One killed as BCL, Jubo League men clash in Feni

A Bangladesh Chhatra League activist was killed in a clash between the men of BCL and Jubo League in Sonagazi upazila in the district on Sunday.

A CNG auto-rickshaw and a motorcycle were burnt during the incident. The agitated activists of both groups also attacked and ransacked three shops.

Police arrested three Jubo League men in connection with the incident.

The deceased was Kamrul Hossain alias Rocky, 16, son of Abu Dhabi expatriate Nur Nabi of Sulakhali in the upazila. He was a Class X student of Kumira High School in Chittagong.

Police and witnesses said, Mainududin, Yasin and Saiful Islam of Sonapur village, who are known as Jubo League activist, waylaid one

expatriate Dulal Hossain's motorbike in the area and snatched a gold bracelet, chain, cash and a mobile phone from him.

Sonagazi Police Station in this connection. Local elites through an arbitration collected the looted materials and returned those to Dulal. The arbitrators fixed the price of the bracelet at Tk 24,000 and asked the attackers to pay the amount to Dulal but they were dillydallying in paying the amount.

Around 8:00pm on Sunday, Dulal entered the BCL office at Sulakhali Bazar and tried to kidnap accused Mainuddin. At one stage, a group of 15 to 16 BCL activists led by Shahin and Rahmatullah resisted Dulal and confined him to the office.

As the news of Dulal's confinement

reached his village Sonapur, a number of people including supporters of Dulal, Chhatra League and Jubo League rushed to the spot and then a Dulal Hossain filed a case with chase and counter chase ensued, triggering a clash.

Kamrul Hossain alias Rocky, Sheikh Ismail Hossain, Dulal Hossain, Nur Alam, Sabbir and Rahmatullah were injured. A number of bombs were also

exploded during the clash. Seriously injured Rocky was first taken to Sonagazi Upazila Health Complex and later shifted to Feni Sadar Hospital. As his condition deteriorated, he was referred to Chittagong Medical College Hospital

(CMCH). Rocky later died in Baraiahat area on the way to CMCH, said Officer-in-Charge of Sonagazi Police Station Md Humayun Kabir.

Police picked up Monsura, but could not arrest Moazzem as he had gone into hiding.

Elephants kill one, damage crops in Jamalpur

Wild elephants killed a man and injured another at Satanipara village in Bakshiganj upazila of the district early yesterday.

The deceased is Saju Mia, 30, son of Idris Ali of the village.

The injured, Khokon Mia, 25, of the same village, is now undergoing treatment at Bakshiganj Upazila Health Complex.

The incident occurred when a herd of 20/25 elephants came to the village from adjacent Garo Hills in search of food around 12:00am.

At one stage, the elephants attacked the villagers when they tried to drive them away from their croplands, killing Saju on the spot and Khokon injured, Officer-in-Charge Aslam Hossain of Bakshiganj Police Station said.

The elephants also destroyed crops on several acres of land, said Nazrul Islam, a member of Kamalpur union parishad.

Hindu priest murder case accused remanded

Storm-damaged school lies without repair for 2 years

Students of Kamol Narayan Government Primary School in Gobindaganj upazila of the district are attending classes under the open sky as the schoolhouse, which was damaged by a nor'wester two years ago, is yet to be repaired. Students suffer under the

scorching sun and classes are suspended when the sky becomes overcast, guardians said. "We don't know how long this situation will continue," they added.

"We have to attend classes under the scorching sun. Our clothes and books get wet when it rains. The schoolhouse must be repaired immediately," said Rasheda Khatun, a student of Class IV, and some of her classmates.

"We don't know why the schoolhouse has not been repaired despite repeated appeals from students and guardians. Education of the children is being seriously hampered due to this," said Rafiqul Islam, a guardian. As the schoolhouse has

remained without repair for the

last two years, the attendance of students is falling. At present, the number of students is over 200, said Babul Akhter, headmaster of the school.

"We appealed several times to the authorities concerned to repair the damaged schoolhouse, but to no effect," he added.

"A proposal for renovation of the schoolhouse was sent to the higher authorities. Work will start on priority basis as soon as the fund is available," said Rownak Akhter Jahan, Gobindaganj upazila education officer.
