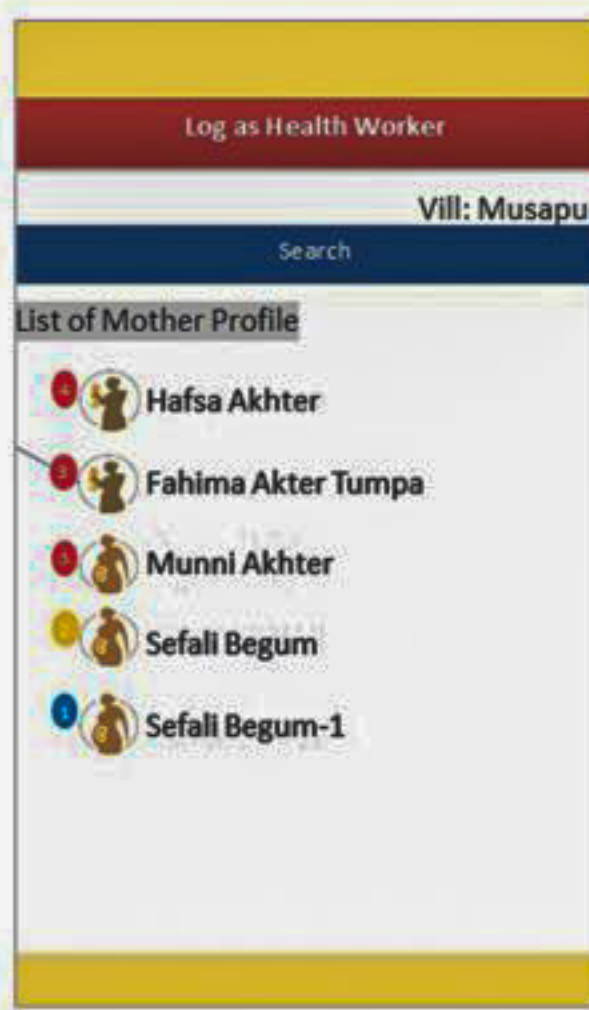

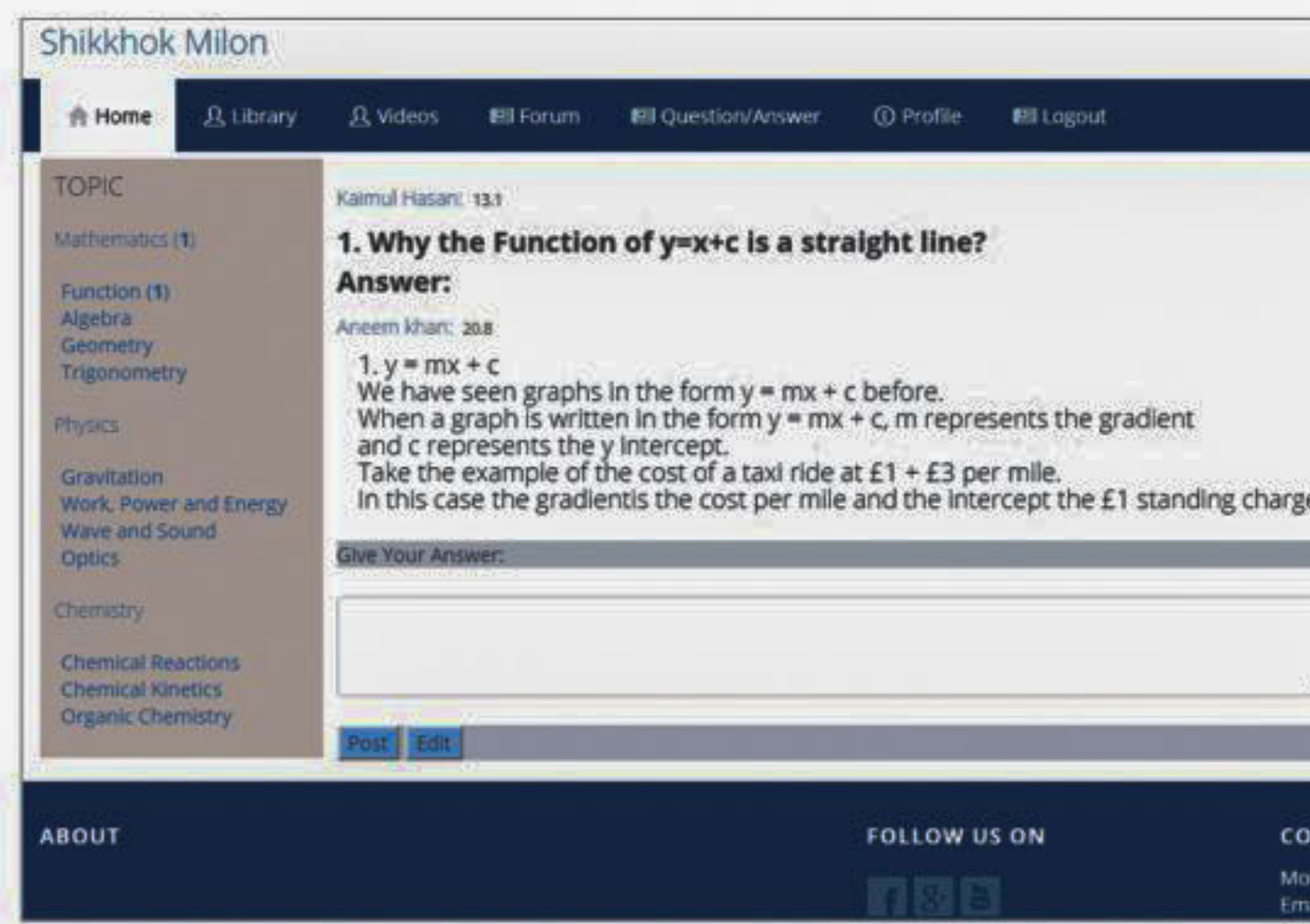
THE AWARD WINNING INNOVATIONS