Kuwait to help build oil refinery

Kuwait has responded positively to cooperate in establishing an oil refinery in Bangladesh.

In response to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's request, Kuwaiti Prime Minister Sheikh Jaber Al-Mubarak Al-Hamad Al-Sabah assured exploring opportunities in the field of gas and oil.

According to a joint statement issued yesterday on conclusion of Sheikh Jaber's three-day visit, the two sides agreed to expand cooperation in various fields of trade, investment, energy and power, defence, human resources, infrastructure and in priority sectors in Economic Zones under Bangladesh Economic Zone Authority and IT parks.

Expressing satisfaction at the signing of an agreement on promotion and protection of investment, the two affirmed that it would facilitate Kuwaiti investment in Bangladesh.

Appreciating Kuwait for hosting a large number of Bangladeshi workers, Hasina requested to liberalise the recruitment and hiring policy, particularly to ensure more employment opportunities in professional, skilled and semi-skilled jobs.

Sheikh Jaber agreed to positively consider Bangladesh's request.

Both also agreed to continue cooperation to counter terrorism and violent extremist for peace and stability. Hasina reaffirmed Bangladesh's zero tolerance policy towards terrorism.

Both also expressed commitment to work towards the progress and prosperity of Muslim Ummah.

Shafik Rehman denied bail again

A Dhaka court yesterday again rejected a bail petition of journalist Shafik Rehman in a case filed in connection with an alleged plot to abduct and kill Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's son Sajeeb Wazed Joy.

Judge Kamrul Hossain Mollah of Dhaka Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court passed the order after Shafik's lawyer filed the petition.

Earlier on April 16, another Dhaka court rejected his bail petition and placed him on a five-day remand.

Later, he was placed on another five-day remand.

After completion of the second phase of his remand, Shafik was sent to jail on April 27.

Plainclothes detectives arrested him at his Eskaton Road residence in the capital on April 16.

Earlier on Wednesday, Mahmudur Rahman, acting editor of Bangla daily Amar Desh, was placed on a five-day fresh remand in the second phase in the same case.

In August last year, Detective Branch Inspector Fazlur Rahman filed the case with Paltan police.

DMP zones divided for better management

For better administrative management, Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) has divided its 16 zones under eight crime divisions into 24 zones.

The existing eight patrol zones were turned into 16 patrol zones while the four traffic divisions' 16 zones were divided into 22.

"One DMP AC (assistant commissioner) used to look after all the cases in three or four police stations resulting in lax supervision over lower tier officials. But the supervision will boost significantly as most ACs will now oversee the cases of two police stations only," Maruf Hossain Sarder, deputy commissioner (media) of DMP, told The Daily Star.

The DMP authorities took the decisions on Wednesday after considering the pros and cons for a long time, he added.
