## 'Pir' killed in Rajshahi

Motive unknown but killing style bears hallmark of militants

Less than half a month ago, a university professor was brutally murdered in the district. Almost in a similar fashion, a "pir" was killed there by unknown assailants on Friday night.

Shahidullah, 65, of Mohanondakhali area in the district's Poba upazila, was **Shahidullah** found dead in a mango orchard at Jumarpara village of Tanore upazila, said police and family members.

His throat was slit, and there were gashes in his right shoulder.

Shahidullah, who according to locals and family members was a practitioner of Sufism, also ran a grocery at Nawhata College intersection of Poba.

Police could not say what the motive was, but the killing resembles targeted murders of secularist online activists and writers and people of different faiths and ideologies over the SEE PAGE 11 COL 2

Many incidents of violence and irregularities marred the voting in the fourth phase of the union parishad polls yesterday as four more lives were lost and scores injured in clashes across the country.

Meanwhile, two people were killed and at least 50 others injured in a clash between supporters of an Awami League candidate and police at Auchpara union under Bagmara upazila of Rajshahi where polls were supposed to be held yesterday.