OF NATIONAL HACKATHON 2016

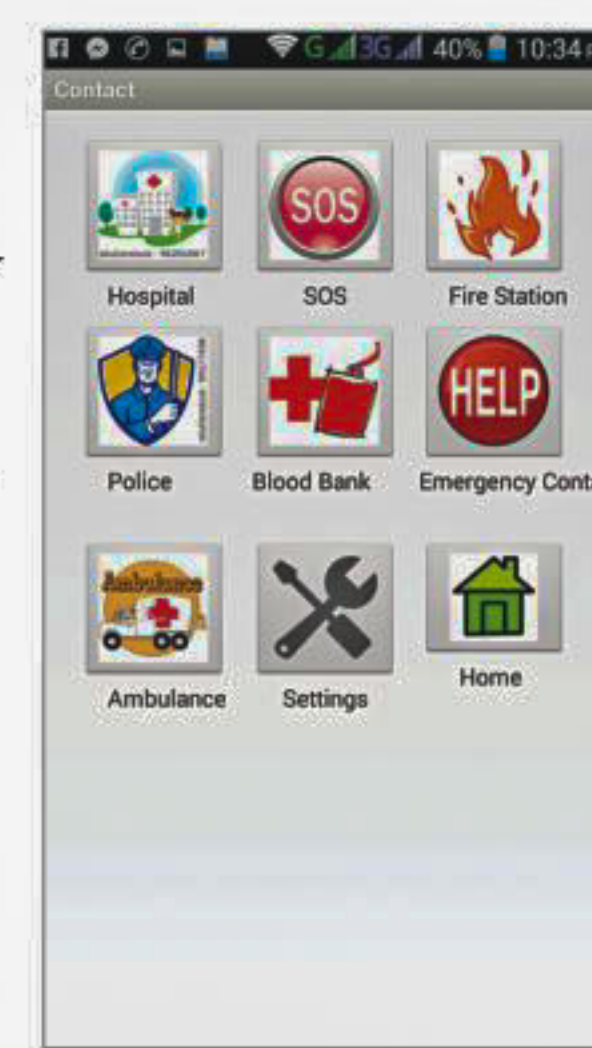

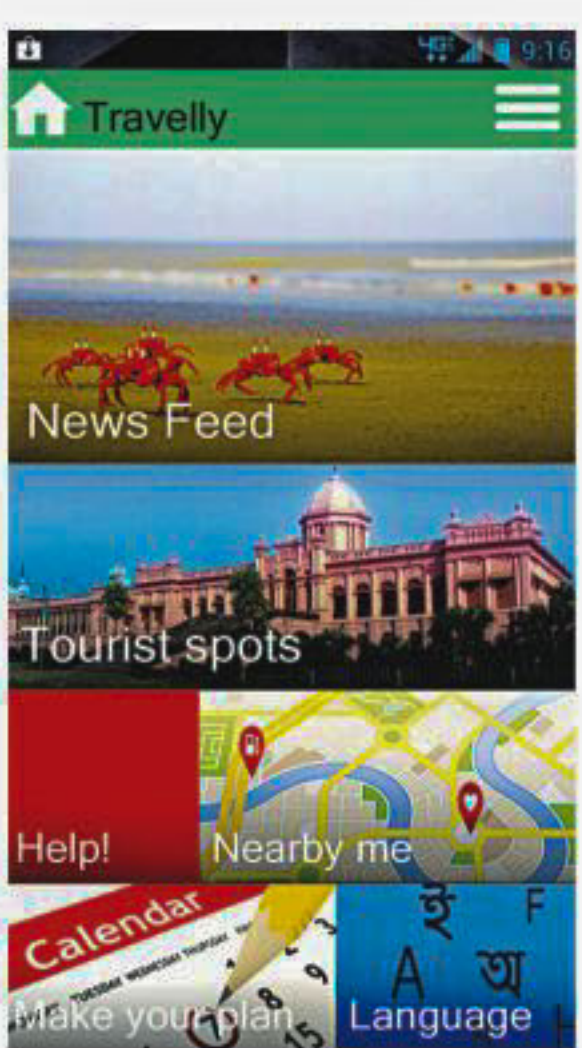
