Dasherath Das, 22, of Tarashi village in Kotalipara of Gopalganj, has been suffering from brain tumour for at least four months. He is also facing hormonal problem. Now, he is being treated at the National Institute of Neurosciences and Hospital. Doctors said he needs at least Tk 4 lakh for his treatment. Dasherath, who lost his father in a road accident when he was seven, was forced to leave school and start earning money for his four-member family. By working in a factory, he married his two sisters off. But one of them got divorced over dowry and now she and her son are living with them. The Public Service Commission (PSC) will conduct a preliminary test of only 100 marks and oral test of 100 marks instead of written test of 1,000 marks in recruiting some 3,600 nurses, Health Minister Mohammed Nasim said yesterday. The PSC took the decision following health ministry's request to do so following widespread demonstration by the nurses who opposed the recruitment through the examinations by the PSC, but demanded recruitment based on seniority and merit. "The PSC has agreed to the health ministry's request as we want to speed up the recruitment of nurses to ease nurse crisis in the public hospitals," Nasim said at a meeting at the secretariat yesterday, according to a ministry press release. The PSC issued a circular on March 28 on recruiting 3,616 senior nurses in public hospitals. It says the applicants below the age of 36 and attaining Bachelor of Science and diploma in nursing had to take an exam. The circular triggered unemployed nurses' demonstration since early April. Bangladesh Nurses Oikya Parishad (BNOP), a platform of nine nurse associations joined it later. On April 24, it submitted a memorandum to the prime minister and health minister. Nasim warned that the authorities would take punitive actions against the public hospital nurses if they violate the rules. He said 10,000 more posts have been created for the nurses in the public hospitals, and 7,000 will be recruited in the current fiscal year.

# Top bureaucrats for innovation in admin

Top civil bureaucrats yesterday directed government officials to be ingenious, promote creativity and focus on making innovation a functional and popular practice in policy and decision implementation to bring a qualitative change in the administration. This will also save money and time, reduce field visits and help serve people faster and better, senior secretaries told a policy review meeting. "Innovation Practice in the Public Administration: Progress and Prospects", in the capital's Bidyut Bhaban. They asked ensuring services by setting up digital centres and introducing e-filing and multimedia classrooms and using social media to increase public contact and to get views on government initiatives. Cabinet Division and Access to Information (A2I) Programme of the Prime Minister's Office (PMO) jointly organised the meeting where 78 secretaries and 25 director generals (DG) of all the ministries and divisions were present. Four secretaries and three DGs highlighted their innovation-based initiatives and most of the secretaries demanded additional funds to make creativity-centric activities sustainable. "If special allocation is given, pace of works will increase," said Chairman of Land Reforms Board Mahfuzur Rahman, which was echoed by others. ### Obituary of Badrul Ahsan

Mr. Badrul Ahsan FCA, Past President - ICAB passed away on 20 April 2016 at 11:25 pm (Innah Lillahe Wa Inna lilahe Rajeun). He is survived by his mother, wife, two daughters and two granddaughters.

Mr. Badrul Ahsan established and successfully ran his own accountancy firm Ahsan Mostafa Kamal & Ahsan Kamal Sadeq & Co in the 1980's & 90's. Later on he became the Senior Partner of A. Qasem & Co (April 2000 to May 2008) and after that - Nurul Faruk Hasan & Co (BDO Bangladesh), Chartered Accountants in June 2008. Mr. Badrul Ahsan was President of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in 1995. He served the Council ICAB for two consecutive terms from 1992-1997 and one single term in the '80s.

Having passed the LLB final examination from Dhaka University with first class first, Mr. Badrul Ahsan qualified as Chartered Accountant in 1969 from the erstwhile CA Institute in Pakistan. Thereafter, he joined United Bank Limited of Pakistan as Systems Analyst & Programmer. He was the Controller of Accounts of Janata Bank during 1972-73. While in the Bank, he received the prestigious "Sonali Bank Medal" and "American express Inc Award" from the Institute of Bankers Diploma. Mr. Badrul Ahsan had been in professional practice for almost forty years, since 1974. He has a number of publications in his credit and is widely traveled.

Sharmeen Murshid, chief executive officer of Brotee, a human rights and election watchdog, said their polls observers witnessed supporters of UP chairmen and member aspirants in many districts openly stuffing ballot boxes.
