Designed by architect, Vlado Milunić, this weirdly crooked building was originally named Fred and Ginger after two famous dancers. The site previously had a house of historic significance that was destroyed during the bombing in Prague.



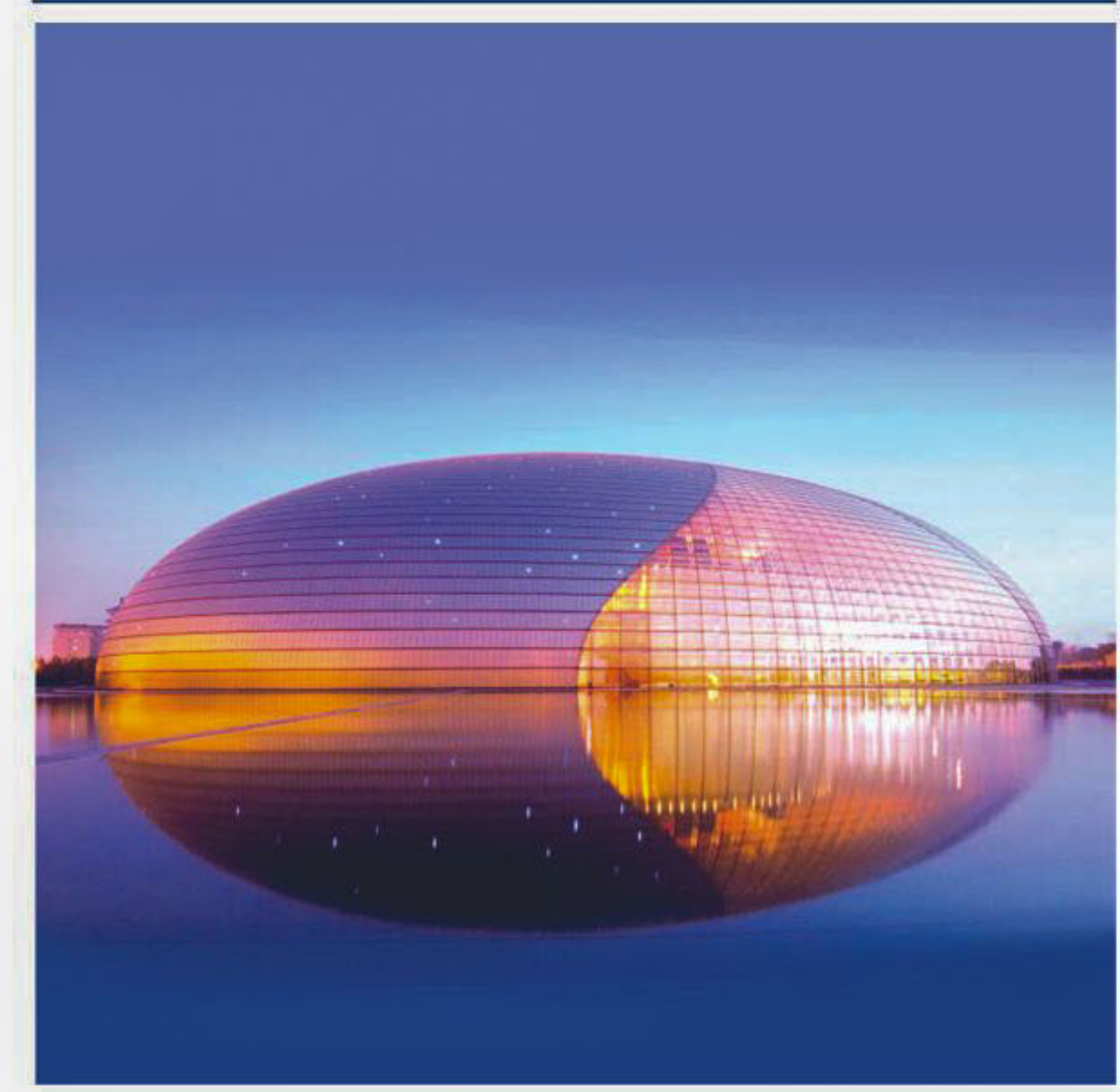
National Centre for the Performing Arts, China

Shaped like a semi-spherical hub, the entire dome is covered with titanium-accented glass. Its construction started in 2001 and it took six years to complete. 46.28 meters in height, it was designed by Paul Andreu.
