered by her in-laws at Nawabganj of Dhaka, was exhumed yesterday 37 days after her death following a court order.

Officer-in-Charge of Nababganj police Saidur Rahman said the body was sent to Sir Salimullah Medical College morgue for autopsy as no autopsy was carried out after the death.

Nasrin Akhter, the wife of Saudi expatriate Abdul Mannan, was found dead at her in-laws' house on the night of March 1 when her parents heard that the in-laws beat her up and locked out the whole day. The in-laws, however, termed the death "a suicide." The victim's father filed a murder case with the Dhaka court on March 13, against five persons including her husband.

DU hall cancels BCL leader's residency

Dhaka University's Haji Muhammad Mohsin Hall authorities yesterday cancelled the residency permit of a fine arts master's student, also the general secretary of the Bangladesh Chhatra League unit at the faculty, for allegedly misbehaving with the provost and house tutors.

Obaidul Kabir Rikto was given 24 hours to leave with his belongings, Provost Nizamul Hoque Bhuiyan told The Daily Star, adding that the incident occurred around 11:00pm on Tuesday when the hall authorities were conducting a drive against illegal residents. "When we asked for his papers, Rikto expressed his anger and misbehaved with us claiming to be a BCL leader," he said. Rikto claimed it was "a misunderstanding" and that he had become "excited."

"If Rikto is guilty, the administration can take any kind of action against him," said DU unit BCL General Secretary Motahar Hossen.

People ashamed seeing UP polls

Former Dhaka University vice chancellor Emajuddin Ahmed yesterday said Bangladeshis have become ashamed observing the ongoing union parishad (UP) polls, which have become infamous for vote rigging.

"I feel ashamed when I observe the polls...the country's people have lost their voting rights and the aspirants have lost their rights to meet the voters. But after seeing all of these the Election Commission is silent," he said.

Addressing a book unveiling programme organised by pro-BNP Bangladesh Youth Forum in the capital's Jatiya Press Club, he termed an inadequate solution the resignation of the Bangladesh Bank governor following the cyber heist netting around \$101 million of the central bank.

He said people wanted to know who were involved and how much money was looted.

BNP leader Osman Faruk said, "Many expressed concern saying that there is no democracy in the country but I observed that democracy has been killed."

"As a democratic party, BNP has participated in the local government polls and decided to stay in the polls even after the ruling party men carried out vote rigging," added the BNP chairperson's adviser.

did not take the charges into cognisance.

According to the prosecution, the JMB activists carried out the attack on October 3, 2005, killing Mojibul Hoque, a litigant, and injuring MA Sufian, a judge of the court, Shafique Ullah, a bench officer, and some others.

On August 15, 2006, Lakshmpur speedy trial tribunal sentenced JMB's military commander Ataur Rahman Sunny, Masum and Amjad in both the cases. Sunny's death penalty for killing two Jhalakathi judges has already been executed.

The HC in 2013 upheld the death penalty of Masum and acquitted Amjad after

hearing death reference and their appeals against the court's judgment.
