

4 to walk gallows for murder in Pirojpur

A court here yesterday sentenced four people to death for killing a man in Zianagar upazila of the district in 2010.
The death penalty awardees are Sheuli Begum, 30, 40, Asad Majhi, Farid Ahmed and Belal Gazi of Kalaron village in the upazila.
The District and Sessions Judges' Court also fined the four Tk 50,000 each, court sources said.
According to the prosecution, Sheuli Begum, wife of Manik Majhi had an extramarital affair with Asad Majhi of the village. At one

stage, they planned to kill Manik.
On the night of May 25, 2010, Asad, Farid and Belal with the help of Sheuli entered Manik's house and stabbed him indiscriminately, leaving him dead on the spot.
Deceased's younger brother Mizanur Rahman filed a murder case with Indurkani Police Station the following day.
Sub-Inspector Mahbubur Rahman of the police station submitted the charge-sheet against the four in 2011.
After examining the case record and 19 witnesses, Judge Mohammad Golam Kibria handed down the verdict.

MISAPPROPRIATION OF Tk 2.57 LAKH Court issues arrest order against headmaster

The Judicial Magistrate's Court in Dashmina upazila of the district issued an arrest warrant on Wednesday against the headmaster of Dashmina Model High School for misappropriating money from two accounts of the school by forging signature of the chairman of the managing committee.
Judicial Magistrate Mohammad Hossain issued the arrest warrant against headmaster Md Salah Uddin Saikat following a case filed by Golam Mostafa, chairman of the

managing committee, with the court.
According to the case statement, headmaster Md Salah Uddin Saikat withdrew Tk 1.32 lakh from Dashmina branch of Janata Bank (account No 4081) from February 1 to March 31, and Tk 1.25 lakh from Dashmina branch of Agrani Bankon (account No 100) on April 5 this year, using forged cheques.
"I filed the case as per decision of the school's managing committee," Golam Mostafa said.
This correspondent tried to contact Salah Uddin, but his cellphone was switched off.

MISUSE OF GOVT FUNDS Six councillors of Bera municipality land in jail

A court here yesterday sent six councillors of Bera municipality in the district to jail, rejecting their bail prayers in a case filed by the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) for misappropriating state fund in 2015.
The accused are councillors Md Habibur Rahman Habi of Brishalikka village, Samsul Haque Khan of Shombhupur, Abu Daud Sheikh of Bonogram

Uttarpara, Joynal Abedin, of Maitree Bandh, Abdur Razzak Sarkar of Mohonganj, and Md Shahid Ali of Sannalpara village.
Special Judge Mohammad Abdul Kuddus passed the order when they surrendered before the court, said Public Prosecutor Abdur Rahim.
Mohammad Jalal Uddin, deputy assistant director of ACC in Pabna, filed the case with Bera Police Station on August 27 last year against 16 people, including Bera

municipality Mayor Md Abdul Baten.
Bera municipality Mayor Baten, three other councillors and the other accused went into hiding as warrant order was issued against them, court sources said.
Earlier on Tuesday, Shahidul Islam Talukdar, former executive engineer of Pabna Water Development Board (WDB), was sent to jail after his surrender before the court in the same case.
In 2015, the commission

filed three separate cases against the mayor and 20 others for embezzling Tk 6.78 lakh from the state fund.
According to the case statement, Mayor Abdul Baten and his men leased Karamza Haat at C&B Bazar and embezzled the money instead of depositing it to the government fund.
The case statement also says that the accused have been occupying the haat since 2002 and did not even deposit the lease money.

2 killed over land disputes in Mymensingh, Joypurhat

Two people were killed over land disputes in Mymensingh and Joypurhat districts yesterday and the day before.
Our Mymensingh correspondent reported that a physically challenged man was killed by his younger brother over a land dispute at Borjhora village under Iswarganj upazial of the district yesterday afternoon.
The victim was identified as Abul Hashem, 55, son of late Abal Hossain of the village.
Quoting the victim's family members, police said there had been a longstand-

ing dispute between Abul Hashem and his younger brother Ahmed Ali over a piece of land.
Ahmed locked in an altercation with Hashem over the issue at around 3:00pm. At one stage, Ahmed punched Hashem several times, leaving him dead on the spot.
On information, police rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy, said Md Badrul Alam Khan, officer-in-charge of Iswarganj Police Station.
In Joypurhat, a woman was allegedly beaten to death in Panchbibi upazila

of Joypurhat on Tuesday over a land-related dispute, reports our Dinajpur correspondent.
The deceased was identified as Monwara Begum, 50, wife of late Shamsuddin of Bakila village under the upazila. Her son Monsur Ahmed, 20, was injured when he tried to save his mother.
Panchbibi police, quoting witnesses, said Ismail Hossain, neighbour of Monwara, was erecting a fence on her land on the day, claiming the land as his own. Seeing that, Monwara protested and asked Ismail to stop erecting the fence on the land.
Following an altercation

over the issue, family members of Ismail beat up Monwara and her son Monsur with sticks. Monwara died on the spot while her son sustained injuries.
Locals admitted Monsur to Panchbibi Upazila Health Complex. Later, doctors shifted him to Joypurhat Modern Hospital as his condition worsened.
Being informed, police recovered Monwara's body and sent it to Joypurhat Modern Hospital for autopsy.
Ismail and his family members had gone into hiding, said Kiran Roy, inspector (Investigation) of Panchbibi Police Station.

Early marriage bid foiled, 3 held

A schoolgirl was saved from early marriage after she courageously protested against it at Birguppapur village under Madarganj upazila of the district yesterday morning.
The girl Subarna, 14, daughter of Lutfur Rahman of the village, is a Class IX student of Mirza Rawshan Ali High School in the upazila.
Locals said Subarna's father was

preparing to forcibly marry her off with Khairul, 25, an expatriate and son of Joardar Akanda of Fazilpur village under the upazila.
As the girl was dead against the marriage, her father started torturing her and even tied up her hands and legs to make her agree to marry the man, locals said.
"Finding no alternative, she and one of her classmates informed me of the matter and requested me to stop the marriage," said Rayhan Rahmatullah

Rimu, head teacher of Subarna's school, adding that he immediately informed the police and requested them to take necessary steps in this regard.
Police went to the spot and prevented the marriage, said Rampada Mandol, officer-in-charge (OC) of Madarganj Police Station.
Police detained Lutfur Rahman, the girl's maternal uncle Mirza Ranju Miah, and marriage registrar Aminul Islam, the OC added.
