Businessman rescued 7 days into abduction, three held

The Detective Branch (DB) of police rescued an abducted businessman from Char Adhpakhia in Muktagachha upazila of the district early yesterday. They also arrested three people for their alleged involvement in the abduction. The arrestees are Ripon Miah, 28, his wife Fahima Khatun, 22, and their accomplice Riton Miah, 25, of the area. Ripon, an apparel businessman, knew rescued

businessman Momin Hasan, 30, owner of Uday Sweater at Yeasin Market of Uttara in Dhaka, for long, said Iqbal Hossain Gazi, officer-in-charge of DB police in Mymensingh. On April 13, Momin came to a mosque of Police Lines Uttara Residential area in the district town with a Tabligh Jamaat. Ripon then invited Momin to visit his house in Muktagachha upazila and called him out of the mosque on Monday noon. When Momin went out of the mosque, a gang abducted him and took him

to Ripon's house at Char Adhpakhia in the upazila. The abductors demanded Tk 2 lakh ransom from Momin's family over mobile phone on the same day. Police was later informed about the matter. After tracking phone calls, the law enforcers raided the area and rescued Momin. They also arrested the three from the spot. Momin filed a case with Kotwali Police Station against eight people, including the arrestees. They are raiding different areas to arrest the other accused, said the OC.

The law enforcers rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Naogaon Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy, said the OC.

Youth held with pistol

The Detective Branch (DB) of police arrested a young man with a pistol, one bullet and two bottles of foreign made liquor from Rajarhat area on Jessore-Khulna highway in the district on Tuesday night. The arrestee is Hannan Miah, 34, son of late Ansar Miah of Kafrikhan village in Mithapukur upazila of Rangpur district. Masud Rana, assistant sub-inspector of Jessore DB police, said tipped off, the law enforcers conducted a drive in the area and intercepted a Dhaka-bound private car around 11:30pm. They arrested Hannan with the pistol and bullet from there.

Kashiani OC closed

Superintendent of Police SM Emran Hossain said the EC faxed a letter, signed by Deputy Secretary M Shamsul Alam of the commission, issuing an order to withdraw OC Manirul Islam of Kashiani Police Station. The EC's decision came after several allegations that Manirul had harassed an independent chairman aspirant and a few member candidates.

Villagers block road in Tangail protesting power outage

People of different villages under Sakhipur upazila of the district blocked Sakhipur-Sagardighi Road yesterday, demanding smooth electricity supply. They kept the road blocked for four hours from 8:00am by burning tires at Kachua Intersection. They also held a rally there, causing tailback of several hundred vehicles on both sides of the road.

Hundreds of people from Kachua, Ghonarchala, Joairpara, Dapnajarpara, Kamannapara, Araiapara, Nichchintapur, Naya Kachua and Ramkha Para villages joined the road blockade programme. Addressing a rally at the venue, some villagers said boro paddy in the area is drying up due to lack of proper irrigation. The people in the area are not getting more than two to three hours of electricity per day, they alleged.

Moreover, ghost bills are compounding the problems, they added. The villagers later withdrew the blockade after the chairman of Sakhipur Upazila Parishad Shawkat Shikder, Upazila Nirbahi Officer Rafiqul Islam and Executive Engineer (sales and distribution) Shahadat Ali went to the spot and assured the agitating villagers that they would take immediate steps to ensure smooth supply of electricity in the

They thought of a way in which the survivors, who received assistance from Meena at different times since 2013, could create an investment for their future through art.

of establishing a sewing workshop, with the support of a Bangladeshi RMG company, Esquire Group, and its Danish partner, who donated 17 machines and provided technical expertise, design and skills training. "Many of the women could not go back to work after the building collapse because of physical and mental trauma. Sometimes employers were not willing to recruit the survivors," said Hanne. Mossamat Asma Begum, who was a machine operator in Phantom Apparel, had tried to go back to work but could not take the eight-hour-long stressful shifts in factory. "My back hurts a lot," she said, adding that the atmosphere of a formal factory brought back the dreaded memory of April 24, 2013. Instead, Asma attended a sewing course at Meena and now has a hand-run sewing machine at home. She now takes order from people in her locality and earns about Tk 2,000 a month.

work together. Farhana explained that in the workshop they could work in small shifts and take orders requiring simple work such as production of shopping bags. However, the workshop is in need of further funding for electrical installations, and also orders from clients. That's why the second sculpture workshop. The joy shone in Shilpi's eyes when she told the correspondent proudly how she rented a quarter in Savar alone, this time not to work in a garment factory but to go back to studying.
