Fakhrul charged for arson, bombing

Police yesterday pressed charges against BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir and 42 others in an arson case filed with Paltan Police Station.

Sub-inspector Tabibur Rahman, also the case investigation officer (IO), submitted two separate charge sheets, one over arson and the other over hurling crude bombs, to the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court in the capital.

Fakhrul, along with 11 others including BNP leaders Rizvi Ahmed, Amanullah Aman, is on bail.

Meanwhile, BNP leaders Barrister Rafiqul Islam Mia, Barkatullah Bulu, Habib-un-Nabi Khan Sohel are among the rest 31 who are absconding. The IO also made an appeal to the court to issue arrest warrants against the absconding accused. A case was filed after a bus carrying public administration ministry staff was set ablaze at Purana Paltan intersection around 6:00pm on December 28, 2014.

Woman 'kills husband' in Old Dhaka

A woman in collaboration with two men allegedly killed her husband at Chawk Bazar in Old Dhaka Monday.

Mousumi Akhter, 22, her extramarital partner Al Amin and his friend Aslam slit the throat of Jamil Ahmed, 37, owner a Swari Ghat scotch tape factory, and stabbed him to death, said police.

The couple lived in a rented flat on the first floor of a five-storey building in Chadni Ghat.

Chawk Bazar police broke open the door of the house and found the body inside a sack, which was sent to Sir

one Rangu Mia in Nasirnagar, killing of five men in Sabiyannagar in Astogram, and killing of 10 other men in the same village.

NARAIL CASE

The tribunal showed two Narail men arrested in a war crimes case, following a prosecution's petition.

The accused are Abdul Wahab 70, of Fulsar village and Omar Ali Sheikh, 60, of Barasula village in Narail Sadar upazila.

Prosecutor Rezia Sultana Chaman told the tribunal that the two were now in a Narail jail following their arrest in two separate cases filed under the Special Powers Act-1974.

Meanwhile, an investigation against the duo started on March 21 this year, and the investigation officer said he had found their involvement in two incidents of killings committed in 1971.

They need to be shown arrested and kept in jail; otherwise they may be released on bail and go into hiding, said the prosecutor.

The three-member tribunal led by Justice Anwarul Haque fixed May 18 for passing the next order in the case.

Trying Pakistani war criminals ethical right

Prof Anisuzzaman tells discussion on 'Trial of Pakistani War Criminals and Jamaat-e-Islami' marking Jahanara Imam's birthday

Prof Emeritus Dr Anisuzzaman yesterday said Bangladesh has an ethical right to try 195 Pakistani war criminals as Pakistan failed to keep its promise of trying them.

"Our demand is not illogical and out of emotion," he said.

He said there is no barrier in trying Jamaat-e-Islami as the party's anti-liberation role is established in the verdicts delivered by the International Crimes Tribunals.

He was addressing a discussion on "Trial of Pakistani War Criminals and Jamaat-e-Islami" organised by Ekatture Ghat Dalal Nirmul Committee at the Bangladesh National Museum in the capital marking the 87th birth anniversary of Saheed Janani Jahanara Imam.

Acting president of the committee Shahriar Kabir said there is no barrier to holding the trials except for the government's political willingness.

"Al-Badr created a hit list during the Liberation War and led killings in the name of Islam; the current hit list has been prepared the same way," he said.

"If the Awami League or administration has no relation with Olama League, then why no punitive measures are taken against it," he added.

Information Minister Hasanul Haq Inu said establishment of the spirit of the Liberation War will be possible only when anti-liberation elements are thrown out of politics.

"For every secret killing that has been taken place, Khaleda Zia must be kept on the suspect list," he added.

Historian Muntassir Mamoon said the government's policy to compromise with Islamic religious groups has gradually turned it helpless.

Former adviser to a caretaker government advocate Sultana Kamal said parties that reject the Liberation War's spirit should not be allowed to do politics.

Shyamoli Nasrin Chowdhury, vice-president of the committee, Maj Gen (ret'd) Mohammad Abdur Rashid, executive director of the Institute of Conflict Law and Development Studies and barrister Tania Ameer also addressed the programme, presided over by journalist Kamal Lohani, adviser of the committee.
