Speakers at the sit-in said the country now needed a clean politician like Manna as he was vocal against sick politics.

He was a voice of the people seeking emancipation and democracy and should be released unconditionally, they added.

Plainclothes detectives arrested the then Nagorik Oikya convener Mahmudur Rahman Manna in the capital on February 24 last year. The arrest was made a day after his phone conversation with BNP leader Sadeque Hossain Khoka was leaked to the media anonymously. The speakers also demanded trial of the all recent murders

Sit-in staged in Dhaka Non-cereal diets must for curbing malnutrition

Experts tell nutrition symposium organised by FAO in capital

Experts yesterday suggested diversifying food production and promoting nutrition education to fight malnutrition that affects millions of people in the country.

They said cereals constitute 80 percent of food consumption in Bangladesh, a practice that deprives people of essential nutrients such as protein, minerals and vitamins, mostly coming from fish, meat, milk, eggs, fruits and vegetables.

The observations came at a symposium titled "Nutrition sensitive agriculture in Bangladesh", organised by Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) with sup-

port from USAID at the Bangladesh Agriculture Research Council's (BARC) auditorium in the capital. Though Bangladesh has made remark-

able progress in food production, nutrition

still remains a major challenge. According to a FAO statement, 36 percent of children under five years are either short for their age or stunted, and one third of women are under-nourished with many

becoming pregnant while anaemic. Such malnutrition, especially for children, hampers cognitive development, leading to a shortage of skilled human resources and productivity, mentioned the experts.

Trial still being demanded

Leaders of organisations representing ethnic minority communities yesterday demanded that the government ensures trials of killings in the Chittagong Hill Tracts, including the Logang killings in 1992. Urging unity between Bangalee and ethnic minority

communities against enemies of the public, Gonotantrik

Jubo Forum, Pahari Chhatra Parishad and Hill Women's Federation organised a discussion and lit candles afterwards in the capital's Shahbagh marking 24 years past the Logang killings. Jatiya Mukti Council General Secretary Fayzul Hakim

Lala said the frequent killings nowadays, including that of college student Sohagi Jahan Tonu, were resulting from the government's security failures.

A sudden attack took place on ethnic minority communities preparing to celebrate Boishabi at Logang area in Khagrachhari on April 10, 1992, leaving over 1,000 members of the communities dead.

task. "It is a difficult task but not impossible. I know I have to overcome a number of obstacles. I have to be tough," he said. He also lamented not being able to bring discipline in



The HC on March 14 issued a rule asking the authorities concerned to explain as to why collecting such information should not be declared illegal. BTRC replied to the rule, saying that the writ petition is

not acceptable, as it does not serve public interest, Aneek R Haque, a lawyer for the petitioner, told The Daily Star. Biometric re-registration started from December 16 last year.

Petitioner's lawyer Mucktadir Rahman told this correspondent that there is no specific law for protecting private information. The mobile companies should be restrained until a security system is introduced.

Thirteen officials including law secretaries, home and post and telecommunication ministries, chief election commissioner, BTRC chairman and chief executive officers of six mobile companies have been made respondents to the rule.
