Inflation tests ahead, currencies often not cooperating

With the world economy entering a more uncertain phase and the top central banks sounding ever more cautious, attention may turn in the coming week to signs of whether years of aggressive stimulus have yielded any significant rise in inflation.

The US Federal Reserve, the Bank of England and the European Central Bank all have been disappointed to varying degrees about how little inflation has picked up, or indeed how it has spent too much time going the

opposite way. The Bank of Japan, which has been trying to ward off deflation going on two decades, has now been hit with a counterproductive surge in the yen after a contested decision last month to adopt a tiny negative interest rate.

Even in China, where it is difficult to fathom the sheer magnitude of fiscal and monetary stimulus Beijing has piled on since the financial crisis, consumer price inflation is remarkably tame and likely to remain so.

worry is whether a slowdown in growth over the past several months will get in the way of what many central banks are hoping for: pressure on inflation through wages as labour increasingly becomes more scarce.

Already there are signs the dramatic fall in unemployment in the United States and Britain, and to a lesser extent the euro zone, is starting to slow, which is normal this far into

uneven and lacklustre one.

"The US merits special attention," writes David Hensley, a director of global research at JP Morgan.

"If the U.S. unemployment rate were to stabilize at 5 percent, the Fed would have much less incentive to hike rates unless this level of unemployment turns out to be low enough to generate a sustained rise in wage and price inflation, something Chair Yellen has expressed considerable skepticism about."

So far, measures of underlying price pressures that strip out volatile energy and food prices have risen to close to or even above where the Fed likes them to be. But they have shown little sign of climbing beyond that, hence the caution on rates.

U.S. inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index (CPI) is expected to rise to 1.2 percent on a year ago, and steady around 2.3 percent on a core basis, according to a preliminary Reuters poll of economists for data due on Thursday.

In Britain, where the central bank For developed economies, the has left its key interest rate at a record low for seven years and shows no sign of moving for at least another, inflation is even weaker.

The UK CPI is forecast to rise by just 0.4 percent on a year ago and 1.3 percent on a core basis, in data due Tuesday, a few days before the Bank of England sets policy. No dissent on a unanimously-forecast decision to leave rates steady is expected.

The UK jobless rate has stabilised an economic expansion, albeit an at 5.1 percent over the last few

months. That has followed a recent softening in wage inflation as well as a slowdown in economic growth and investment plans ahead of a June 23 referendum on whether Britain should remain in or leave the European Union.

In the euro zone, where the European Central Bank just delivered an unexpectedly large dose of extra stimulus, growth has been holding up relatively well, but progress in getting the unemployment rate down has also slowed.

Euro zone inflation is expected to be confirmed at -0.1 percent, well short of its goal of just under 2 percent.

If that itself weren't enough of a worry, the euro, like the yen, is stubbornly rallying just when central bank policymakers have delivered stimulus with the hope of spurring on export performance and importing inflation from abroad.

This suggests to many observers that central banks are near or at the end of their policy reach.

The start of the U.S. company earnings season is also set to kick off, with hopes abound that a reprieve from the dollar's climb may improve the outlook after one of the most volatile starts to the year ever for Wall

The worry, again, is that a tamer dollar will hurt performance at companies based in Europe, Japan and elsewhere, underscoring the reasons behind the Fed's caution about the international backdrop behind its policy stance.

Italy in gloomy growth forecast AFP, Rome

The Italian government revised down its growth forecast for 2016 on Friday but swore the gloomy figures would not lead have an impact on the country's budget. Finance Minister Pier Carlo Padoan said the

updated forecast for the country's gross domestic product (GDP) growth is 1.2 percent, down from a previous forecast of 1.6 percent. It is now expected to reach 1,4 percent in 2017 and 1.5 percent in 2018.

"Growth is accelerating compared to 2015, which was a positive year of growth after three years of recession," Padoan said at a press conference with Prime Minister Matteo Renzi following a cabinet meeting. Renzi said that the government was being inten-

tionally cautious with its outlook: "for the first time for years the forecast is more intelligent, more prudent" thanks to "the scrupulousness" of the finance ministry, he said. He also ruled out a "corrective move" to adjust the

country's budget, saying "there will be no manoeuvres".

Padoan said growth "has been stimulated by the effect of government measures and is accompanied by a continuous improvement in public finances both in terms of the deficit/GDP ratio and of debt, which will reduce from 2016". The government forecasts its huge public debt

burden will drop from 133 percent of GDP in 2015 to 132.4 percent in 2016 and 130.9 percent in 2017, reaching 123.8 percent in 2019. The deficit is forecast to stand at 2.3 percent of GDP

in 2016 and 1.8 percent in 2017. "We are confident" the deficit level "is compatible

with the flexibilty (afforded by the EU) and the exceptional circumstances that relate to the marked deterioration in the international environment," Padoan said. He also moved to stave off criticism over the coun-

try's economic performance, saying that the "government's economy policies are producing tangible results".

Iran exporting 350,000 bpd oil to India

Iran is exporting around 350,000 barrels of crude oil a day to India and hopes to increase this number, Oil Minister Bijan Zanganeh was quoted as saying on Saturday after meeting Indian counterpart Dharmendra Pradhan.

The Shana news agency, linked to Iran's oil ministry, quoted Zanganeh as saying Indian oil purchases from Iran were at 350,000 barrels a day, and that "we hope this number will increase now that sanctions have been lifted".

The two ministers signed a cooperation agreement covering oil exports, the petrochemical sector and the development of a gas field, though there were no reports of any final deals being signed. Pradhan said India was ready to invest \$20 billion

in the port of Chabahar port in southeastern Iran, according to Shana, adding that "Iran and India's energy ties are no longer limited to crude oil imports". Zanganeh said Indian companies were looking to

invest in oil, gas and petrochemical projects in the Islamic Republic, but that reaching deals was "a difficult task and needs time".

Industry sources last week said Indian refiners are looking to ramp up purchases of Iranian crude after sanctions on Tehran were lifted in January, bringing India's imports to at least 400,000 bpd in the coming year.
