Recording of testimony deferred to April 28

A Sylhet court yesterday deferred recoding of the testimony of witnesses to April 28 in the former finance minister SAMS Kibria murder case.

The order came as only one accused out of 13 appeared before the court yesterday, said Kishore Kumar Kar, public prosecutor of the tribunal.

Five people, including Kibria, were killed and 70 others injured in a grenade attack on a public rally of Awami League at Baidder Bazar in Sadar upazila of Habiganj on January 27, 2005.

Awami League leader Abdul Mazid Khan filed two cases -- one for murder and another under the Explosives Substances Act -with Habiganj Police Station the following day.

Family members of death row war criminal Motiur Rahman Nizami met him at Kashimpur jail in Gazipur, on the outskirts of the capital, yesterday.

The six family members including his wife talked to him for around 40 minutes from 12:40pm, Senior Jail Superintendent of the prison Prasanta Kumar Banik told The Daily Star.

It was the second time the family members met him after International Crimes Tribunal (ICT) issued death warrant against him on March 15, hours after the Supreme Court released its full verdict upholding his death penalty.

In October 2014, the ICT-1 handed down capital punishment to Nizami, the chief of anti-liberation Jamaat-e-Islami and leader of the infamous Al-Badr Bahini, for committing crimes against humanity during the 1971 Liberation

On March 29 this year, Nizami filed a petition seeking a review of the SC verdict.
